On January 13, 2026, Applicant entered into a non-disciplinary Consent Agreement for Re-Entry to Practice with the Board. In this Agreement, Applicant agreed to practice under the supervision of a pre-approved acupuncturist mentor for 600 hours.

On December 18, 2025, Applicant entered into a non-disciplinary Consent Agreement for Re-Entry to Practice with the Board. In this Agreement, agreed to practice under the supervision of a pre-approved physician mentor for 1,000 hours.

3 ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a)  
4 any conduct or practice contrary to recognized standards of ethics of the medical profession, and  
5 ORS 677.188(4)(a) conduct which does or might constitute a danger to health of a patient; ORS  
6 677.190(13) repeated acts of negligence in the practice of medicine; and ORS 677.190(13) gross  
7 negligence in the practice of medicine. Licensee understands that this Order is a public record  
8 and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and the  
9 Federation of State Medical Boards.

11 Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this  
12 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions:

13 4.1 Licensee is reprimanded.

14 4.2 Licensee retires his Oregon medical license while under investigation and agrees  
15 to never reapply for a medical license in the State of Oregon.

16 4.3 The July 11, 2025, Interim Stipulated Order terminates upon the effective date of  
17 this Stipulated Order.

18 4.4 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining  
19 to the practice of medicine.

20 4.5 Licensee stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall  
21 be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Gerald Francis Farnell, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

2.

On April 30, 2024, the Board opened an investigation after receiving credible information regarding Licensee’s possible violation of the Medical Practice Act, specifically kissing and sexually explicit communication with a patient. On May 9, 2024, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order with the Board to voluntarily withdraw from practice and place his license in Inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation.

3.

Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183) and, by the signing and issuance of this Order, Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing, understands and acknowledges that this order is not subject to judicial review, and acknowledges and agrees that this Order was signed freely, without fraud or duress. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that Licensee engaged in conduct that violated the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional conduct, defined as conduct unbecoming a person licensed to practice medicine or detrimental to the best interest of the public, specifically ORS 677.188(4)(a)

1 any conduct or practice contrary to recognized standards of ethics of the medical profession and  
2 OAR 847-010-0073(3)(b)(F)(i)(VI) kissing a patient in a romantic or sexual manner, and (ii)(IV)  
3 sexually explicit communication with a patient. Licensee understands that this Order is a public  
4 record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and  
5 the Federation of State Medical Boards.

7 Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this  
8 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions:

9 4.1 Licensee retires his Oregon medical license while under investigation, effective  
10 November 30, 2025.

11 4.2 Licensee must not reapply for a medical license in the State of Oregon for at least  
12 two years from November 30, 2025.

13 4.3 The May 9, 2024, Interim Stipulated Order terminates on November 30, 2025.

14 4.4 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining  
15 to the practice of medicine.

16 4.5 Licensee stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall  
17 be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

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This Order becomes effective the date it is signed by the Board Chair.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Keith Allen Johnson, MD, (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

2.

On November 7, 2024, the Board issued a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action (Notice) in which the Board proposed to take disciplinary action against Licensee pursuant to ORS 677.205(2), including reprimand; 30-day suspension; permanent practice restriction; comprehensive educational courses in psychotherapy, psychopharmacology, and medical record keeping; \$10,000 fine; and assessment of costs of any contested case hearing on the matter not to exceed \$40,000. The Board proposed to take this disciplinary action for violations of the Medical Practice Act, specifically: ORS 677.190(13) repeated acts of negligence.

3.

Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by entry of this Stipulated Order. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183) and, by the signing and issuance of this Order, Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing, understands and acknowledges that this order is not subject to judicial review, and acknowledges and agrees that this Order was signed freely, without fraud or duress. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that Licensee's conduct as described in the November 7, 2024, Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action violated ORS 677.190(13). Licensee understands that this Order is a public

1 record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and  
2 the Federation of State Medical Boards.

3 4.

4 Licensee and the Board agree to resolve this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order  
5 subject to the following terms and conditions:

6 4.1 Licensee must pay a civil penalty of \$10,000, with \$7,500 to be paid within 90  
7 days from the effective date of this Order. The remaining \$2,500 is held in abeyance and shall be  
8 waived upon successful and timely completion of all other terms of this Order. If Licensee fails  
9 to comply with the terms of this Order, the \$2,500 held in abeyance shall be due and payable.

10 4.2 *CPEP educational plan.* Licensee must complete a Center for Personalized  
11 Education for Professionals (CPEP) educational plan (“the plan”) and any post-education  
12 evaluation. The plan must be approved by the Board’s Medical Director. Licensee must sign all  
13 releases to allow full communication and exchange of documents and reports among the Board,  
14 CPEP, and any mentors, ensure CPEP submits the evaluation reports directly to the Board, and  
15 bear all costs associated with completing the plan and any post-education evaluation. Upon  
16 successful completion of the plan, Licensee must provide the Board with written verification  
17 from CPEP of successful completion and that Licensee has complied with any education  
18 recommendations, practice modifications, post-education evaluation recommendations, and  
19 timelines set forth by CPEP. It is noted that Licensee has completed this term.

20 4.3 *Preceptor.* Licensee agrees to enter into an agreement with a licensed physician  
21 who is pre-approved by the Board’s Medical Director to serve as his preceptor in psychiatry and,  
22 specifically, psychotherapy. Licensee agrees to meet with the approved preceptor at least  
23 monthly for five years. For the first six months, the preceptor shall review on an ongoing basis at  
24 least 50% of charts for patients receiving psychotherapy with Licensee. After the initial six  
25 months, at the preceptor’s discretion, the chart review may be reduced to 25%. The preceptor is  
26 to provide quarterly written reports to the Board on Licensee’s demonstration of psychotherapy  
27 practice standards. Licensee may request to further reduce the meetings and chart review  
28 required by this term after one full year of compliance and four quarterly reports from the

1 preceptor. Licensee may request to terminate this term (4.3) in its entirety after two years of  
2 compliance and a written recommendation of termination from the preceptor.

3 4.4 At the discretion of the Board or its designees, random, no notice chart audits and  
4 office visits may be conducted by Board designees.

5 4.5 Licensee must inform the Compliance Section of the Board of any and all practice  
6 sites, as well as any changes in practice address(es), employment, or practice status within 10  
7 business days. Additionally, Licensee must notify the Compliance Section of any changes in  
8 contact information within 10 business days.

9 4.6 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining  
0 to the practice of medicine.

1 4.7 Licensee stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall  
2 be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

3 4.8 Licensee stipulates and agrees that this Order becomes effective the date it is  
4 signed by the Board Chair.

2 Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order  
3 which is a final order of the Board. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case  
4 hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183) and, by  
5 the signing and issuance of this Order, Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested  
6 case hearing, understands and acknowledges that this order is not subject to judicial review, and  
7 acknowledges and agrees that this Order was signed freely, without fraud or duress. Licensee  
8 neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that Licensee engaged in conduct as described in  
9 the October 2, 2025, Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action, and that this conduct violated the  
10 Medical Practice Act, specifically ORS 677.190(17). The Board did not reach a conclusion  
11 regarding Licensee's alleged violation of ORS 677.190(1)(a) as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a).  
12 Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that Licensee willfully violated the  
13 Board's Order for Evaluation by failing to participate as directed in an assessment that was to be  
14 conducted by Acumen Assessments, and that this conduct violated the Medical Practice Act, to  
15 wit, ORS 677.190(17). Licensee understands that this Order is a public record and is a  
16 disciplinary action that is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of  
17 State Medical Boards.

19 Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this  
20 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions:

21 4.1 Licensee's Oregon medical license is revoked.

22 4.2 Licensee agrees to never reapply for a medical license in the State of Oregon.

23 4.3 The February 2, 2024, Interim Stipulated Order terminates effective the date the  
24 Board Chair signs this Stipulated Order.

25 4.4 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining  
26 to the practice of medicine.

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
