OLCC Commissioners Ratify Stipulated Bottle Bill Settlements

PORTLAND, OR – At its monthly meeting Oct. 26, 2018, the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission ratified the following stipulated settlements for violations of the Oregon Bottle Bill by wilfully refusing to accept empty beverage and refusing to pay the customer the value of those containers:

Siletz Gas & Mini Mart, 315 S Gaither St., Siletz, will pay a \$990 civil penalty or serve a six-day suspension. Licensee is Native American Management, LLC; Douglas Johnson, managing member.

Safeway store #1765, 5270 SW Philomath Blvd., Corvallis, will pay a \$660.00 civil penalty or serve a four-day suspension. Licensee is Safeway, Inc.; Jim Donald, president; Robert Gordon, director; Gary Morton, secretary; Robert Dimond, vice president; Lisa Gray, director; Robert Miller, director; Albertson's Companies, LLC, stockholder.

Safeway store #1230, 2177 NW 185th, Hillsboro, will pay a \$660.00 civil penalty or serve a four-day suspension. Licensee is Safeway, Inc.; Jim Donald, president; Robert Gordon, director; Gary Morton, secretary; Robert Dimond, vice president; Lisa Gray, director; Robert Miller, director; Albertson's Companies, LLC, stockholder.

Safeway store #1590, 455 N Columbia, Milton-Freewater, will pay a \$660.00 civil penalty or serve a four-day suspension.
