

Oregon Medical Board
BOARD ACTION REPORT
June 15, 2016

The information contained in this report summarizes new, interim, and final actions taken by the Oregon Medical Board between May 16, 2016, and June 15, 2016.

Scanned copies of Interim Stipulated Orders, Orders of Emergency Suspension, Stipulated Orders, Final Orders, Termination Orders, Modification Orders and Voluntary Limitations are included at the end of this report in the order that they appear in the report. These orders are marked with an * asterisk. **Scanned copies of Consent Agreements are not posted, as they are not disciplinary action and impose no practice limitations.** Complaint and Notices of Proposed Disciplinary Action are not listed in this report, as they are not final actions by the Board. Both Orders, however, are public and are available upon request.

Busby, Dean Joseph, MD; MD23338; Bend, OR

On May 26, 2016, Licensee entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board. In this Agreement, Licensee agreed to complete the terms of his CPEP re-entry plan to include a preceptorship monitored by CPEP.

***Dossey, Brian Lane, MD; MD153277; Medford, OR**

On May 26, 2016, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order to voluntarily cease the authorization of medical marijuana cards to patients under the age of 18 pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

***Estevez, Miguel, MD; MD160337; Springfield, OR**

On May 26, 2016, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order to voluntarily withdraw from practice and place his license in Inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

***Parker, Gregory James, MD; MD152156; Hood River, OR**

On June 3, 2016, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order to voluntarily cease providing hospital care, participating in deliveries or C-sections, and taking call after regular

office hours pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

Skrzynski, Mary Claire, MD; MD19014; Bend, OR

On May 25, 2016, Licensee entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board. In this Agreement, Licensee agreed to practice in accordance with her re-entry plan to include practicing under the supervision of a Board-approved mentor.

At the conclusion of the Board's investigation, the Board will decide whether to close the case or to proceed to some form of disciplinary action. If the Board determines, following that review, not to lift the requirements of this Order, Licensee may request a hearing to contest that decision.

5.

This order is issued by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.410, which grants the Board the authority to attach conditions to the license of Licensee to practice medicine. These conditions will remain in effect while the Board conducts a complete investigation in order to fully inform itself with respect to the conduct of Licensee. Pursuant to ORS 677.425, Board investigative materials are confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure, nor shall they be admissible as evidence in any judicial proceeding. However, as a stipulation this Order is a public document and is reportable to the National Databank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain healthcare providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. Miguel Estevez, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon.

2.

The Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board initiating an investigation. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised concerns to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to cease the practice of medicine until the investigation is completed.

3.

In order to address the concerns of the Board, Licensee and the Board agree to enter into this Interim Stipulated Order, which is not an admission of any wrongdoing on the part of the Licensee, and provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions effective the date this Order is signed by Licensee:

3.1 Licensee voluntarily withdraws from the practice of medicine and his license is placed in Inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

3.2 Licensee understands that violating any term of this Order will be grounds for disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

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4.

At the conclusion of the Board's investigation, Licensee's status will be reviewed in an expeditious manner. Following that review, if the Board determines that Licensee shall not be permitted to return to the practice of medicine, Licensee may request a hearing to contest that decision.

This Order is issued by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.265(1) and (2) for the purpose of protecting the public, and making a complete investigation in order to fully inform itself with respect to the performance or conduct of the Licensee and Licensee's ability to safely and competently practice medicine. Pursuant to ORS 677.425, Board investigative materials are confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure. However, as a stipulation this Order is a public document and is reportable to the national Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.

This Order becomes effective the date it is signed by the Licensee.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain healthcare providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. Gregory James Parker, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon.

2.

The Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board initiating an investigation. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised concerns to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to restrict his practice of medicine until the investigation is completed.

3.

In order to address the concerns of the Board, Licensee and the Board agree to enter into this Interim Stipulated Order, which is not an admission of any wrongdoing on the part of the Licensee, and provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions effective the date this Order is signed by Licensee:

- 3.1 Licensee must not provide hospital care and must not participate in deliveries or C-sections.
- 3.2 Licensee must not take any call after regular office hours.
- 3.3 Licensee must only practice in a clinic setting with another licensed physician that is board certified, and on site, acting as a practice supervisor. The practice supervisor must be pre-approved by the Board's Medical Director and will provide weekly reports to the Board.
