

APPENDIX I NEED FOR MAJOR REHABILITATION

ISSUE WORKSHOP PROCESS

During the SCORP planning process, OPRD completed a series of 11 regional workshops across the state. A primary objective of the workshops was to identify the top three Land & Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) issues related to land acquisition, facility development, and major rehabilitation in each of the 11 SCORP Planning Regions. The need for major rehabilitation of existing outdoor recreation facilities in the state was voted as a top regional LWCF issue in 9 of the 11 SCORP planning regions (see Figure I.1. below). As a result, the SCORP Advisory Committee selected the need for major rehabilitation of existing outdoor recreation facilities as a top Statewide Outdoor Recreation Issue.


Figure I.1. Need For Major Rehabilitation of Existing Outdoor Recreation Facilities



During the issues workshops, recreation providers consistently reported that the current recreational infrastructure in Oregon (e.g. utilities, roads, trails and buildings) is aging. A comment consistently voiced across the state was that those facilities built in the heyday of LWCF funding (see Figure I.2. below) are now over 20 to 30 years old and in need of major rehabilitation to extend their useful lives.

MEASURING THE NEED FOR MAJOR REHABILITATION

To better understand this reported need for major rehabilitation in the state, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department, with the assistance of the Oregon Recreation and Park Association, developed a method for collecting major rehabilitation data from non-federal, public-sector recreation providers across the state of Oregon.

The data collection process is designed to:

- develop a basic understanding of the relative health of the recreational infrastructure in the state,
- identify the specific types of facilities in need of major rehabilitation at the regional and statewide levels,
- identify the specific reasons why the facilities are in need of major rehabilitation at the regional and statewide level, and
- establish a baseline measurement for measuring rehabilitation progress across time.

The process also had to have the flexibility to collect reporting information from a wide range of recreation providers across the state including all non federal, public-sector providers.

For this reporting exercise, major rehabilitation was defined as follows.

Major rehabilitation projects involve the restoration or partial reconstruction of eligible recreation areas and facilities, which is necessitated by one or more of the following:

- the recreation area or facility is beyond its normal life expectancy,
- the recreation area or facility is destroyed by fire, natural disaster or vandalism,
- the recreation area or facility does not meet health and safety codes/requirements,
- the recreation area or facility requires rehabilitation to ensure critical natural resource protection,
- the recreation area or facility does not meet access requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act, and
- changing recreation needs (e.g. changes in demographics within the service area) dictate a change in the type of recreation area or facility provided.

Recreation providers were asked not to report routine maintenance or repair work as major rehabilitation. Routine maintenance/repair includes work such as cleanup, painting, and minor repairs of buildings, structures, equipment and utilities merely maintaining portions of such facilities in a sound and useful state.

The first step was to develop a complete package of reporting materials to allow outdoor recreation providers to report their facilities in need of major rehabilitation. The reporting packet included:

1. a cover letter requesting recreation provider assistance in major rehabilitation reporting,
2. a Major Rehabilitation Reporting Instruction Sheet describing the step-by-step reporting process,
3. a Facility and Reporting Measure List to ensure consistent facility reporting,
4. a Life Expectancy Schedule of Recreation Areas and Facilities to provide a basic understanding of the estimated life expectancy for each recreation area/facility, and
5. a SCORP Major Rehabilitation Reporting Form for reporting specific facilities in need of major rehabilitation and the primary reason for major rehabilitation.

A copy of each of these reporting packet items is included at the end of this appendix.

DATA COLLECTION

Data collection for major rehabilitation reporting was conducted over a period from March 4, 2002 to August 30, 2002. A reporting packet was sent to all non-federal, public-sector recreation providers reporting facilities in the 2001 Oregon Statewide Recreational Resources/Facility Inventory. A postage-paid return envelope was provided with each questionnaire mailing and follow-up mailings. A replacement questionnaire was mailed to providers who had not returned their completed reporting forms by July 15, 2002. A final phone call was made to each non-respondent during the week of August 12, 2002. Again, if the reporting packet was misplaced, another was mailed out. Major Rehabilitation Reporting Forms received after August 31, 2002 were not included in the reporting process.

After receiving completed reporting forms, the data was checked for reporting accuracy. Follow-up phone calls were made when necessary to verify data accuracy. The data was then entered into a Microsoft Access database. Major rehabilitation data was entered into the database for each of the 11 planning regions. Region level data was combined for statewide reporting purposes. This database was used to generate information included in the following tables (Tables I.1. through I.12.).

RECREATION PROVIDER RESPONSE

Reporting packets were initially sent out to 358 non-federal, public-sector recreation providers identified. These providers included all state agencies, county, municipal, port and special district recreation departments, and Native American Tribes. A total of 300 completed reporting forms were returned and entered into the major rehabilitation database. 51 providers failed to return a reporting form. The response rate for the major rehabilitation reporting process was 84%.

Dear Recreation Provider:

As you know, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) is currently in the process of developing a Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (SCORP) for the state of Oregon. As part of this planning effort, OPRD staff recently completed a series of eleven regional "recreational issues workshops" across the state. We would like to thank those who participated in these valuable workshops.

A primary objective of the "public provider" workshops was to identifying the top three Land & Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) issues (related to land acquisition, facility development, and major rehabilitation) in each of the eleven SCORP Planning Regions. This workshop process identified the *need for major rehabilitation of existing outdoor recreation facilities* as a top statewide LWCF issue (top issue in 9 of the 11 SCORP Planning Regions). Recreation providers report that the existing recreational infrastructure (utilities, roads, and buildings, etc.) is aging and in need of major rehabilitation. *Note: A full listing of issues gathered during the workshops are available on the SCORP Planning Website at www.prd.state.or.us/scorp.php under the heading "Regional Outdoor Recreation Issues."*

Now that the need for major rehabilitation has been identified as a key statewide issue, our challenge is to properly address the issue in the 2003-2007 SCORP plan. Towards this end, OPRD and the Oregon Recreation and Park Association (ORPA) have developed a method for collecting major rehabilitation data from non-Federal, public-sector recreation providers across the state of Oregon. This data collection process is designed to:

- develop a basic understanding of the relative health of the recreational infrastructure in the state,
- identify the specific types of facilities in need of major rehabilitation at the regional and statewide level,
- identify the specific reasons why the facilities are in need of major rehabilitation at the regional and statewide level, and
- establish a baseline measurement for measuring rehabilitation progress across time.

The purpose of this letter is to request your assistance in identifying the number of outdoor recreational facilities that your agency/organization manages that are in need of major rehabilitation. The information that you provide will be used for statewide planning purposes only. Information that your agency/organization provides will not be used to later evaluate your specific LWCF major rehabilitation grant requests. *Note: Federal agencies currently identify critical rehabilitation projects using a more technical set of maintenance/rehabilitation definitions.*

Please use the attached Major Rehabilitation Reporting Instruction Sheet to complete the SCORP Major Rehabilitation Reporting Form. This packet of information is available in downloadable format on our SCORP planning website at http://www.prd.state.or.us/scorp_rehab.php. Major Rehabilitation Reporting Instruction Sheet

Important Note: The information that your agency/organization provides in this reporting exercise will be used for statewide planning purposes only. The information will not be used to later evaluate your specific LWCF major rehabilitation grant requests. For reporting consistency, it is essential that you follow this set of instructions while completing the SCORP Major Rehabilitation Reporting Form.

Step 1 Before starting this reporting exercise, please check to see that you have the following materials:

- a Facility and Reporting Measure List,
- a Life Expectancy Schedule of Recreational Areas and Facilities,
- an Oregon SCORP Planning Regions map,
- a SCORP Major Rehabilitation Reporting Form, and
- a postage-paid return envelope.

Step 2 Please use the following definition for identifying major rehabilitation projects.

Major Rehabilitation Projects involve the restoration or partial reconstruction of eligible recreation areas and facilities, which is necessitated by one or more of the following:

- the recreation area or facility is beyond its normal life expectancy (please use the "Life Expectancy Schedule of Recreational Areas and Facilities" to help make this determination),
- the recreation area or facility is destroyed by fire, natural disaster or vandalism,
- the recreation area or facility does not meet health & safety codes/requirements,
- the recreation area or facility requires rehabilitation to insure critical natural resource protection,
- the recreation area or facility does not meet access requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act, and
- changing recreation needs (e.g. changes in demographics within the service area) dictate a change in the type of recreation area or facility provided.

Important Note: Please do not report routine maintenance or repair work as major rehabilitation. Routine maintenance/repair includes work such as cleanup, painting, and minor repairs of buildings, structures, equipment and utilities merely maintaining portions of such facilities in a sound and useful state.

Step 3 Please review the Facility and Reporting Measure List. The list includes all types of areas and facilities currently eligible for Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) funding as major rehabilitation projects. Use this list as a guide for reporting all facilities managed by your agency/organization currently in need of major rehabilitation. The list includes:

- **Facility Category:** This column is included for organizational purposes only. Please do not report the "Facility Category" name on the SCORP Rehabilitation Reporting Form.
- **Facility Type:** Please report all facilities using the specific "Facility Type" names included in this column (e.g. report the name such as tent campsite, asphalt trail, irrigation system, and so forth) on the SCORP Rehabilitation Reporting Form.
- **Reporting Measure:** Please use the corresponding "Reporting Measure" for each Facility Type to report the number of facilities or projects your agency/organization currently manages in need of

major rehabilitation (e.g. when reporting the number of tent campsites in need of major rehabilitation, you would report the *number of sites needing major rehabilitation*).

Step 4 *You are now ready to complete the SCORP Major Rehabilitation Reporting Form. Please use the following instructions for completion of the form. Refer to the Sample SCORP Major Rehabilitation Reporting Form example as you read through the Step 4 instructions.*

- Use the specific instructions described in Step 2 and Step 3 to identify all facilities/projects managed by your agency/organization currently in need of major rehabilitation.
- For each major rehabilitation facility/project reported, record the specific "Facility Type" name from the Facility and Reporting Measure List under Column 1 of the SCORP Major Rehabilitation Reporting Form.
 - ✓ On the sample reporting form, we are reporting tent campsite, outdoor pool, gravel parking and playground.
- Report the number of facilities/projects in need of Major Rehabilitation for each Facility Type (reported in Column 1) under Column 2 of the SCORP Major Rehabilitation Reporting Form. As stated in Step 3, use the appropriate "Reporting Measure" from the Facility and Reporting Measure List.
 - ✓ On the sample reporting form, we are reporting 16 tent campsites, 1 outdoor pool, 3 acres of gravel parking and 1 playground.
