OLCC Commissioners Ratify Stipulated Alcohol Settlements

PORTLAND, OR. – At its monthly meeting Mar. 21, 2019, the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission ratified the following fines and suspensions based on stipulated settlement:

Hales Restaurant, 2755 SE TV Highway, Hillsboro, will pay a \$1,485.00 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension for licensee permitting their employees, agents, servants or representatives to mix, sell or serve alcoholic beverages, or supervise those who do, without a valid service permit issued by the Commission. Licensee is Hales Restaurant, Inc.; Deanna Hale, President/Vice President/Secretary/Director/Stockholder.

Triangle Tavern, 222 W Marine Drive, Astoria, will either pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a 9-day suspension for licensee permitting their employee, agent, servant or representative to mix, sell or serve alcoholic beverages, or supervise those who do, without a valid service permit issued by the Commission. Licensee is MNC Enterprises, Inc.; Michael Cearley, President/Director/Stockholder; Nadine Cearley, Secretary/Director/Stockholder.

Relish Gastropub, 6637 SE Milwaukie, Portland, will either pay a \$1,815 civil penalty or serve an 11-day suspension for licensee permitting their corporate principal to mix, sell or serve alcoholic beverages, or supervise those who do, without a valid service permit issued by the Commission. Licensee is GP Relish, Inc.; Akhil Kapoor, President/Secretary/Director/Stockholder; Marla Kapoor, Treasurer/Director/Stockholder.

Commissioners additionally confirmed new distilled product listings for retail services, which featured many Oregon brands. They also heard a compliance report and received a staff update on the ongoing legislative session.
