On July 1, 2021, the Board issued an Order Terminating Consent Agreement for Re-Entry to Practice. This Order terminates Licensee's November 1, 2019, Consent Agreement for Re-Entry to Practice.

Douglass, Kristen Marie, MD; SX206767; Tualatin, OR

On July 12, 2021, Applicant entered into a non-disciplinary Consent Agreement for Re-Entry to Practice with the Board. In this Agreement, Applicant agreed to practice under the supervision of a pre-approved physician mentor for 2,000 hours, to include reports to the Board by the mentor; pass the Special Purpose Examination within six months; and obtain certification from the American Board of Pediatrics.

On July 1, 2021, Licensee entered into a Stipulated Order with the Board for unprofessional or dishonorable conduct and repeated acts of negligence. This Order assesses a \$7,500 civil penalty; prohibits Licensee from obtaining, purchasing, leasing, or using any equipment for vestibular or balance testing; and prohibits Licensee from performing allergy testing and treating chronic environmental allergies by desensitization injections.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Vladimir Borisovich Fiks, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

On May 28, 2020, the Board issued a Complaint and Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action (Notice) in which the Board proposed taking disciplinary action by imposing up to the maximum range of potential sanctions identified in ORS 677.205(2), which may include the revocation of license, a \$10,000 civil penalty per violation, and assessment of costs, against Licensee for violations of the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a) any conduct or practice contrary to recognized standards of ethics of the medical profession, or any conduct or practice which does or might constitute a danger to the health or safety of a patient or the public, ORS 677.188(4)(b) willful performance of any surgical or medical treatment which is contrary to acceptable medical standard, and ORS 677.188(4)(c) willful and repeated ordering or performance of unnecessary laboratory tests; administration of unnecessary treatment; employment of outmoded, unproved or unscientific treatments; or otherwise utilizing medical service for diagnosis or treatment which is or may be considered inappropriate or unnecessary; and ORS 677.190(13) repeated acts of negligence.

2 Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by entry of this Stipulated Order.
3 Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative
4 Procedures Act (chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes. Licensee fully and finally waives the
5 right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this
6 Order in the Board's records. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that
7 Licensee's conduct as described in the March 27, 2020, Complaint and Notice of Proposed
8 Disciplinary Action violated ORS 677.190(1)(a), as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a), ORS
9 677.188(4)(b), and ORS 677.188(4)(c); and ORS 677.190(13). Licensee understands that this
10 Order is a public record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the National Practitioner
11 Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.

13 Licensee and the Board agree to resolve this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order
14 subject to the following terms and conditions:

15 4.1 Licensee must pay a civil penalty of \$7,500 within six months from the effective
16 date of this Order. Licensee may make payments, as long as no payment, excepting the final
17 payment, is less than \$100.

18 4.2 Licensee must not obtain, purchase, lease, or use any equipment used for the sole
19 purpose of vestibular or balance testing.

20 4.3 Licensee must not perform allergy testing for any patient nor treat chronic
21 environmental allergies by desensitization injections.

22 4.4 Licensee must inform the Compliance Section of the Board of any and all practice
23 sites, as well as any changes in practice address(es), employment, or practice status within 10
24 business days. Additionally, Licensee must notify the Compliance Section of any changes in
25 contact information within 10 business days.

26 4.5 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining
27 to the practice of medicine.

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1 4.6 Licensee stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall
2 be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

3 4.7 Licensee stipulates and agrees that this Order becomes effective the date it is
4 signed by the Board Chair.

On February 25, 2021, the Board issued a Complaint and Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action (Notice) which may include the revocation of license, a \$10,000 civil penalty per violation, and assessment of costs, against Licensee for violations of the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a) any conduct or practice contrary to recognized standards of ethics of the medical profession; and ORS 677.190(17) willful violation of any provision of ORS chapter 677 or any Board rule, specifically ORS 677.320(6) and OAR 874-001-0022(1) and (2). Licensee filed a timely appearance with the Board and requested a contested case hearing. Licensee neither admits nor denies the Board's allegations.

Licensee and the Board now desire to settle this matter by entry of this Agreement. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes. Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this Agreement in the Board's records. The Board agrees to close the current investigation and does not make a finding in regard to any violation of the Medical Practice Act. This Agreement is a

1 public document; however, it is not a disciplinary action. This document is reportable to the
2 Federation of State Medical Boards.

4 In order to address the concerns of the Board and for purposes of resolving this
5 investigation, Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation
6 contingent upon Licensee agreeing to the following conditions:


7 4.1 Within six months of the effective date of this Agreement, Licensee agrees to
8 complete a professionalism course that has been pre-approved by the Board's Medical Director.

9 4.2 Licensee agrees to inform the Compliance Section of the Board of any and all
10 practice sites, as well as any changes in practice address(es), employment, or practice status
11 within 10 business days. Additionally, Licensee agrees to notify the Compliance Section of any
12 changes in contact information within 10 business days.

13 4.3 Licensee agrees to obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations
14 pertaining to the practice of medicine.

15 4.4 Licensee agrees that any violation of the terms of this Agreement constitutes
16 grounds to take disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183), and fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this Order in the Board's records. - 4.4 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining to the practice of medicine.
- 4.5 Licensee stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Peter Geon-Sang Lee, MD (Applicant) submitted an application for unlimited license to practice medicine in the State of Oregon.

2.1 Applicant submitted an application to the Board on November 25, 2019. Upon review of the application it was discovered that Applicant failed to provide complete and accurate answers to personal history questions. Prior to submitting the application, Applicant attested that all statements and answers on the submitted application were true and correct and that any omissions or false statements were grounds for denial of the application to practice medicine.

2.2 Failure to provide complete and accurate answers on a license application in the State of Oregon is a violation of ORS 677.190(8) and OAR 847-008-0058, fraud or misrepresentation in applying for or procuring a license to practice in this state, and is grounds for disciplinary action.

Applicant and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order. Applicant understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183), and fully and finally waives the right to a

1 contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this Order in the
2 Board's records. Applicant neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that Applicant
3 engaged in conduct that violated the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(8) fraud or
4 misrepresentation in applying for or procuring a license to practice in this state. Applicant
5 understands that this Order is a public record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the
6 National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.

8 Applicant and the Board agree that the Board will resolve and close this matter by entry
9 of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions:

10 4.1 Applicant withdraws his application to practice medicine in the State of Oregon
11 while under investigation.

12 4.2 Applicant agrees not to apply for licensure in the State of Oregon for a period of
13 two years from the effective date of this Order as provided in OAR 847-020-0185(3).

14 4.3 Applicant must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining
15 to the practice of medicine.

16 4.4 Applicant stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall
17 be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Thomas Philip McWeeney, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

2.2 On February 25, 2021, the Board issued an Amended Complaint and Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action (Notice) in which the Board proposed to take disciplinary action by imposing up to the maximum range of potential sanctions identified in ORS 677.205(2), which may include the revocation of license, a \$10,000 civil penalty, and assessment of costs, against Licensee for violations of the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a) and (b); ORS 677.190(8) fraud or misrepresentation in applying for or procuring a license to practice in this state, as defined in ORS 677.188(1); ORS 677.190(13) repeated negligence in the practice of medicine; ORS 677.190(17) violation of a Board order; and ORS 677.190(26) failure to report to

1 the Board any adverse action taken against Licensee by a health care institution or professional
2 or medical society or association for acts or conduct similar to acts or conduct that would
3 constitute grounds for disciplinary described in the Medical Practice Act, including ORS
4 677.190(14) incapacity or incompetence. Licensee responded to the Board's Amended
5 Complaint and Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action by denying the allegations and requesting

However, as a stipulation this Order is a public document and is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards. This Order becomes effective the date it is signed by the Board's Executive Director in accordance with OAR 847-001-0030.
