| Certificate of Approval (for beer, wine, and cider) ORS 471.244 | CERA | \$350 (good for 5 years) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allows a beer, wine, or cider manufacturer, wholesaler, or importer in a U.S. state other than Oregon to send malt beverages, wine, or cider to an Oregon wholesaler (the Oregon wholesaler may receive the alcohol only if the person sending the alcohol has a CERA and the Oregon wholesaler has the privilege to import the alcohol into Oregon). • Allows a wholesaler in Oregon to receive malt beverages, wine, and cider directly from a beer, wine or cider manufacturer, wholesaler, or importer outside of the U.S. (the Oregon wholesaler must get the CERA). |
| Certificate of Approval (for distilled spirits) ORS 471.251 | CER-D | No fees | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is no need to apply for this certificate as it is automatically issued by the OLCC to businesses outside of Oregon who have applied to the OLCC and have been approved by the OLCC to sell distilled liquor by the bottle directly to the OLCC. • For more information: Listing distilled liquor in Oregon |
