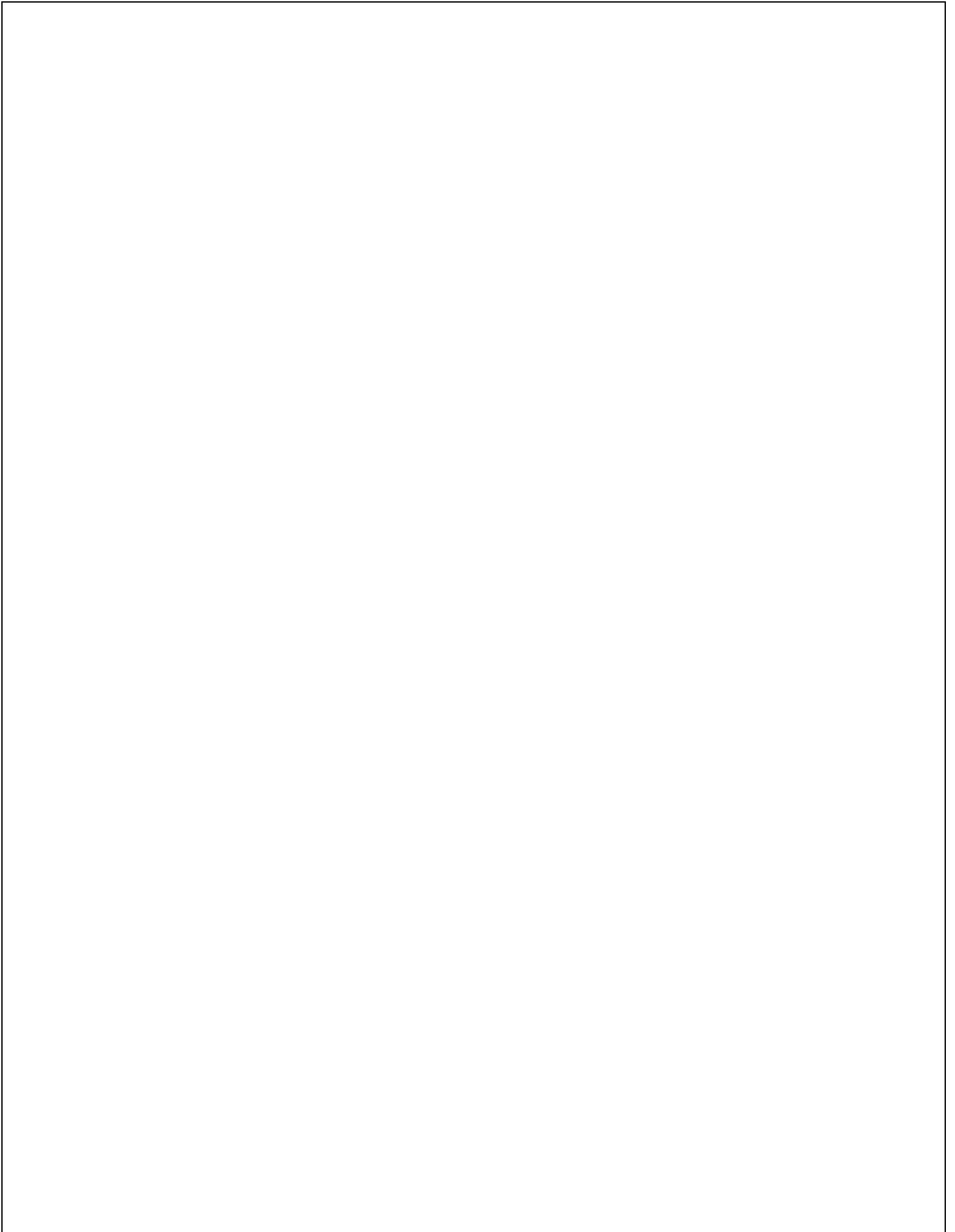

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**STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT AND UNDERSTANDING  
Required for Air National Guard of the United States (ANGUS) Appointment**

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Place full initials next to every statement to indicate that it has been read and understood. Include middle initial. Place 'N/A' next to statements that don't apply. Once you have read and initialed indicating your understanding of the statements, print your full name in the name block on page 2, sign in the signature block, and date document.

	<p><b>1. (ALL APPLICANTS)</b> Any initial skills training required for full qualification in the appointment specialty is considered a condition of appointment. I agree to enter training within 24 months unless otherwise authorized in the Air Force Officer Classification Directory (AFOCD), in which case, I agree to complete training within three years of appointment. I understand that failure to attend such training, or elimination from such training, may result in separation from the ANG.</p>
	<p><b>2. (ALL APPLICANTS)</b> I certify I am ____ / am not ____, a Key Federal Employee. In the event I am identified as a Key Federal Employee, I understand I must present a Certificate of Availability from my civilian employment indicating that, in the event of a partial or full mobilization, I will be available for active military duty. (See DAFMAN 36-2032, para. 3.7.5 and attachment 28).</p>
	<p><b>3. (ALL APPLICANTS)</b> I certify I am ____ / am not ____, single, divorced, separated, or married to a military (or common law) spouse WITH custody or joint custody of at least one dependent. (See DAFMAN 36-2032, para.5.4.11.3.).</p>
	<p><b>4. (INITIAL ACCESSION or COMMISSION/WARRANT INTO THE ANG)</b> I understand that attending all required training is mandatory for commissioning. I agree to remain a member of the ANGUS for a period of <b>eight (8) years</b> from the date of my appointment to satisfy my initial Military Service Obligation (MSO) in accordance with Title 10 U.S.C. §651 and DoDI 1304.25.</p> <p>I further understand that this MSO will run <b>concurrently</b> with any other service commitments I have or may incur, including those resulting from commissioning, bonuses, or training, as determined by FSS or FDO</p>
	<p><b>5. (ALL APPLICANTS EXCEPT UNDERGRADUATE FLYING TRAINING {UFT})</b> I understand that my appointment is being accomplished prior to completion of the required security investigation. I further understand that if I fail to meet these requirements within 180 days from the date of temporary federal recognition, I will be determined unacceptable for appointment as a commissioned officer and will be discharged from my appointment and receive an Honorable Discharge Certificate.</p>
	<p><b>6. (UNDERGRADUATE FLYING TRAINING {UFT} APPLICANTS ONLY)</b> I agree to remain a member of the ANGUS for a period of <b>TEN (10) years</b> from the date of graduation from UFT. I understand that this service commitment will be served concurrently, unless otherwise specified, with any other service commitments I have or may incur. 10 USC § 653 and DAFMAN 36-2139.</p>
	<p><b>7. (COMBAT SYSTEMS {CSO}, REMOTELY PILOTED AIRCRAFT {RPA}, or AIR BATTLE MANAGER {ABM} TRAINING APPLICANTS ONLY)</b> I agree to remain a member of the ANGUS for a period of <b>SIX (6) years</b> from the date of graduation from CSO/RPA/ABM training. I understand that this service commitment will be served concurrently, unless otherwise specified, with any other service commitments I have or may incur. 10 USC § 653 and DAFMAN 36-2139.</p>
	<p><b>8. (ALL RATED APPLICANTS – except OTS)</b> I understand that I will not be authorized to perform flying duties until receipt of temporary federal recognition and valid aeronautical orders.</p>
	<p><b>9. (COMMISSIONING APPLICANTS ONLY)</b> I agree to attend officer training school (OTS) within 12 months of temporary appointment approval. I understand appointment will occur upon completion OTS graduation.</p>
	<p><b>10. (INITIAL APPOINTMENT OF HEALTH PROFESSIONALS)</b> I agree to attend Commissioned Officer Training (COT) within 12 months of my appointment. I understand that attendance is required for commissioning. If I fail to meet these requirements, I may be found <b>unacceptable for appointment</b> and <b>discharged</b> under DAFI 36-3211.</p>
	<p><b>11. (APPOINTMENT OF HEALTH PROFESSIONALS)</b> I understand that I will be appointed in the ANG; however, I will not be granted privileges to practice until medical credentials have been completed IAW AFI 44-119.</p>
	<p><b>12. (HEALTH PROFESSIONAL APPLICANTS WITH 18 OR MORE YEARS OF CONSTRUCTIVE SERVICE CREDIT)</b> I understand that appointment in the grade of lieutenant colonel requires approval by the Secretary of War and that this process may add several months to my application processing time. If I otherwise qualify for appointment in the grade of lieutenant colonel, I hereby consent to and request appointment as a major pending approval by the Secretary of War. In the event the Secretary of War does</p>

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	not approve my name, I understand that I may be honorably discharged from all appointments. DAFMAN 36-2032.
	<b>13. (CHAPLAINS, MEDICAL, DENTAL, NURSE, AND BIOMEDICAL SCIENCE CORPS)</b> I have been counseled and understand that I may request to be retained in an active status beyond my Mandatory Separation Date to enable me to obtain 20 satisfactory years of service or to age 68, whichever is earlier. I understand that I must remain qualified for active status in an ANG or AFRES program; otherwise, my status may be terminated under provisions of law or instruction prior to my reaching age 68.
	<b>14. (EARLY COMMISSIONING PROGRAM {ECP} APPLICANTS)</b> I understand that I am applying for appointment in the ANGUS under the ECP for physicians. If approved for appointment, I will be appointed as a Medical Service Corps (MSC) Officer until such time as I am appointed to the Medical Corps (MC). a. I will serve within the ANG as directed, unless sooner relieved by competent authority, for a minimum period of FOUR (4) to EIGHT (8) years from the date I am appointed as a physician. I further agree to remain a member of the Ready Reserve during the tenure of my appointment as an ANG officer. b. If I fail to complete the requirement for award of a Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Osteopathy degree acceptable to the Air Force Surgeon General, the Chief, National Guard Bureau will then withdraw my federal recognition and I could be separated from the ANGUS.
	<b>15. (INITIAL APPOINTMENT AS A CHAPLAIN)</b> I agree to attend Officer Training School (OTS) and the Basic Chaplain Course within 24 months of my appointment.
	<b>16. INITIAL APPOINTMENT AS A JUDGE ADVOCATE)</b> I agree to attend Officer Training School (OTS) before attendance at the Judge Advocate Training. I also agree to attend the Judge Advocate State Officer Course (JASOC) within two years of taking my oath as a commissioned officer in the ANG and attend the ANG Law Office Course (ANGLOC) no later than 18 months after accession. (See DAFI 51-101).
	<b>17. (APPLICANTS RECEIVING SEVERANCE/SEPARATION PAY)</b> I have been counseled and understand the following information from DoD 7000.14-R, DoD Financial Management Regulation. a. A member who has received Special Separation Benefit (SSB) and who later qualified for retired or retainer pay shall have deducted a portion of such retired or retainer pay until an amount equal to the gross amount of such SSB has been deducted. The portion deducted shall be equal to a fraction determined by dividing the years of service for which the member received SSB by the total years of service used in computing the member's retired or retainer pay."
	<b>18. (APPLICANTS UNABLE TO OBTAIN 20 YEARS OF SERVICE)</b> I understand that I will not be able to obtain 20 satisfactory years of service towards a full military retirement
	<b>19. (WARRANT OFFICER COMMISSIONING APPLICANTS ONLY)</b> I agree to attend Warrant Officer Training School (WOTS). I understand I will receive a Reserve Service Commitment of 5 years upon WOTS graduation.
	<b>20. (ALL APPLICANTS)</b> I agree to attend Warrant Officer Training School (WOTS). I understand that upon graduation, I will incur a <b>five-year Reserve Service Commitment (RSC)</b> , which will run <b>concurrently with my statutory MSO</b> , unless otherwise directed by policy.
	<b>21. (ALL APPLICANTS)</b> I certify that I have ____ / have not ____ been non-selected for promotion to the next higher grade. a. Number of times non-selected ____ (if applicable).
	<b>22. (ALL APPLICANTS)</b> I understand if I make a fraudulent statement, I am subject to immediate discharge action.
