Beulah Reservoir

- UPDATE: Located on the North Fork of the Malheur River approximately 15 miles north of Juntura on a gravel road. As of June 21, the water level meets the end of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Brownlee Reservoir

- Hewitt and Holcomb Parks are open and docks are floating. ODOT is chip sealing along Highway 86 through June, there may be up to 30-minute delays.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open.

Columbia River

- NEW: Hammond Marina was recently dredged. The City of Warrenton is putting everything back together and should have the work completed in time for the Buoy 10 fishery.
- Donaldson Marina pumpout is open and operational.
- The Umatilla Marina boat ramp and docks will be closed for [Umatilla Landing Days](#), from June 24 beginning at 4 pm to June 25 at 11:59 pm.

- The [Hood River-White Salmon Interstate Bridge](#) will be closed beginning at 12:01 am, Friday, June 24 through 11:59 pm Sunday, June 26, to complete ramp and surface treatments. During this time the Port of Hood River boat ramp and marina will be open.
- McCuddy's Marine Drive pumpout and dump station are scheduled to be replaced this year.
- Port of Cascade Locks pumpout and dump station are out of service. The next available equipment downstream is at M. James Gleason and upstream is at Port of Hood River.

Coos Bay

- UPDATE: Empire Boat Ramp is closed. The City plans to reopen Friday, June 24, 2022.

Coquille River

- NEW: The sediment at the Arago boat ramp was removed and the docks are anticipated to be installed between June 21 and July 1.
- NEW: The Coquille boat ramp has not been cleaned and sediment is present. Coos County is unsure if they will remove the sediment this year.
- Sturdivant Park has approximately three feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp at ordinary low water. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Crane Prairie Reservoir

- Boarding docks are installed at Rock Creek Day Use and Crane Prairie Day Use.

Crescent Lake

- Crescent Lake campground and day use main boat launch is unusable due to low water. The low water boat launch to the west of the main launch is open. Crescent Lake Resort is open for launching small boats. Be cautious, because some vehicles have gotten stuck in the sediment.
- Spring campground and day use areas are open. The U.S. Forest Service recommends only launching small boats because of low water levels. The dock will not be installed this year.

Davis Lake

- The boat launch at Lava Flow campground is under a wildlife closure until September 1. Small boat launching is possible at North Lava Flow campground adjacent to the lava field and at West Davis recreation site.

Diamond Lake

- Black Bird Fishing Derby is Saturday June 25, at Diamond Lake Resort.

East Lake

- Cinder Hill and Hot Spring boat ramps are usable and have a low amount of water at the toe of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting. The docks will not be installed this year.
- The East Lake boat ramp is dry and docks will not be installed this year.

Foster Reservoir

- Gedney Creek and Sunnyside boat ramps are open and docks are floating. There is approximately three feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp at Calkins Park. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Gold Lake

- UPDATE: As of June 15, Gold Lake Road and Waldo Lake Road are impassable due to snow. The U.S. Forest Service is receiving numerous reports of stranded vehicles stuck in the snow. The approximate base is 18 inches. The U.S. Forest Service is monitoring the status and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. Hells Canyon Reservoir

- Copperfield boat launch is open and docks are floating.

Henry Hagg Lake

- There will be intermittent parking lot striping and paving at various areas of Scoggins Valley Park on weekdays between June 13-24. Some minor impacts, but the boat ramps, docks and parking will be open and operational.

Hills Creek

- All boat ramps are open. Bingham boat ramp has approximately 10 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Hyatt Lake

- The reservoir is at less than 21% full, unfortunately both boat ramps are out of water and closed to trailered boats. The campground is open and access to the water is difficult, but paddlers can carry their boats to the water.

Kingsley Reservoir

- [Kingsley Reservoir Campground](#) and boat ramp opening is delayed until July.

Lake Billy Chinook

- UPDATE: The Cove Palisades Resort and Marina wave attenuator is installed. Additional anchors will be installed to secure the attenuator. Work is anticipated to be completed by September 2022. The boating facilities are open during construction.
- Sundance waterski club is getting a new anchoring system for their dock located on the Crooked River arm. The dock will be unusable until mid-summer.

Lake Owyhee Reservoir

- Leslie Gulch boat ramp is dry. Gordon Gulch and Indian Creek are open. The floating restroom will not be installed this year.

Lookout Point Reservoir

- All boat ramps are open. Hampton Landing and Meridian boat ramps have approximately nine feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp. The water level is dropping. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Lost Creek Reservoir

- The Takelma boat ramp boarding docks were damaged and will not be reinstalled this year.

Luckiamute River

- Luckiamute Landing is open and usable. Due to recent rains the launch area is muddy. There is woody debris in the water and you may need to portage around some of the debris.

McKenzie River

- NEW: Taylor Landing is open.
- NEW: Silver Creek Boat Landing is open for boating. The ramp, parking and restroom are open. The river viewing platform was destroyed by the Holiday Farm fire and is closed.
- NEW: Rennie Boat Landing is open.
- The boat ramp, parking and access road to Ben and Kay Dorris State Park are open. All other park facilities are closed due to the Holiday Farm fire.

Miller Lake

- NEW: Digit Point Campground boat ramp is open and docks were installed last week.

North Santiam River

- Greens Bridge gate will close within the next two weeks. Once closed, boaters wishing to launch or retrieve boats must apply for a key through ODFW 541-757-4186. Use our interactive [obstruction dashboard](#) for information about boating hazards and obstructions.

North Umpqua River

- Amacher Park boat ramp and parking is anticipated to be closed in the late summer-early fall to replace the upper half of the boat ramp and reconfigure and pave the parking area. Access to the camping area will be open.

Odell Lake

- Sunset Cove boat launch is open.
- Princess Creek boat launch open.
- Trapper Creek boat launch is not yet open for the season.
- Odell Lake Resort and Shelter Cove Resort boat launches are open.

Oxbow Reservoir

- Oxbow boat ramp is open and docks are floating.

Paulina Lake

- Little Crater and Paulina Lake Campground boat ramp is open and docks are floating.

Pilcher Creek Reservoir

- NEW: The reservoir is full; the boat ramp is open and docks are floating.

Prineville Reservoir

- All boat ramps on Prineville Reservoir are out of the water. Hand launching kayaks, canoes and standup paddleboards can be done at Prineville Reservoir State Park. The floating restrooms will not be installed this year.

Rogue River

- NEW: The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is completing maintenance dredging and will also dredge a large gravel bar at the entrance of the boat basin. Work is scheduled to be completed by late October 2022. - Foster Bar Scat Machine is operational. The equipment is temperamental and scheduled to be replaced later this year. To help keep the system functioning, do not dispose of wipes in the scat machine.

Scappoose Bay

- NEW: Scappoose Bay Marina will be closing the boat ramp for one day on June 29 for pavement maintenance. This is a weather dependent project and may be rescheduled if it rains.

Snake River

- NEW: Nyssa City Park boat ramp is open and docks are floating.

Spring Creek

- Collier Memorial Park -The Spring Creek Day Use and Kayak Launch will be closed for construction starting June 13 – July 20th. Improvements include paved parking, designated loading and unloading zone, reconfigured asphalt pathways to restrooms and kayak launch, gate, launch dock and informational kiosk.

Suttle Lake

- Boarding docks are installed at Link Creek, South Shore and Suttle Lake.

Tillamook Bay

- Memaloose County Park is severely shoaled in making launching and retrieving difficult. Monitor the tides closely.

Thief Valley Reservoir

- NEW: The reservoir is full; the boat ramp is open and docks are floating.

Tualatin River

- NEW: Cook Park boat ramp will be closed beginning Friday, June 25 at dawn through Monday, June 28 at dawn for the [Tigard Festival of Balloons](#).
- Rood Bridge boat launch and kayak dock are open.

Turner Lake

- NEW: Turner Lake Park boat ramp is open and docks are floating. There is a seasonal fee from May 28 to September 5. A large, July 3 and 4 festival is scheduled. No onsite parking will be available on those days.

Umpqua River

- NEW: Alfred S. Tyson boat launch in Elkton is open and usable.
- Rainbow Plaza overflow parking across from the boating facility behind the floodwall will be open for camping beginning July 1 through October 31.

Willamette River

Lower (Columbia River to Willamette Falls)

- NEW: City of Oregon City, Clackamette Park Master Plan Third Open House on June 22, 2022, 6 p.m. The meeting is hybrid style, live and Zoom. In-person at Oregon City, City Hall, 625 Center Street, Oregon City, OR 97045. Come and review the final site plan and provide comments on the plan. - UPDATE: Milwaukie Bay Park's remaining boarding docks are scheduled to be installed June 23, 2022.
- Cathedral Park - ODOT will be doing repair work on the St. Johns bridge columns this year. Portland Parks and Recreation does not anticipate any impact to the boat ramp and docks. There may be minor if any impact to boater parking area. The two N. Philadelphia Avenue frontage roads connecting North Syracuse and North Willamette Avenues will close. Middle (Willamette Falls to Salem)

- Boones Ferry dump station is repaired and operational.
- Hebb Park docks are partially installed. The remaining docks are scheduled to be installed within the next two-weeks.
- Molalla River State Park is open.
- Regulatory changes to the [Towed Watersports Education Program](#) for Newberg Pool are in effect.

Upper (Salem to Eugene)

- NEW: [World Beat Festival at Salem Riverfront Park dragon boat races](#) June 24 and 25. The races are 500 meters and the starting point is the south side of the Marion Street bridge connecting West Salem with Salem downtown. The finish line is south of the Riverfront Park dock.
- UPDATE: Wallace Marine Park boat ramp is closed until Thursday, June 23. The docks have been removed. The City plans to install dock sections as repairs are made.
- Riverview Park in Independence will be closed to vehicles July 2-4 for the annual Independence Days festival. The Independence Sports Park boat ramp located approximately one-mile downstream will be open.

- Buena Vista County Park is closed through September 30, 2022, for construction of the boat ramp, boarding docks, lower parking area, vault toilet and access road. During this time there is no boating access at the Park. The contractor has started demolition of the old ramp and lower parking area.
- Marshall Island and Christensen are open.
- City of Harrisburg is making street improvements for Monroe St. between 1st and 2nd Streets. Use an alternative route to reach the boat ramp and restrooms until July 5.

Waldo Lake

- UPDATE: As of June 15, Gold Lake Road and Waldo Lake Road are impassable due to snow. The U.S. Forest Service is receiving numerous reports of stranded vehicles stuck in the snow.
