Who may apply: Current on-board members of the 142d Wing. Current on-board members in the Oregon Air National Guard. Members eligible to join the Oregon Air National Guard.

Special Duty Summary:

Produces all-source intelligence, situation estimates, order-of-battle studies, and other intelligence reports. Advises commanders on force protection and intelligence information for US and allied forces. Prepares and disseminates mission reports. Conducts intelligence training. Instructs Combat Controller (CCT), Pararescuemen (PJ), Special Reconnaissance (SR), Combat Rescue Officer (CRO), and Special Tactics Officer (STO), Tactical Air Control Party (TAC-P) personnel on all-domain threats to include enemy capabilities, equipment, and order of battle. Collates intelligence and operations materials and assembles final products for mission briefings and training materials. Produces intelligence materials. Prepares, maintains, and presents intelligence displays, reports and briefings. Compiles, evaluates, researches, interprets, analyzes, and disseminates intelligence information. Assembles maps, charts, and target materials. Establishes intelligence collection requirements. Identifies and establishes unit requirements for intelligence reference materials. Maintains intelligence reference files. Uses intelligence automated data systems to store, retrieve, display, and report intelligence information. Performs mission planning and execution support. Provides tailored collections planning, threat analysis, and intelligence expertise necessary to develop detailed execution plans for air-ground operations. Develops conflict scenarios, manages threat replication, provides current situational awareness, and manages Intelligence Surveillance and Reconnaissance (ISR) assets during training exercise operations. Analyzes intelligence to support military operations and targeting. Processes, exploits, and disseminates intelligence products and conducts analysis concerning threat countries or targets of interest via written and/or verbal means. These products provide specificity and knowledge to commanders to impact tactical through operational-level decision making processes.

HOW TO APPLY:

If the applicant is NOT currently in the Guard, it is recommended that the person reach out to Retention & Recruiting to further assist.

Application package will consist of a resume detailing your experience, military and civilian education, a record review RIP (from vMPF) with in 60 days, Official Air Force Biography and a copy of current Physical Fitness Assessment. All applications will need to be submitted in a single PDF <5MB.
