## Sibling Groups

Parent or Guardian client	Report only one case, using the case number for the eldest of the client's children in the case number field. Report other case numbers in the comments field.
Child Client	Report each child client separately. Use the base code for the eldest child of the sibling group, and the "X" code for each other child. If a single child has more than one dependency petition, report the earliest in the case number field and any others in the comments field.

## Disposition Codes

<b>JUDP</b>	The Court finds Jurisdiction either after either settlement or an adjudicative hearing
<b>JUNF</b>	Jurisdiction is not found following an adjudicative hearing
<b>DIVR</b>	The client enters into a Diversion or a Conditional Discharge agreement
<b>COM</b>	The client is committed to OYA.
<b>CONT</b>	The client is continued on probation after a probation violation hearing
<b>EMAN</b>	The client is emancipated
<b>WAIV</b>	The client is waived into adult court.
<b>PRT</b>	Parental rights are terminated either by settlement or after an adjudicative hearing
<b>TERM</b>	Jurisdiction and wardship are terminated
<b>WTBN</b>	Youth is subject to a Protective Custody Warrant for 180 days
<b>WTHD</b>	The court has granted a motion to withdraw.
<b>DSM</b>	The case is dismissed for reasons not otherwise specified
<b>OTPA</b>	Other Post-adjudicative disposition
<b>OTHR</b>	Disposition not otherwise specified
