What is HERO Kids Registry?



- Voluntary, no-cost system
- Any Oregon family can share critical information about their child's or young adult's health before a health emergency occurs
- Available to any Oregon child or young adult up through age $26\,$
- The information can be quickly and easily accessed by emergency medical services (EMS) and hospital emergency department (ED) providers

What information can EMS & emergency departments get from the Registry?

- Medical and/or behavioral conditions
- Alerts
- · Medications
- Allergies
- POLST information
- · Safe words
- · Emergency protocol letters
- Emergency Information Forms
- Parent or legal guardian contact information




Accessing the Registry

- EMS & ED providers will call the hotline with the child's demographic information or Registry ID number
 - Information is relayed in less than 90 seconds and can also be faxed
- EMS and EDs can also access through the OREMS App
- Registry information is available through the Emergency Department Information Exchange (EDIE)

Who creates HERO Kids Registration?



- Only parents, legal guardians, and young adults aged 15-26 can create or change a registration.
- Families are encouraged to work with heath care provider(s) to make sure the information is correct and complete.

Become a HERO Kids Registry champion

- Educate families while on-scene
- Distribute materials at community outreach events
- Add information to website and/or social media account
- Encourage families to talk with their child's providers
- Provide brochures and flyers in waiting room and at patient discharge
- Add a HERO Kids dot phrase to EMR
- Include link to HERO Kids Registry in MyChart and after visit summary
