



**June 8, 2022**

### **Beulah Reservoir**

- As of May 22, there was approximately four feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

### **Brownlee Reservoir**

- Hewitt and Holcomb Parks are open and docks are floating. ODOT is chip sealing along Highway 86 through June, there may be up to 30-minute delays.

### **Bully Creek**

- The boat ramp is open and docks are floating. Malheur County refurbished the boarding dock and guideway over the winter.

### **Chetco River**

- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Yaquina is dredging the federal navigation channel. The work will be completed before June 30.

### **Columbia River**

- Hood River-White Salmon Interstate Bridge will be closed beginning at 12:01am, Friday, June 10 through 11:59pm Sunday, June 12 to complete ramp and surface treatments. The work must be completed in dry conditions. In the event it is raining the closure will be rescheduled for June 24-26. During this time the

Port of Hood River boat ramp and marina will be open.

- Westport County Park just off the River in Westport Slough, will be closed June 17 for installation of permanent striping and stencils in the parking lot.
- McCuddy's Marine Drive pumpout and dump station are scheduled to be replaced this year.
- Port of Cascade Locks pumpout and dump station are out of service. The next available equipment downstream is at M. James Gleason and upstream is at Port of Hood River.

### **Coos Bay**

- Empire Boat Ramp is closed for two weeks beginning May 26, while the City of Coos Bay has dock repairs completed.

### **Coquille River**

- Arago and Coquille boat ramps are scheduled to be cleaned and reopened by June 15-17.
- Sturdivant Park has approximately 3 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp at ordinary low water. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting

### **Crane Prairie Reservoir**

- Boarding docks are installed at Rock Creek Day Use and Crane Prairie Day Use.

### **Crescent Lake**

- Crescent Lake campground and day use main boat launch is unusable due to low water. The low water boat launch to the west of the main launch is open.
- Spring campground and day use are not open yet for the season. U.S. Forest Service anticipates that once opened it will only be usable for launching small boats because of low water levels. The dock will not be installed this year.
- Crescent Lake Resort is open for launching small boats, be cautious as some vehicles have gotten stuck in the sediment.

## **Davis Lake**

- The boat launch at Lava Flow campground is under a wildlife closure until September 1. Launching of small boats is possible at North Lava Flow campground adjacent to the lava field and at West Davis recreation site.

## **Devils Lake**

- East Devils Lake State Park is open and docks are floating.

## **Dexter Lake**

- Columbia Drag Boat Association is having the Can Am Challenge event June 11-12. [Race Schedule | Columbia Drag Boat Association | United States \(cdbaracing.com\)](http://cdbaracing.com)
- All boat ramps are open and docks are floating.

## **East Lake**

- Cinder Hill and Hot Spring boat ramps are usable and have a low amount of water at the toe of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting. The docks will not be installed this year.
- The East Lake boat ramp is dry and docks will not be installed this year.

## **Fall Creek Reservoir**

- All boat ramps are open. Watch for large woody debris-logs on the water.

## **Foster Reservoir**

- Gedney Creek and Sunnyside boat ramps are open and docks are floating. There is approximately 3 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp at Calkins Park. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

## **Gold Lake**

- As of June 2, Gold Lake Road and Waldo Lake Road are impassable due to snow. The approximate base is 18 inches. U.S. Forest Service is monitoring the status and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. For updates call Gold Lake information line 541-782-5235

## **Henry Hagg Lake**

## **Hyatt Lake**

- The reservoir is at less than 21% full, unfortunately both boat ramps are out of water and closed to trailered boats. The campground is open and access to the water is difficult, but paddlers can carry their boats to the water.

## **Kingsley Reservoir**

- Kingsley Reservoir Campground and boat ramp opening is delayed until July. [Kingsley Campground and Green Point Reservoir - CLOSED - Public Notices - Hood River County, OR](#)

## **Lost Creek Reservoir**

- The Takelma boat ramp boarding docks were damaged and will not be reinstalled this year

## **Luckiamute River**

- Luckiamute Landing is open and usable. Due to recent rains the launch area is muddy. There is woody debris in the water and you may need to portage around some of the items.

## **McKenzie River**

- The boat ramp, parking and access road to Ben and Kay Dorris State Park are open. All other park facilities are closed due to the Holiday fire.

## **Middle Fork Willamette River**

- Pengra Access State Greenway is open

## **Millicoma River**

- Doris Place boarding docks were repaired and reinstalled.

## **Multnomah Channel**

- J.J. Collins Memorial Park clean up event is planned for June 17-19 with Columbia River Yachting Association. Plans include clearing trails and repairing benches and picnic tables.

## **North Santiam River**

- Approximately 4 miles downstream of Buell Miller boat ramp there is a river wide log jam that is impassable for all boaters. The stretch of river from Buell Miller to Greens Bridge is littered with logs with root wads and not recommended for boating.
- Downstream of Greens Bridge to Jefferson there are several large woody debris accumulations that less maneuverable boats will have challenges safely navigating. This area is not recommended for beginner or intermediate boaters due to swift currents and large woody debris.
- Greens Bridge gate will close within the next two-weeks. Once closed, boaters wishing to launch or retrieve boats must apply for a key through ODFW 541-757-4186. For information about boating hazards and obstructions [BORT Dash \(arcgis.com\)](http://arcgis.com)

## **North Umpqua River**

- Amacher Park boat ramp and parking is anticipated to be closed late summer-early fall to replace the upper half of the boat ramp and reconfigure and pave the parking area. Access to the camping area will be open.

## **Odell Lake**

- Sunset Cove boat launch is open.
- Princess Creek boat launch is closed for hazard tree removal.
- Trapper Creek boat launch is closed because of snow.
- Odell Lake Resort and Shelter Cove Resort boat launches are open.

## **Owyhee Reservoir**

- The floating restroom will not be installed this year.

## **Paulina Lake**

- Little Crater and Paulina Lake Campground docks were installed last week.

## **Prineville Reservoir**

- All boat ramps on Prineville Reservoir are out of the water as of May 22, 2022. Hand launching kayaks, canoes and standup paddleboards can be done at Prineville Reservoir State Park.

## **Rogue River**

- Foster Bar Scat Machine is operational. The equipment is temperamental and scheduled to be replaced later this year. To help keep the system functioning, do not dispose of wipes in the system.

## **Snake River**

- A boat traveling from Lake Havasu with quagga/zebra mussels was decontaminated at the Ontario boat inspection station. Thank you ODFW for decontaminating the boat. Help keep aquatic invasive species out of Oregon. Always remember to Clean, Drain, Dry and Pull Your Plus. ## **Spring Creek**

- Collier Memorial Park -The Spring Creek Day Use and Kayak Launch will be closed for construction starting June 13 – July 20<sup>th</sup>. Improvements include paved parking, designated loading and unloading zone, reconfigured asphalt pathways to restrooms and kayak launch, gate, launch dock and informational kiosk.

## **Suttle Lake**

- Boarding docks are installed at Link Creek, South Shore and Suttle Lake.

## **Tillamook Bay**

- Memaloose County Park is severely shoaled in making launching and retrieving difficult. Monitor tides closely.

## **Willamette River**

### **Lower (Columbia River to Willamette Falls)**

- Cathedral Park - ODOT will be doing repair work on the St. Johns bridge columns this year. Portland Parks and Recreation does not anticipate any impact to the boat ramp and docks. There may be minor if any impact to boater parking area. The two N. Philadelphia Avenue frontage roads connecting North Syracuse and North Willamette Avenues will close.

- Milwaukie Bay Park's remaining boarding docks are scheduled to be installed June 16, 2022.

### **Middle (Willamette Falls to Salem)**

- Bernert Landing boat ramp will be closed July 15-17 for the City of West Linn Annual Old Time Fair.
- Rogers Landing boat ramp will be closed June 9 from dawn to 2:00pm for dock and boat ramp inspection.
- Hebb Park docks are partially installed. The remaining docks are scheduled to be installed within the next two-weeks.
- Molalla River State Park is open.

### **Upper (Salem to Eugene)**

- Riverview Park in Independence will be closed to vehicles July 2-4 for the annual Independence Days festival. The Independence Sports Park boat ramp located approximately one-mile downstream will be open.
- Buena Vista County Park is closed through September 30, 2022, for construction of the boat ramp, boarding docks, lower parking area, vault toilet and access road. During this time there is no boating access at the Park. The contractor has started demolition of the old ramp and lower parking area.
- Marshall Island and Christensen are open.
- City of Harrisburg is making street improvements for Monroe St. between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Streets. Use an alternative route to reach the boat ramp and restrooms until July 5.

## **Waldo Lake**

- As of June 2, Gold Lake Road and Waldo Lake Road are impassable due to snow. The approximate base is 18 inches. U.S. Forest Service is monitoring the status and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. For updates call Gold Lake information line 541-782-5235

## **Woahink Lake**

- The Oregon Dunes Triathlon and Duathlon will be at East Woahink boat ramp. Use of the boat ramp and parking area will be limited.
