	<b>Accredited Main Street</b>	<p>The Accredited Main Street level recognizes exemplary achievement by a local main street organization and the impact they are having through collaborative partnerships on preserving and enhancing their historic downtown or traditional commercial neighborhood.</p>
	<b>Designated Main Street</b>	<p>The Designated Main Street level is reflects a commitment and dedicated effortsto building, growing, and sustaining successful historic downtown or commercial neighborhood improvement efforts by leveraging partnerships and engaging community.</p>
	<b>Affiliated Main Street</b>	<p>The Affiliate Main Street level is for communities who are just starting or growing their Main Street by leveraging the powerful main street methodology to create lasting impact in enhancing their historic downtown or commercial neighborhood.</p>
	<b>Rural Regional Main Street</b>	<p>Rural Regional Main Street is a regional tier that serves at least three communities under a designated hub organization. This tier serves small, rural communities that might not have the capacity to form a sustainable main street structure independently.</p>



	<b>Connected Communities</b>	<p>The Connected Communities level is for communities who care about their historic downtown or neighborhood commercial district and want to access to information to help them make a difference. Communities at this level may be organized around a specific project or activity to enhance their community.</p>
