



**June 15, 2022**

### **Beulah Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Located on the North Fork of the Malheur River approximately 15 miles north of Juntura on a gravel road. As of June 13, there is approximately a foot of water at the bottom of the boat ramp. Looking for an adventure check out Beulah Reservoir.

### **Brownlee Reservoir**

- Hewitt and Holcomb Parks are open and docks are floating. ODOT is chip sealing along Highway 86 through June, there may be up to 30-minute delays.
- NEW: Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open.

### **Chetco River**

- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Yaquina is dredging the federal navigation channel. The work will be completed before June 30.

### **Columbia River**

- NEW: Donaldson Marina pumpout is open and operational.
- NEW: Umatilla Marina boat ramp and docks will be closed for [Umatilla Landing Days](#) June 24 at 4 pm to June 25 at 11:59 pm

- [Hood River-White Salmon Interstate Bridge](#) will be closed beginning at 12:01 am, Friday, June 24 through 11:59 pm Sunday, June 26, to complete ramp and surface treatments. During this time the Port of Hood River boat ramp and marina will be open.
- Westport County Park just off the River in Westport Slough, will be closed June 17, for installation of permanent striping and stenciling for the parking lot.
- McCuddy's Marine Drive pumpout and dump station are scheduled to be replaced this year.
- Port of Cascade Locks pumpout and dump station are out of service. The next available equipment downstream is at M. James Gleason and upstream is at the Port of Hood River.

### **Coos Bay**

- Empire Boat Ramp is closed for two weeks beginning May 26, while the City of Coos Bay has dock repairs completed.

### **Coquille River**

- Arago and Coquille boat ramps are scheduled to be cleaned and reopened by June 15-17.
- Sturdivant Park has approximately three feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp at ordinary low water. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

### **Crane Prairie Reservoir**

- Boarding docks are installed at Rock Creek Day Use and Crane Prairie Day Use.

### **Crescent Lake**

- Crescent Lake campground and day use main boat launch is unusable due to low water. The low water boat launch to the west of the main launch is open.
- UPDATE: Spring campground and day use are open. U.S. Forest Service recommends only launching small boats because of low water levels. The dock will not be installed this year.
- Crescent Lake Resort is open for launching small boats. Use caution, because some vehicles have gotten stuck in the sediment.

## **Davis Lake**

- The boat launch at Lava Flow campground is under a wildlife closure until September 1. Launching small boats is possible at North Lava Flow campground adjacent to the lava field and at West Davis recreation site.

## **East Lake**

- Cinder Hill and Hot Spring boat ramps are usable, with a low amount of water at the toe of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting. The docks will not be installed this year.
- The East Lake boat ramp is dry and docks will not be installed this year.

## **Foster Reservoir**

- Gedney Creek and Sunnyside boat ramps are open and docks are floating. There is approximately three feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp at Calkins Park. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

## **Gold Lake**

- UPDATE: As of June 13, Gold Lake Road and Waldo Lake Road are impassable due to snow. The approximate base is 18 inches. U.S. Forest Service is monitoring the status and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. For updates call Gold Lake information line at 541-782-5235.

## **Hells Canyon Reservoir**

- NEW: Copperfield boat launch is open and docks are floating.

## **Henry Hagg Lake**

- NEW: There will be intermittent parking lot striping and paving at various areas of Scoggins Valley Park on weekdays between June 13-24. Some minor impacts but boat ramps, docks and parking will be open and operational.

## **Hills Creek**

- NEW: All boat ramps are open. Bingham boat ramp has approximately 10 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp. The water level is dropping.

Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

### **Hyatt Lake**

- The reservoir is at less than 21% full. Unfortunately, both boat ramps are out of the water and closed to trailered boats. The campground is open and access to the water is difficult, but paddlers can carry their boats to the water.

### **Kingsley Reservoir**

- Kingsley Reservoir Campground and boat ramp [opening is delayed](#) until July.

### **Lake Billy Chinook**

- NEW: A wave attenuator is being anchored at Cove Palisades Resort and Marina. The boating facilities are open during construction.
- NEW: Sundance waterski club is getting a new anchoring system for their dock located on the Crooked River arm. The dock will be unusable until mid-summer.

### **Lake Owyhee Reservoir**

- NEW: Leslie Gulch boat ramp is dry. Gordon Gulch and Indian Creek are open. ODFW identified Crappie fishing should be picking up in the shallow bays of the Owyhee Reservoir as fish move to spawning areas.
- The floating restroom will *not* be installed this year.

### **Lookout Point Reservoir**

- NEW: All boat ramps are open. Hampton Landing and Meridian boat ramps have approximately nine feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp. The water level is dropping. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

### **Lost Creek Reservoir**

- The Takelma boat ramp boarding docks were damaged and will not be reinstalled this year.

## **Luckiamute River**

- Luckiamute Landing is open and usable. Due to recent rains the launch area is muddy. Be aware of woody debris in the water and portage may be necessary.

## **McKenzie River**

- The boat ramp, parking and access road to Ben and Kay Dorris State Park are open. All other park facilities are closed due to the Holiday Farm wildfire.

## **North Santiam River**

- Greens Bridge gate will close within the next two-weeks. Once the gate is closed, boaters wishing to launch or retrieve boats must apply for a key through ODFW 541-757-4186. ## **North Umpqua River**

- Amacher Park boat ramp and parking is anticipated to be closed late summer to early fall, to replace the upper half of the boat ramp and reconfigure and pave the parking area. Access to the camping area will be open.

## **Odell Lake**

- Sunset Cove boat launch is open.
- UPDATE: Princess Creek boat launch open.
- Trapper Creek boat launch is not yet open for the season.
- Odell Lake Resort and Shelter Cove Resort boat launches are open.

## **Oxbow Reservoir**

- NEW: Oxbow boat ramp is open and docks are floating.

## **Paulina Lake**

- Little Crater and Paulina Lake Campground docks were installed last week.

## **Prineville Reservoir**

- UPDATE: All boat ramps on Prineville Reservoir are out of the water as of May 22, 2022.

Hand launching kayaks, canoes and standup paddleboards can be done at Prineville Reservoir State Park. The floating restrooms will not be installed this year.

### **Rogue River**

- Foster Bar Scat Machine is operational. The equipment is temperamental and scheduled to be replaced later this year. To help keep the system functioning, do not dispose of wipes in the system.

### **Spring Creek**

- Collier Memorial Park -The Spring Creek Day Use and Kayak Launch will be closed for construction starting June 13 – July 20<sup>th</sup>. Improvements include paved parking, designated loading and unloading zone, reconfigured asphalt pathways to the restrooms and kayak launch, a gate, launch dock and informational kiosk.

### **Suttle Lake**

- The boarding docks are installed at Link Creek, South Shore and Suttle Lake.

### **Tillamook Bay**

- Memaloose County Park is severely shoaled in, making launching and retrieving difficult. Monitor the tides closely.

### **Trask River**

- NEW: Carnahan Park boat ramp is open; the docks are floating. The city removed sediment from the boat ramp and from under the docks.

### **Tualatin River**

- NEW: Rood Bridge boat launch and kayak dock are open.

### **Willamette River**

#### **Lower (Columbia River to Willamette Falls)**

- Cathedral Park - ODOT will be doing repair work on the St. Johns Bridge columns this year. Portland Parks and Recreation does not anticipate any impact to the boat ramp and docks.

There may be minor, if any, impact to the parking area. The two N. Philadelphia Avenue frontage roads connecting North Syracuse and North Willamette Avenues will close.

The southern frontage road will remain open to local access. Additional information can be found on the [ODOT project page](#).

- UPDATE: Milwaukie Bay Park's remaining boarding docks were scheduled to be installed on June 16, 2022, and will likely be delayed due to high water.

### **Middle (Willamette Falls to Salem)**

- NEW: Boones Ferry dump station is repaired and operational.
- Bernert Landing boat ramp will be closed July 15-17 for the City of West Linn Annual Old Time Fair.
- Rogers Landing boat ramp will be closed on June 9, from dawn to 2:00 pm for dock and boat ramp inspection.
- Hebb Park docks are partially installed. The remaining docks are scheduled to be installed within the next two-weeks.
- Molalla River State Park is open.
- Regulatory changes to the [Towed Watersports Education Program](#) for Newberg Pool are in effect.

### **Umpqua River**

- NEW: Rainbow Plaza overflow parking across from the boating facility behind the floodwall will be open for camping beginning July 1 through October 31. The Regional Chainsaw Carving Championships will be held from June 16-19<sup>th</sup> in the overflow parking area. There will be traffic and pedestrian congestion during the event.

### **Upper (Salem to Eugene)**

- NEW: Wallace Marine Park boarding docks were damaged during high river flows. The boat ramp is open but use extreme caution because of strong river current and the damaged docks.
- Riverview Park in Independence will be closed to vehicles July 2-4 for their annual Independence Days festival. The Independence Sports Park boat ramp located approximately one-mile downstream, will be open.
- Buena Vista County Park is closed through September 30, 2022, for construction of the boat ramp, boarding docks, lower parking area, vault toilet and access road. During this time, there is no boating access at the park. The contractor started demolition of the old ramp and lower parking area.

- Marshall Island and Christensen access are open.
- City of Harrisburg is making street improvements for Monroe St. between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Streets. Use an alternate route to the boat ramp and restrooms until July 5.

### **Waldo Lake**

- UPDATE: As of June 13, Gold Lake Road and Waldo Lake Road are impassable due to snow. The approximate base is 18 inches. U.S. Forest Service is monitoring the status and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. For updates call the Gold Lake information line at 541-782-5235.
