Tuesday, February 12, 2013

Committee Business

Chair Custer called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Steve Kay, Grants Division Manager: Self introduction. Steve explained his role at OPRD and with the ATV staff and committee.

Roger Roper, Heritage and Community Programs Manager: Self-introduction. He talked about streamlining the funding process for standard LE and O&M projects. This will be discussed again in April. We had previously discussed using an Inter-governmental Agreement however since then we have determined that was not the best tool. Instead we will continue with to standard Grants Agreement then provide extensions beyond the two year period.

Tim: Notes his concerns about providing long-term agreements due to the increase funds designated to agencies other than OPRD by the Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO).

Rod: Expresses his budget concerns for long-term grants, specifically for agencies that may receive funding without having to make a presentation before the committee.

Ron and Rod discussed assistance provided by the Oregon State Police and game officers for ATV-related issues.

New Business

Ron: Discussed upcoming proposed ATV legislation.

- HB 2725 would direct OPRD to provide 4"x7" license plates for ATVs. We are required by statute to limit the costs for the current sticker to \$10. Roger will be meeting with the bill sponsor, Representative Buckley, to discuss this bill in further detail. The purpose is for identification only.

Tim: Would like to it to go back to titles and adding information to tag to identify. We had talked with the dealers about increasing the sticker fee to \$15 then give \$2 of that fee to the dealers.

Roger: Suggested putting a stakeholder meeting together to further discuss this concept.

Ron:

SB 238 - allows motorcycle riders under age seven (7) on public lands under certain circumstances

SB 390 - Expands offense of carrying minor on external part of motor vehicle to include all passengers.

HB 2404 - Permits person 21 years of age or older to operate motorcycle without wearing approved motorcycle helmet if person has motor vehicle liability insurance that provides personal injury protection benefits. This does not change OHV use, just street legal motorcycles on the highway.

Rod: Announces his resignation from the Coos County Sheriff's Office effective January 31, 2013 thus he will be resigning as the Law Enforcement ATV committee member effective December 31, 2013.

Ron: Will write a letter to the Sheriff's Association to request an ATV law enforcement replacement for the committee.

Ron: Land exchange in Jacksonville

Tim: Co-chair and chairperson positions. He proposes rotating these positions if interested, although we are not required to do so by rule. We can make a decision in April for the chair and co-chair positions in 2014.

Wade: Suggests having transition period.

Rod: Still has a lot of contact with law enforcement issues and will be available as a resource; just not at the law enforcement representative
