Application Update

Ian – updated the committee on contacts made over the past couple of months. As of now, no new applications have been received. Umatilla County has some county roads open. Union County - La Grande is looking to adopt a county wide ordinance to open up roads. We’re not expecting an application from Union County. Lakeside is having a town hall meeting in April. They are looking to potentially open up their city roads. Barrett – if the city went forward with a proposal, we would engage with them on phase II. Ian – they would have to pass that ordinance first.

Grant Application Discussion

Barrett – after the last week’s round of grant presentations, he is recognizing that on-road use would become a growing part of our law enforcement expenditures. Several people spoke about on-road contacts with ATVs and it’s becoming part of the program.

Last meeting for Angela
