DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Oversees the unit's On-the-Job Training (OJT) program, including Upgrade Training (UGT) and Qualification Training (QT). Manages Career Development Courses (CDCs), including enrollment, testing, and tracking. Reviews and processes 2096s (AFSC-awarding courses, engine run, borescope, etc.).
2. Provides the Commander and maintenance leadership with the Training Performance Metrics (TPM) briefings. Identifies training trends, deficiencies, and provides solutions to improve the unit's mission-ready posture.
3. Maintains and audits electronic training records (using systems like myLearning, DAFLR, Envision, TFAT, and maintenance-specific databases like IMDS). Ensures Special Experience Identifiers (SEIs) and task certifications are properly documented.
4. Conducts internal Staff Assistance Visits (SAVs) and work center audits to ensure compliance with AFIs and Major Command (MAJCOM) supplements. Prepares the unit for Inspector General (IG) inspections.

5. Coordinates with the Base Training for formal school slots.
6. Manages ancillary and expeditionary training requirements to ensure deployment readiness.
