The Certified Water Right Examiner (CWRE) test is given annually. Applicants will have four hours to complete the exam. This is an <u>open book</u> exam which consists of multiple choice, true/false questions, questions requiring the performance of calculations, and questions requiring the applicant to select items from lists.
