OLCC Commissioners Direct Staff to Initiate Phase Five of Retail Expansion and Ratify Stipulated Settlements for Liquor Violations

PORTLAND, OR – At its monthly meeting June 14, 2018, the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission directed staff to move forward with phase five of Retail Expansion. Phase five will be advertised in August 2018 for the following counties: Clatsop, Columbia, Lincoln, Marion, Polk, Tillamook and Yamhill. Applications for retail liquor locations in these counties will be accepted beginning August 2018.

Liquor Program Action

Commissioners ratified the following fines and liquor license suspensions based on stipulated settlement:

Tommy's Too, 10335 SE Foster Rd., Portland, will serve a 37-day suspension or pay a \$2,640 civil penalty and a 21-day suspension for three violations. The first violation is for an employee under the influence of intoxicants while on duty; the second violation is for unlawful activity on the licensed premises or in areas that the licensee controls that are adjacent to or outside the premises where an employee was in possession of cocaine; and the third violation was for the destruction, damaging, altering, removal or concealing of potential evidence when video evidence was allowed to be written over after it was requested. Licensee is 3P and L, LLC; Patrick Schwartzkopf, member.

Horny Goat, 234 SW 5th St., Grants Pass, will pay a \$1,815 civil penalty or serve an 11-day suspension for selling, giving or otherwise making alcohol available to a visibly intoxicated person. Licensee is Bread & Butter, LLC; Shelly Solomon and Eric Solomon, members.

Landmark Saloon, 4847 SE Division St., Portland, will pay a \$4,950 civil penalty or serve a 30-day suspension. The licensee, (former) managing member Marc Curtis failed to exercise license privileges in compliance with the license restrictions when Mr. Curtis failed to refrain from the consumption of alcoholic beverages, including consuming alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises. Licensee has removed former managing member Marc Curtis from the business entity, Landmark Saloon, LLC. Licensee is Landmark Saloon, LLC; Nicolas Wilson, managing member; Timothy Hawk, Erica Nukaya, members.

Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for permitting employee(s) to mix, sell, or serve alcoholic beverages, or supervise those who do, without a valid alcohol service permit:

Sloan's Tavern, 36 N. Russell, Portland, will pay a civil penalty of \$1,485 or serve a nine -day liquor license suspension. Licensees are Sloan's Tavern, Inc.; Robert Sloan, Shirley Sloan and Roberta Carr, corporate principals.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him/her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he/she reasonably appeared to be under 26 years of age.

Shari's of South Redmond, 1565 Odem Medo Rd., Redmond, will pay a civil penalty of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensee is Shari's Management Corporation; Bruce MacDiamid, Kevin Bechtel, Alan Hartley, Erik Hermann, Jim Balis, Wade Daniel, corporate principals; Shari's Restaurant Group, Inc., stockholder.

Mark Sargent, 4353 NE 85th Ave., Portland, will pay a civil penalty of \$450 or serve an 18-day liquor license suspension for two violations, each repeated. The first violation was failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when she reasonably appeared to be under 26 years of age. The second violation is for permitting a minor to drink alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises.
