Title: Collier 242 Fire – Campground Entrance Improvement Project

Location: Collier Memorial State Park

Description: This project includes improving and replacing several critical infrastructure elements at the campground entrance. Improving park operations and accessibility for all are key factors in this project. Specific projects elements as follows;

- Replacing the campground wood shed and storage building burned in the 242 fire.
- Installing a campground registration kiosk
- Installing a trash/recycle facility
- Developing a paved overflow parking area.
- Realigning the roadway for improved campground access and providing additional lanes for the registration kiosk and trash/recycle area.
- Restoring the RV dump station area for accessibility and improved function.
- Install two vehicle access gates.
- Restore landscaped areas at the campground entrance.
