RULE SUMMARY

Some Oregon Scenic Waterways are also designated as federal Wild and Scenic Rivers. Federal regulations have been adopted that govern recreational use on the Wild and Scenic Rivers. Those federal regulations are not enforceable by state law enforcement officers unless they have also been adopted in Oregon Administrative Rules through the Scenic Waterway program. These proposed amendments to the chapter 736, division 40 rules are aligning state rules on the John Day and Deschutes rivers with federal regulations already in place. The rules being adopted do not impose any additional regulations on river users.
