## **OLCC Commissioners issue 9 sanctions and appoint Union Liquor Agent**

**PORTLAND, Ore.** – At their monthly meeting June 23, the commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission ratified the following stipulated settlements for an employee(s) failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him/her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he/she reasonably appeared to be under 26:

**JC's Bar & Grill, 642 NW Franklin Ave., Bend;** will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee will also be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensee is Cox Brothers Corporation, Jeremy Cox and Christopher Cox, corporate principals.

**Griff's Mini Market, 4432 SW Carnes Road, Roseburg;** has paid a fine of \$330. Licensee will also install age verification equipment and will use the equipment to verify the age of each person purchasing alcohol who reasonably appears under the age of 26. Licensees are Chang Kim and Song Kim.

**Albany Mega Foods, 2000 Queen SE, Albany;** has paid a fine of \$1,485. Licensee will be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensee is B & E3, LLC; Charles Blake Barton and Bobby J. Ellis, members.

**Mick & Mom's Pub & Eatery, 255 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave., Stayton;** has paid a fine of \$1,485. Licensee will be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensee is Mick & Mom's Pub & Eatery, Inc.; Yong Chao Wu and Yichao Wu, corporate principals.

**Sapphire Hotel, 5008 SE Hawthorne Blvd, Portland;** will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Rat Circus, LLC, Carrie Engle and Shannon Freeman, members.

**Phillips Golf Shop, 1005 NW Stewart Park Drive, Roseburg;** will pay a fine of \$330 or serve a two-day liquor license suspension. Licensee will also install age verification equipment and will use the equipment to verify the age of each person purchasing alcohol who reasonably appears under the age of 26. Licensees are Fred Phillips and Jeremy Phillips.

**Cascade General Store, 47781 Highway 58, Oakridge;** will pay a fine of \$1,155 or serve a seven-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Smart Bucks, LLC, Jane Malott and Guy Malott, members.

**Sunnyside 76, 12405 SE 97<sup>th</sup> Ave., Clackamas;** will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Khan Oil Clackamas, LLC; Sohail Khan and Farzana Khan, members.

**Clackadeli Pub, 14950 SE 82<sup>nd</sup> Drive, Clackamas;** will pay a fine of \$330 or serve a two-day liquor license suspension. Licensee will also install age verification equipment and will

use the equipment to verify the age of each person purchasing alcohol who reasonably appears under the age of 26. Licensee is Patrick Wilburn.

The commissioners of the OLCC appointed the following liquor store agents:

Retail liquor agents are independent contractors; they are not state employees. The Retail Services Division of the OLCC works closely with liquor agents to help them understand and follow liquor regulations and store operating procedures.

The five citizen commissioners are the policy-making body of the OLCC. They meet monthly for one or two days to make decisions on liquor licenses, rules, contested case hearings and appointments of liquor store agents. Commission meetings are held every other month at OLCC's main office, 9079 SE McLoughlin Blvd., Room 103A in Portland. Subsequent months, the meetings are held via phone.
