



# OREGON LIFE SAFETY TEAM

A multi-agency team that emphasizes community risk reduction, shares best practices, coordinates, develops and implements consistent statewide fire prevention and life safety education.

## GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

### 1) PROMOTE SMOKE AND CARBON MONOXIDE ALARM PROGRAMS

- Promote smoke and carbon monoxide alarm education, and provide consistent statewide messaging.
- Support smoke alarm installation programs, and alarm installations for people who are Deaf or hard of hearing.

### 2) INCREASE HOME FIRE ESCAPE PLANNING EFFORTS

- Increase awareness about the importance of home fire escape planning.
- Increase window fall prevention awareness and how it relates to home fire escape planning.

### 3) INCREASE EDUCATION ON PREVENTING TOP FIRE CAUSES

- Identify top fire causes.
- Increase awareness and education efforts on the top fire causes.

### 4) TARGET HIGH-RISK POPULATIONS WITH FIRE PREVENTION EDUCATION

- Identify high-risk populations.
- Expand older adult fire prevention education efforts.
- Increase youth fire prevention and intervention efforts.
- Provide fire prevention education for occupants of non-conventional residences (e.g., travel trailers, campers, and recreational vehicles).

### 5) PROMOTE WILDLAND URBAN INTERFACE FIRE PREVENTION EDUCATION

- Increase education to prevent outdoor and wildland urban interface fires.

### 6) INCREASE RESIDENTIAL FIRE SPRINKLER AWARENESS

- Promote education and awareness on the benefits of residential fire sprinklers.

### 7) SUPPORT WATER SAFETY EFFORTS

- Support and encourage water safety in natural waterways.
