Topic: Heceta Head Lighthouse SSV – Siuslaw School Dist. Inholding

Heceta Head Lighthouse State Scenic Viewpoint (SSV) encompasses approximately 549 acres on both sides of Highway 101 in Lane County. The Heceta Head Lighthouse sits 206 feet above the Pacific Ocean and is believed to be the most photographed on the Oregon Coast. The lands were acquired by the State Parks system dating back to the 1930's. This scenic viewpoint, located twelve miles north of Florence, offers hiking trails, marine mammal and bird watching, and other outdoor activities that have welcomed state park visitors for decades.

Staff recently identified a one-acre parcel, an in holding to this park, that is owned by the Siuslaw School District. This vacant parcel is in the immediate area of the Heceta Head Lighthouse parking lot. With OPRD owning the surrounding land, by acquiring this parcel it would align with our park planning, eliminate possible management issues, and support the operation as state park land.

Recent valuation activities have determined the property to be valued at \$45,000 and the school district has agreed to sell the property to OPRD at that value.

Staff asks that Commission approve the acquisition of this one-acre parcel.
