Industrial Hemp Certificate Expiration; Revocation

(1) Expiration. A hemp grower or handler who received an industrial hemp certificate under OAR 845-025-2700 on or before April 16, 2018 may continue to operate beyond the expiration of the certificate:

(a) Until the Commission adopts new rules that are applicable to hemp growers and handlers; or

(b) Unless the Commission revokes the industrial hemp certificate.

(2) Revocation.

(a) The Commission shall revoke any industrial hemp certificate if the holder no longer holds a valid industrial hemp registration issued under ORS 571.305.

(b) If the Commission revokes a certificate, the holder has a right to a hearing in accordance with ORS 183.
