



Change Advisory: NPA Update to Division 62

Details

On January 1, 2026, amended Chapter 851 Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Division 62 Standards for Certification of the Nursing Assistant (CNA) and Medication Aide go into effect. Amendments made align the OARs with the requirements of HB 3044 (2025) and standardize application processes. These amendments will impact all certification applicants.
