Check Local Liquor Store for Thanksgiving Day Hours OLCC offices closed on Thanksgiving Day and the Day After

PORTLAND, Ore. – The Oregon Liquor Control Commission reminds customers that liquor stores in Oregon have the option to be open on Thanksgiving Day; Thursday, Nov. 22. State law provides that liquor agents have the discretion to be open or closed on Sundays and holidays.

OLCC offices statewide will be closed on Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, Nov. 22 and Friday, Nov. 23.

The nine state holidays liquor stores may be closed are:

New Year's Day
Martin Luther King Jr. Day
President's Day
Memorial Day
Fourth of July
Labor Day
Veteran's Day
Thanksgiving (and day after)
Christmas Day
