

SALE AND DELIVERY OF LIQUOR TO OREGON RESIDENTS

WHO MAY SELL AND DELIVER DISTILLED LIQUOR TO OREGON RESIDENTS

DEFINITIONS FOR DISTILLED LIQUOR DELIVERY¹

- **Oregon resident:** This means an individual who resides in Oregon, even temporarily, who orders distilled liquor for delivery for personal use and not for resale. The OLCC does not require proof of Oregon residency to receive a distilled liquor delivery.
- **Full On-Premises Sales Licensees:** Businesses that hold a license issued under ORS 471.175 that allows for sale of distilled liquor by the drink.
- **Distillery Retail Outlet Agent (DROA):** Pursuant to ORS 471.230, a distillery licensee may apply for an appointment as a DROA. This appointment will allow the DROA to retail distilled liquor that is manufactured in Oregon by the distillery licensee and is listed by the OLCC for sale in Oregon. A DROA is an independent contractor and is not an employee or officer of the OLCC or the State of Oregon.
- **"Mixed drink" (Cocktails)** means a beverage that is a combination of distilled liquor and one or more mixers that is combined on a licensed premises and sold in a sealed container for consumption off the licensed premises. A mixed drink (or "cocktail") must only contain three ounces or less of distilled liquor. The total amount of liquid in a single mixed drink container must be six ounces or less. "Neat" or "shots" are NOT allowed.
- **Retail Sales Agent (RSA):** RSAs are independent contractors who have agreed to manage the state distilled liquor inventory and funds as directed by the OLCC. The state provides store inventory, and some business supplies and individual RSAs have access to some state benefits. However, agents themselves are not state employees.
- **For Hire Carrier (FHC):** This is an individual or entity that holds itself out to the public as providing the services of pick-up, transport, and delivery of distilled liquor between a DROA, RSA or Full On-Premises Sales Licensee and a resident of Oregon. To lawfully provide this service in Oregon, the FHC must be approved by the OLCC. For-hire carriers include, but are not limited to the following when those parties are delivering distilled liquor to Oregon residents:
 - Common carriers
 - Courier services
 - Peer-to-peer ride-sharing services
 - Taxicab companies
 - App or web-based (e-commerce) food and beverage delivery services (also known as a Third-Party E-Commerce Platform or TPP)

¹ Definitions specifically tailored to distilled liquor deliveries.

- **Third-Party E-Commerce Platform (TPP):** This refers to unlicensed entities (DoorDash, UberEats, etc.) involved with the promotion, marketing, and facilitation of sales of distilled liquor by DROAs or Full On-Premises Sales licensees (in the form of mixed drinks in sealed containers) to Oregon residents over the Internet (including through a website or mobile application). If the TPP is also going to deliver distilled liquor to an Oregon resident, the TPP must be an approved FHC.

ARE YOU AN OREGON RETAIL SALES AGENT (RSA), DISTILLERY RETAIL OUTLET AGENT (DROA) OR FULL ON-PREMISES SALES LICENSEE?

IF NO.....you may NOT sell distilled liquor for delivery to Oregon residents. This includes NO sales of distilled liquor drinks (i.e. mixed drinks or cocktails) or manufacturer-sealed bottles or other containers of distilled liquor for delivery to an Oregon resident.

IF YES....you may sell and deliver as follows:

Accepting payment	In-person in the tasting room or curbside, and through a website or mobile application (including third-party websites and mobile applications, IF both DROA and third-party follow the Interim policy on TPP).	In-person in the store or curbside (no remote web or mobile application purchases).	In-person in the business or curbside, and through a website or mobile application (including third-party websites and mobile applications, IF both the licensee and third-party follow the Interim policy on TPP).
Hours of sale	7 am – 10 pm	7 am – 10 pm	7 am – 10 pm
Hours for delivery	7 am – 10 pm	7 am – 10 pm	7 am – 10 pm
Delivery locations	Within 100 feet of premises (curbside), home, business	Within 100 feet of the store (curbside), home, business	Within 100 feet of the premises (curbside), home, business
Volume for delivery (per day)	Up to six different distilled liquor products with no more than two bottles of the same product.	No limit.	Must be ordered with a substantial food item . Maximum of two mixed drinks per substantial food item.
Who may deliver	DROA personnel or approved FHC.	Approved FHC only.	Licensee personnel or approved FHC.

Verification and recordkeeping requirements for delivery	DROA must follow the operations manual. FHC must follow OAR 845-005-0424.	FHC must follow OAR 845-005-0424.	Licensee must follow OAR 845-006-0399. FHC must follow OAR 845-005-0424.

IMPORTANT!

- No out-of-state retailer of distilled liquor may sell distilled liquor for delivery to an Oregon resident.
- No carrier may deliver distilled liquor to an Oregon resident from an out-of-state source.
