FINAL ORDER INCORPORATING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Based on the attached Settlement Agreement, incorporated herein, the Oregon State Board of Examiners for Engineering and Land Surveying (Board) finds that because Daniel Roseman applied the seal of another to nineteen pages of an engineering plan set for a waterslide project located in Eugene, Oregon, and because Roseman also forged the signature of another on each page of that plan set, thus falsely impersonating a registrant of like or different name, Roseman violated both ORS 672.045(3) and ORS 672.045(5) on nineteen occasions.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to ORS 672.325 and ORS 183.745, the Board assesses Roseman a civil penalty of \$2,000, to be paid in 10 consecutive, monthly payments of \$200 each, payments to be received at the OSBEELS office no later than the first day of the month they are due, first payment due July 1, 2021.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

- The Board, by and through its President, Daren L. Cone, PE, PLS, and Daniel Roseman (Roseman), do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:
- 4 1. The Board and Roseman agree to settle this matter in accordance with ORS 183.417(3).
- 5 2. At no relevant time was Roseman registered or licensed in any capacity under the Board's authority to engage in the professional practice of engineering in Oregon.
- 7 3. On October 15, 2020, the Board issued a Notice of Intent to Assess Civil Penalty (Notice)
- 8 assessing Roseman a civil penalty of \$2,000. The Board charged Roseman with nineteen
- 9 violations of ORS 672.045(3) and ORS 672.045(5) for applying the seal of another and
- falsely impersonating a registrant of like or different name on nineteen pages of an
- engineering plan set for a waterslide project located in Eugene, Oregon.
- 12 4. On December 10, 2020, the LEC and Roseman met in an informal conference to discuss a
- settlement. Roseman and the LEC agreed to settle this matter at that time.
- 14 5. The Board finds, but Roseman neither admits nor denies, that Roseman applied the seal of
- another to nineteen pages of an engineering plan set for a waterslide project located in
- Eugene, Oregon, and also forged the signature of another on each page of that plan set, thus
- falsely impersonating a registrant of like or different name. The Board finds, but Roseman
- neither admits nor denies, that by engaging in the conduct above, Roseman violated both
- ORS 672.045(3) and ORS 672.045(5) on nineteen occasions.
- 20 6. The Board and Roseman agree that, pursuant to ORS 672.325 and ORS 183.745 and for the
- violations above, the Board assesses Roseman a civil penalty of \$2,000, to paid by Roseman
- in 10, consecutive, monthly payments of \$200 each, with the first monthly payment due no
- later than July 1, 2021, and subsequent monthly payments due on the first day of the month
- they are due.

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1	7.	Payment shall be made to the "Oregon State Board of Examiners for Engineering and Land
2		Surveying," and delivered or mailed to 670 Hawthorne Street SE, Suite 220, Salem, Oregon
3		97301.
4	8.	The full \$2,000 civil penalty shall be paid no later than April 1, 2022.
5	9.	If Roseman fails to pay any part of the civil penalty on its due date, the Board will assess a
6		9% interest rate on any unpaid balance, and the unpaid balance will become immediately
7		due.
8	10.	Any violation of this order may result in further discipline.
9	11.	The Final Order Incorporating Settlement Agreement sets forth the entire agreement of the
10		parties. Roseman agrees that the determination of any violation of this settlement agreement
11		is entirely within the Board's discretion.
12	12.	Roseman understands and acknowledges that the Final Order Incorporating Settlement
13		Agreement is a public record and may be disclosed in accordance with Oregon's public
14		records law.
15	13.	Roseman represents that he has carefully read this Settlement Agreement, understands the
16		intent and content of the document, and signs below of his own free will, without coercion or
17		duress. Roseman understands this Settlement Agreement is a final order and he hereby
18		waives any and all rights to judicial review, or to otherwise appeal or challenge this
19		Settlement Agreement.
