Design Snow Load Changes in the new 2025 OSSC

The Building Codes Division has issued a new technical bulletin to provide more information about the major changes to design snow load provisions adopted in the new 2025 Oregon Structural Specialty Code (OSSC).

These changes became applicable statewide on April 1, 2026, and represent the most comprehensive revision to design snow load determination in recent versions. The new provisions are important to consider for all OSSC-governed projects and designs.

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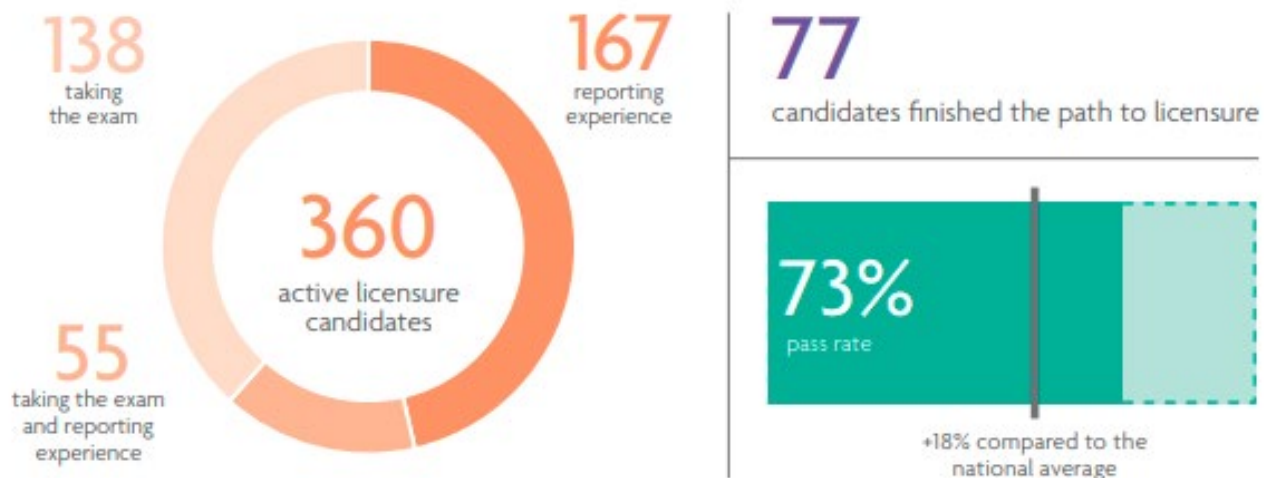
NCARB UPDATES

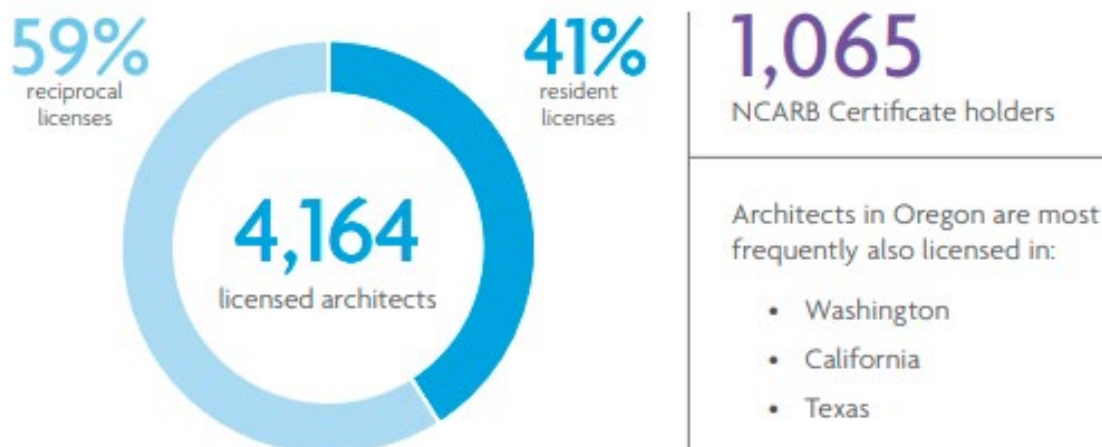

CONTINUING EDUCATION AUDIT

The annual Continuing Education (CE) audit is underway. CE is a critical component of the Board's mission to protect the public health, safety, and welfare. The CE audit is conducted to determine if registrants are meeting the CE requirements listed in Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 806-010-0145. Each renewal cycle, eight percent of registered architects who submitted renewal applications are randomly selected for the CE audit.

OSBAE would like to remind registrants that 24 hours of CE in architectural health, safety, and welfare (HSW) subjects are required to renew or reinstate an architect certificate of registration. Evidence of compliance must be maintained by the architect for a minimum of two years. Acceptable evidence of completion is a certificate or transcript that includes the name of the course provider, registrant's name, course title, completion date, and HSW hours received.

Please see OAR 806-010-0145 for the details regarding CE, as well as the [flowchart](#) that is available on our website. It's important to note that failing to comply with CE requirements or making false statements or misrepresentations related to CE activities, may result in disciplinary action by the Board.
