Grow Site Transfer Information

What is this document?

This document provides information on the transfer of usable marijuana from a registered medical marijuana grow site to licensed recreational marijuana Processors or recreational marijuana Wholesalers. Medical marijuana grow site administrators (GSA) as well as Processor and Wholesaler licensees should review and understand the requirements for these transfers.

This informational document is not an application form. To register for this additional privilege, a grow site must complete a registration document and submit it to OLCC.

Who can apply?

A grow site registered by the Oregon Medical Marijuana Program (OMMP) to grow more than 12 plants and subject to tracking marijuana in the cannabis tracking system (CTS, also called "Metrc") may apply with the Commission to transfer up to 20 pounds of marijuana to an Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC) Processor or Wholesaler annually.

How do I register?

After **July 1, 2018**, a grow site administrator with an active CTS account may complete a registration form on behalf of the grow site and submit it to the Commission via email. To register, a grow site must:

- Have an active cannabis tracking system (CTS) account;
- Be at a grow site where more than 12 mature plants are produced;
- Have copies of personal agreements between the grower and their patient(s) onsite;
- Have been a continually registered grow site with OMMP since August 2, 2017;
- Test all usable marijuana being transferred in accordance with rules;
- Submit a completed registration form to the Commission;
- Provide documentation of legal access to water for commercial purposes; and
- Receive approval from the Commission.

Where can I find the application form?

The registration form will be published on the OLCC's website at marijuana.oregon.gov. OLCC will begin accepting applications for this privilege **after July 1, 2018**. A grow site will need to have an active CTS account prior to applying.

Grow Site Transfer Information

What does "legal access to water" mean?

Although certain water uses may be allowed for the production of **medical marijuana** for non-commercial purposes, the use of water for the production of **marijuana for commercial purposes** will require a right, permit, exemption, or source that is legal for that purpose. This applies if a medical marijuana grow site plans to sell its cannabis into the OLCC regulated recreational market.

The Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) has publicized information on water use regulations and cannabis in Oregon. Information and the "**Understanding Water Use Regulations**" brochure can be found under "**Water Use and Marijuana**" at <http://www.oregon.gov/owrd>.

Proof of legal access to water can be demonstrated by:

- Holding a water right permit or certificate for the site; or
- Demonstrating that water will be provided by a public or private supplier; or
- Providing a completed "Exempt Water Form" from the Oregon Water Resources Department certifying that the water to be used for production does not require a water right.

Do I have to transfer twenty pounds all at once?

No. A grow site that is registered to transfer up to 20 pounds of usable marijuana (flower and/or shake/trim) to a recreational marijuana Processor or Wholesaler may do so within any 12-month period. This means if less than 20 pounds has been transferred within the last 12 months, the grow site may continue to transfer marijuana until the 20-pound limit has been reached for that 12-month period.

Can each grower transfer 20 pounds?

No. The limit is **per grow site**, not per grower.

Does this limit my other transfers such as to patients or medical marijuana dispensaries?

No. Registering for this privilege does not restrict the existing privilege of a grower to transfer marijuana to their patients, medical processing sites, or medical marijuana dispensaries as long as OMMP rules are being followed.

Can I transfer marijuana directly to a recreational marijuana Retailer?

No. A medical marijuana grow site **may not** transfer marijuana to a recreational marijuana Retailer. For usable marijuana from a medical grow site to reach a recreational marijuana Retailer, the usable marijuana would first need to be transferred to a recreational marijuana Wholesaler.
