Commissioner Floyd is an Oregon native, and has been involved in the restaurant and hospitality industry since 1995. Possessing an acumen for the restaurant business, she has worked many roles up to general management, leading to her 2006 purchase of Amalfi's Italian Restaurant in NE Portland. She is an active member in the Oregon Restaurant & Lodging Association and served on its Board of Directors from 2005-2012.
