## **Liquor Licensee/Applicant Notification Form**

## What is this form?

Pursuant to OAR 845-006-0341, liquor license applicants and licensees are required to provide notification to the Commission within five (5) calendar days of the conviction when any individual listed in an application as an applicant or subsequently identified as an applicant or licensee has been convicted of any misdemeanor or felony. This requirement includes non-Oregon convictions. If you have passed the deadline for notification, you may be asked to provide an explanation.
