## Winners Announced for Pappy Van Winkle and the Buffalo Trace Distillery Antique Collection Drawing

**Portland, OR** – The Oregon Liquor Control Commission's second public drawing for rare and limited edition liquors ended Sunday, December 2. A total of 7,663 eligible entrants from Oregon joined the drawing for their opportunity to purchase their bottle of the Pappy Van Winkle and the Buffalo Trace Distillery Antique Collection. 106 winners, selected randomly from all entries statewide, were drawn this week and winners notified.

Entrants were allowed a single entry for each one of the 11 products, and there were 70,005 entries for all products, with no winner winning more than one. Based on total eligible entrants, the odds of winning the chance to purchase just one of the 106 bottles was 1:72. The 106 winners of the opportunity to purchase and the product they won the chance to purchase are:

As part of the terms of the drawing, winners have committed to purchasing their bottle of the Pappy Van Winkle and the Buffalo Trace Distillery Antique Collection at one of OLCC's liquor stores within 14 days of notification of winning.

The second drawing in the OLCC's chance to purchase concept closed to entries on Sunday at 11:00 p.m. The drawing began on Thursday, November 22 at midnight. Just over a month prior, OLCC wrapped up its first public drawing, for 2018 Old Forester Birthday Bourbon on October 13, with 6 winners chosen from a field of 2,261 eligible entrants.

With 106 bottles available, and 11 products to choose from, this was the largest chance to purchase offering yet. Despite that, it was still a "rare and limited" offering. For example, 24 bottles were available for Pappy Van Winkle Family Reserve 10 Year, and 12 bottles were available for Pappy Van Winkle Family Reserve 12 Year. Other products were more limited, such as only six bottles of Thomas H. Handy Sazerac and a single bottle of each of Eagle Rare 17 Year and Van Winkle Family Reserve Rye were available.

OLCC receives special releases throughout the year, such as the Pappy Van Winkle and the Buffalo Trace Distillery Antique Collection, with a limit on quantities we receive from manufacturers and suppliers. The state has no control over how many bottles it receives each year. OLCC will use a public drawing to make available to the public a portion of these rare or limited releases throughout each year by public drawing.
