40 HR FIRE INVESTIGATION

The Oregon State Fire Marshal's "Fire Origin and Cause Investigator" course is a **40-hour "REQUISITE KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS" class for volunteer, combo, and career fire service and law enforcement personnel** who are assistants to the State Fire Marshal as per ORS 476.060 and have fire investigation responsibilities as one of their primarily assigned functions. You must pass the written and field exercise exams for you to pass the class 70% or higher, to receive credit for the course.

After completing this class, the student will have a basic understanding of "Fire Origin and Cause", documenting the fire scene, evidence collection/preservation, performing interviews, post-incident investigation protection, and fire investigation case presentation. In addition to obtaining a certificate of course completion, the student will be required to complete the Oregon DPSST NFPA 1033 Standard for Professional Qualifications for Fire Investigator JPR "Skills" portion of the Task Book prior to applying for state certification.
