FINAL ORDER INCORPORATING
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Based on the attached Settlement Agreement, incorporated herein, the Oregon State Board of Examiners for Engineering and Land Surveying (Board) finds that because Ali Fakih did not report disciplinary action from Nevada to the Oregon Board within 45 days of it being issued, he violated OAR 820-020-0045(4).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to ORS 672.325 and ORS 183.745, the Board assesses Fakih a civil penalty of \$1,000.

1 10. Payment shall be made to the "Oregon State Board of Examiners for Engineering and Land
2 Surveying," and delivered or mailed to 670 Hawthorne Street SE, Suite 220, Salem, Oregon
3 97301.

4 11. The full \$1,000 civil penalty shall be paid no later than June 1, 2024.

5 12. If Fakih fails to pay any part of the civil penalty on its due date, the Board will assess a 9%
6 interest rate on any unpaid balance, and the unpaid balance will become immediately due.

7 13. Any violation of this order may result in further discipline.

8 14. The Final Order Incorporating Settlement Agreement sets forth the entire agreement of the
9 parties. Fakih agrees that the determination of any violation of this settlement agreement is
10 entirely within the Board's discretion.

11 15. Fakih understands and acknowledges that the Final Order Incorporating Settlement
12 Agreement is a public record and may be disclosed in accordance with Oregon's public
13 records law.

14 16. Fakih represents that he has carefully read this Settlement Agreement, understands the intent
15 and content of the document, and signs below of his own free will, without coercion or
16 duress. Fakih understands this Settlement Agreement is a Final Order and he hereby waives
17 any and all rights to judicial review, or to otherwise appeal or challenge this Settlement
18 Agreement.
