FINAL ORDER BY DEFAULT

On or about April 22, 2021, the Oregon State Board of Examiners for Engineering and Land Surveying (Board) properly served a Notice of Intent to Assess a Civil Penalty (Notice) on Ravinder Maniktala (Maniktala). The Notice proposed to assess a civil penalty in the amount of \$250. It designated the Board file on this matter as the record for purposes of establishing a prima facie case upon default. Maniktala did not request a hearing. Therefore, upon consideration of the facts and law, the Board enters the following Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT AND ULTIMATE FACTS

- 1. At all relevant times, Maniktala was a licensed engineer, registration number 81237PE.
- 2. On or about March 14, 2019, the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors for the State of Oklahoma (Oklahoma Board) issued a Consent Order against Maniktala for aiding and assisting the firm BranchPattern, Inc. in offering and practicing engineering in the state of Oklahoma without a Certificate of Authorization. Maniktala signed the consent order on February 15, 2019, agreeing to entry of the Consent Order.
- 3. A Consent Order is disciplinary action related to the practice of engineering.
- 4. Maniktala did not report the Oklahoma Consent Order to the Oregon Board until December 30, 2020, when he applied to renew his registration. Renewal of Maniktala's engineer registration is currently pending.

APPLICABLE LAW

1		AI I LICADLE LAW
2	1.	Former OAR 820-020-0045(4) (2006), a rule of professional conduct, provided that an
3		applicant or registrant must give written notification to the Board of any disciplinary action
4		or sanction related to the practice of engineering, land surveying, or photogrammetric
5		mapping imposed by any licensing agency immediately upon receiving notice of the action
6		or sanction. 1
7 8	2.	Under ORS 670.325(1), the Board may impose a civil penalty of up to \$1,000 per violation
9		of its laws and rules.
10	3.	Under ORS 672.200(6), the Board may suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue, restore, or renew
11		a certificate or permit, or may reprimand an individual enrolled as an intern or holding a
12		certificate or permit for violating a rule of professional conduct prescribed by the board.
13		CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
14	1.	Because the Oklahoma Consent Order was entered by the Oklahoma Board on or about
15		March 14, 2019, <i>former</i> OAR 820-020-0045(4) (2006) applied at the time and required
16 17		Maniktala to report the disciplinary action to the Oregon Board immediately upon receiving
18		notice of that action.
19	2.	Because Maniktala failed to report the Oklahoma Consent Order to the Oregon Board
20		immediately upon receiving notice of that action, Maniktala violated <i>former</i> OAR 820-020-
21		0045(4) (2006).

24		ffective May 9, 2019, OAR 820-020-0045(4) currently reads: "An applicant or registrant must give written
25		ification to the Board of any disciplinary action or sanction related to the practice of engineering, land surveying, photogrammetric mapping imposed by any licensing agency within 45- days of the final order being issued."
26		d Maniktala been subject to the current rule, he would still be in violation because more than 45 days passed hout him having reported the Oklahoma discipline.

1	3. The conduct described above is the basis for disciplinary sanctions under ORS 672.325(1)		
2	and ORS 672.200(6), and Maniktala's conduct is a basis to assess a civil penalty of \$250 for		
3	violation of former OAR 820-020-0045(4) (2006) detailed above.		
4	ORDER		
5	For the reasons above, the Board HEREBY assesses a civil penalty in the amount of		
6	\$250 against Maniktala for violating <i>former</i> OAR 820-020-0045(4) (2006).
