RULE TITLE: Prescription Drug Monitoring Program

RULE SUMMARY: The rule aligns with the requirement in HB 4143 (2018) for all Board licensees to register for the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) if they have a United States Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) registration to prescribe in Oregon. The Oregon Health Authority adopted OAR 333-023-0825 to implement the requirement in HB 4143 (2018). The Board's proposed rule mirrors the OHA rule and provides clear notification of the requirement for Board licensees to register for PDMP.

### RULE TEXT:

- (1) A licensee with an active registration status and an active United States Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) registration to prescribe in Oregon must register with the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program established under ORS 431A.855.
- (2) New licensees with an active DEA registration must register with the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program as specified in section (1) of this rule, within 30 calendar days of Oregon licensure or DEA registration, whichever is later.
