

RULE SUMMARY

OAR 736-015 is being amended to limit the waiver of camping fees to U.S. Military veterans with a service connected disability or active duty U.S. Military personnel on leave, as was the original intent of the rule. The fee waiver has been in place since 2004, but the rule did not specify U.S. Military veterans. Over the last few years, there have been increasing requests for fee waiver from people outside the United States, mostly Canadian military personnel. The rule needs to be specific to the original intent to prevent confusion or reaction from foreign military visitors expecting to have a fee waiver.
