State and Federal activities status updates, Presented by Director Bauer

State-Level Updates:

Director Bauer provided an overview of recent state service activities, including



- ongoing coordination with partner agencies and alignment with state priorities.
- Updates were given on program performance and funding status, including upcoming deadlines for grant reports.
- Noted developments in partnerships to enhance community impact and volunteer engagement across Oregon.

Federal-Level Updates:

- Provided an overview of recent federal guidance impacting AmeriCorps programs and state service commissions.
- Shared a recent federal action directive regarding grantmaking oversight and discussed implications for Oregon Serves.
- Highlighted upcoming opportunities for federal engagement and technical assistance.

Commission Meeting Agenda Planning

State Service Plan Development & Annual Retreat Agenda Development, Presented by Director Bauer

State Service Plan Development:

- Discussed timeline and approach for the State Service Plan, emphasizing partner engagement and integration of equity priorities.
- Identified priority areas for the plan, including equitable access to service, capacity building for rural organizations, and youth engagement.
- Discussed incorporating public input through listening sessions and surveys prior to finalizing the plan, if full plan developed.
- Discussed integrating new federal priorities and aligning with Oregon's broader workforce and education strategies.

Annual Retreat Agenda Development:

- Discussed potential retreat dates and venues, with a preference for a central location accessible to all commissioners.
- Proposed agenda topics included:
 - o Review of the State Service Plan draft and finalization steps.
 - Typically, it includes visioning for next three years, though difficult in this context and a shorter plan may be considered.
 - Facilitated networking and team-building activities to strengthen Commission cohesion.



- o Elections for next chair positions.
- Considered inviting guest speakers from AmeriCorps and Oregon partner agencies to provide context on emerging trends in service and volunteerism.
- Next steps include circulating a draft retreat agenda for commissioner feedback before the next Executive Committee meeting.
