OLCC approves three liquor licenses in Portland **COMMISSIONERS ISSUE SANCTIONS TO OREGON LICENSEES**

PORTLAND, Ore. - At their monthly meeting April 16, the commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission granted liquor licenses for the following locations:

- **Stars Cabaret Bridgeport**, 17939 SW McEwan Rd, Tigard; 2-1 in favor of granting the liquor license. Licensee is SCTO, Inc., Jeff Struhar, Corporate Principal.
- **San Felipe Restaurant**, 6221 SE Milwaukie Ave, Portland; 3-0 in favor of granting the liquor license. Licensee is San Felipe Restaurant, Inc., Luna Prisscilia Aguirre Cordero Corporate Principal.
- **Brown's Bar and Grill**, 6526 SE Foster Rd, Portland; 3-0 in favor of granting the liquor license. Licensee is Renato Angelo Beorchia.

The OLCC ratified the following sanctions to Oregon licensees through stipulated settlement agreements.

Hood River Restaurant, 108 2nd Street, Hood River; will pay a civil penalty of \$3,135 or serve a 19-day suspension because the Licensee permitted unlawful activity when private security professionals provided services without being certified to do so which is a violation of ORS 181.991(1)(b). Licensee is Shan He Company, Inc., Sin Min Mok and Liu Ji Tan, Corporate Principals.

Mudai Ethiopian Restaurant & Lounge, 801 NE Broadway, Portland; will pay a civil penalty of \$3,300 or serve a 20-day suspension for Corporate Principal Belay Birhane failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him to be served an alcoholic beverage when he reasonably appeared under 26. In addition Birhane sold, mixed or served alcoholic beverages, or supervised those who do without a valid service permit. Licensee is Mudai Ethiopian Restaurant, Inc., Belay Birhane and Ellen Gezahegne, Corporate Principals.

District, 232 NW 12th Ave., Portland; will serve a 34-day suspension for allowing service, consumption, or receipt of alcoholic beverages at the licensed premises during the period of time that the liquor license was under suspension. Licensee is District LLC, Peter Villanueva, Corporate Principal.

H Mart, 10120 SW Hall Boulevard, Portland; will serve a 23-day suspension for failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing her to buy an alcoholic beverage when she reasonably appeared to be under 26 years old. Licensee is Abdullah Mahmood.

Alberta Cooperative Grocery, 1500 NE Alberta St., Portland; will serve a 30-day suspension and will be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program for violating three license restrictions regarding the sale of malt beverages with more than six percent alcohol by volume and wines containing more than 13.8 percent alcohol by volume. The licensee is Alberta Cooperative Grocery, Styen Pearson, SeaOh McConville, Richard Cascio and Corrine Rupp, Corporate Principals.

Split, 7335 SW Bridgeport Road, #R101, Tigard; will receive a letter of reprimand on the permanent OLCC file for two violations. Licensee permitted an employee to sell, mix, or serve alcoholic beverages, or supervise those who do, without a valid service permit in addition to making references outside of the licensed premises to temporary price reductions for alcoholic beverages which is a violation of OAR 845-007-0020(2). Licensee is Fun at the Mall, LLC, Tyler Williams and Gerald Wilson, Corporate Principals.

The commissioners issued the following final orders:

Bing's Restaurant, 58209 S. Columbia River Hwy, St. Helens; will serve a 30-day suspension for refusing to admit police officers to the licensed premises in order to conduct a reasonable search to ensure compliance with

alcoholic beverage laws which is a violation of OAR 845-006-0345(4)(b). Licensee is Bing's Restaurant, Inc., Sue Joe, Paul Joe, Rosemary Joe and Lisa Joe, Corporate Principals.

The liquor license of **Lotsa Luck**, 2136 SE Powell Blvd., Portland; will be cancelled and the application for renewal will be refused for violating a license restriction that prohibited Corporate Principal Robert "RC" Greenough from consuming alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises. Licensee is ERB, Inc., Robert "RC" Greenough and Lynn Greenough, Corporate Principals.

The five citizen commissioners are the policy-making body of the OLCC. They meet monthly for one or two days to make decisions on liquor licenses, rules, contested case hearings and appointments of liquor store agents. Commission meetings are held every other month at OLCC's main office, 9079 SE McLoughlin Blvd., Room 103A in Portland. Subsequent months, the meetings are held via phone.
