OLCC Commissioners Amend Prohibited Conduct and Minor Posting Rules

PORTLAND, Ore. – At its monthly meeting October 21, 2016, the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission amended **OAR 845-006-0345 (Prohibited Conduct)** to allow limited tastings of malt beverage (beer), wine or cider by employees of a liquor-licensed business to test the quality of the product to ensure it is not flawed or deteriorated or for educational activities for public and staff. The tastings are limited to a maximum of one ounce per serving and a maximum of six ounces total between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 2:30 a.m. These limited tastings only apply to employees age 21 and over and do not apply to the consumption of distilled spirits. The rule amendments also clarify that marijuana consumption is prohibited on the premises of liquor-licensed businesses. This rule amendment goes into effect December 1, 2016.

The Commissioners also amended **845-006-0335 and 845-006-0340 (Minor Posting Package)** to allow greater flexibility in managing areas in liquor-licensed businesses where minors may be present. This package adds an exception to allow a minor to access a restroom that is within an area that is normally prohibited to minors. The changes to 845-006-0335 allows minor employees to remain working at the business after the minor posting changes to prohibit minors, if the licensee submits an approved written plan to manage the minor employees. These rules go into effect December 1, 2016.

The Commissioners approved the following liquor license with restrictions:

Paris Theatre, 6 SW Third Ave., Portland; Full-Commercial Liquor License; Licensee is Sunshine Management, LLC; Chris Lenahan and Brad McCray, members.

The Commissioners ratified the following fines and liquor license suspensions based on stipulated settlement:

Metzger Mart, 10055 SW Hall Blvd., Tigard; will pay a fine of \$4,125 or serve a 25-day liquor license suspension for six incidents of permitting unlawful activity on the licensed premises. Two incidents involved Theft in the First Degree, three incidents involved Aggravated Theft in the First Degree and once incident was for unlawfully Obtaining or Disposing of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance. Licensees are Maria Bark and Deok Lim. Deok Lim has been removed from the liquor license and will receive a Letter of Reprimand for the violation.

Remmy's Nightclub & Restaurant & Sports Bar, 3180 Lancaster Drive NE, Salem; will surrender the Full On-Premises Sales liquor license for two incidents of permitting noisy activities on the licensed premises or in areas that the licensee controls that are adjacent to or outside the premises when music was played at a loud level. Licensee was found guilty of violating a Marion County Noise Ordinance for the first violation and pled guilty to the Marion County Noise Ordinance violations for the second violation. Licensee has begun selling the business and will surrender the liquor license on the date the transfer of ownership of the business is complete or at 7:00 AM on December 1, 2016, whichever is earlier. Licensee is Joel Loera Arechiga.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him or her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he or she reasonably appeared to be under 26 years of age:

Oak Market, 711 SE Oak, Roseburg; will pay a fine of \$3,795 or serve a 23-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is HP Johal, LLC; Major Johal, member.

Seaside Station, 231 S. Holladay Drive, Seaside; will pay a fine of \$3,795 or serve a 23-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Wan & Joo, LLC; Wan Yoo and Hyung Yi, members.

Mama Jiah's Market, 2248 Main Street, Forest Grove; will pay a fine of \$3,795 or serve a 23-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Forest Grove Main Street Market, LLC; Jung Byun and Joanna Byun, members.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for permitting an employee(s) to mix, sell, or serve alcoholic beverages or supervise those who do, without a valid alcohol service permit issued by the OLCC:

Sunset Strip, 10205 SW Park Way, Portland; will pay a fine of \$3,795 or serve a 23-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Phoenix Entertainment, Inc.; Damon Shrader, corporate principal.

Starbuck's Coffee #14304, 1122 NW Garden Valley Blvd., Roseburg; will pay a fine of \$1,815 or serve an 11-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Coffee House Holdings, Inc.; Clarice Turner, Sophie Hager Hume, Andrew Wolff, Michael Malanga, Sara Trilling, Linda Van Gosen, Susan Johnson, and Stephanie Meier, corporate principals.

Cascade Cliffs Vineyard & Winery, 211 Oak Street, Hood River; will pay a fine of \$2,475 or serve a 15-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Petroglyph Winery, LLC; Robert Lorkowski, member.

The Alibi Restaurant and Lounge, 4024 N. Interstate, Portland; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is The Alibi Restaurant, Inc.; Karla White, Marci Wagner, and Estate of Larry White, corporate principals.

Tasty Thai Kitchen, 80 E. 29th Ave., Eugene; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Tasty Thai Kitchen, LLC, Pismai Nissen, member.

Night Light Lounge, 2100 SE Clinton, Portland; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Galactic Unicorn, Inc.; Hope Beraka and Christopher Gutierrez, corporate principals.
