On December 3, 2021, Applicant entered into a non-disciplinary Consent Agreement for Re-Entry to Practice with the Board. In this Agreement, Applicant agreed to practice under the supervision of a pre-approved physician mentor for 1,000 hours and obtain certification from the American Board of Pediatrics.

On December 2, 2021, Licensee entered into a Stipulated Order with the Board. With this Order, Licensee withdraws his reactivation application while under investigation.

#### Meier, Douglas Lloyd, MD; MD21730; Milwaukie, OR

On December 2, 2021, the Board issued an Order Terminating Corrective Action Agreement. This Order terminates Licensee's July 10, 2020, Corrective Action Agreement.

#### Sticker, Carol Lynne, PA; PA194156; Tigard, OR

On December 13, 2021, Licensee entered into a non-disciplinary Consent Agreement for Re-Entry to Practice with the Board. In this Agreement, Licensee agreed to specific requirements regarding supervision and chart review from her supervising physician, and that her supervising physician would submit reports to the Board regarding her progress in her return to the practice of medicine.

11	Oregon. John Edward Hamby, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician (Inactive status) in the

14	On May 19, 2021, Licensee submitted an application to reactivate his Oregon license to
15	Active status. During the review of this application, concerns were noted regarding Licensee's
16	qualifications and fitness for an Oregon medical license. Pursuant to ORS 677.175(2) and ORS
17	677.415(2), the Board undertook further review of Licensee's reactivation application.

19	Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order.
20	Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative
21	Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183), and fully and finally waives the right to a
22	contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this Order in the
23	Board's records. Licensee understands that this Order is a public record and is a disciplinary
24	action that is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State
25	Medical Boards. Licensee understands the terms of this Order and signs freely, without fraud or
26	duress.
