### **Agate Lake**

- The County ramp is open, and the reservoir is approximately 87% full.

### **Agency Lake**

- Henzel and Petric Park's boarding docks have been seasonally removed. The boat ramps are open.

### **Applegate Reservoir**

- French Gulch has more than 80 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Copper boat ramp has approximately 18 feet over the bottom of the ramp.
- Hart-Tish Campground and boat ramp is anticipated to open in mid-April. More than 10 feet of water is at the bottom of the ramp.

### **Ben Irving Reservoir**

- The boat ramp and docks are open.

### **Beulah Reservoir**

- Water is approximately 25 feet *below* the bottom of the ramp.

### **Big Lake**

- Big Lake West and Big Lake Campgrounds, Big Lake Day Use and the boat ramp are closed.

### **Blue River Reservoir**

- Saddle Dam boat ramp is closed to trailered boats. Paddlers can carry down to access the reservoir. The water is approximately five feet below the end of boat ramp. The water level is rising.
- Lookout boat ramp is closed to trailered boats. The water level is approximately 35 feet below the boat ramp.

### **Brownlee Reservoir**

- Hewitt Park will open April 1st for camping. The water level is approximately eight feet below the boat ramp. The annual Easter Egg Hunt is scheduled for April 8<sup>th</sup>. A new vault toilet is being installed near the low-water boat ramp and will be open in early April. Idaho power will be conducting test hole boring to determine the best way to stabilize the banks along the RV parking side and extending the high-water ramp at the Tent Area on April 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- The Holcomb Park will open on April 1st for camping. The water level is approximately 17 feet below the boat ramp.
- Farewell Bend State Park – The water level is approximately seven feet below the boat ramp. Paddlecraft can carry down.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open and has approximately 10 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Spring Recreation Campground will open on, or around, April 1<sup>st</sup>. This site will begin charging fees at that time. The water is approximately 29 feet below the boat ramp. There is currently no water, trash service, or onsite host and the bathrooms are not maintained regularly. The fish cleaning station will not be operational until the water is turned on, sometime in April. The docks are not anticipated to be in use until late May.

### **Bully Creek Reservoir**

- The boat ramp has approximately 25 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp. The docks are anticipated to be floating in early to mid-April.

### **Carmen Reservoir**

- The closure has been extended to spring of 2025.

### **Clackamas Lake**

- Currently Closed. Tentative open date 5/19/23, depending on snow conditions. Plan ahead. When Timothy Lake campgrounds are full, consider going to Clackamas Lake and enjoy paddling on this small, shallow waterbody.

### **Clear Lake (Linn County)**

- The hand launch is open at the Clear Lake Resort.

### **Columbia River**

- From September 15 through May 14, 2023, boaters may only pass-through the locks at Bonneville, The Dalles and John Day during daytime hours. Winter recreational lock schedule begins September 15th on Lower Columbia.

### **Coos Bay**

- The California Street boat ramp is open and accessible.
- Empire Boat Ramp boarding docks are removed for inspection and repairs. Docks are anticipated to be reinstalled in late May.

### **Cooper Creek Reservoir**

- The boat ramps and docks are open.

### **Cottage Grove Reservoir**

- Boating access sites are anticipated to reopen in mid-May.

### **Cougar Reservoir**

- Slide Creek and Echo Park are closed. The water is approximately 120 feet below the bottom of the boat ramps.

### **Crane Prairie**

- Quinn River, Rock Creek and Crane Prairie boat ramps are open. The campgrounds are closed. Crane Prairie Reservoir is 85% full. The docks are not installed. To monitor when docks will be installed check here [Deschutes National Forest - Home \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/land-management/land-ownership/lands-deschutes-national-forest).

### **Crescent Lake**

- Crescent Lake Campground is closed. The reservoir is 10% full.

### **Crump Lake**

- The lake is closed.

### **Deschutes River**

- Aspen, Big River and Lava Island Day use boating access sites are open. Aspen and Lava Island Day Use are also hiking trailheads for the Deschutes River Trail. ### **Detroit Lake**

- Hoover, Cove Creek, Southshore, State Park G Loop are closed.

- Mongold Low Water boat ramp has approximately 25 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Depoe Bay**

- Depoe Bay boat ramp is open and new boarding docks are anticipated to be installed in April. The Depoe Bay Crab Feed and Chowder Cook Off is April 15, from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm at the Depoe Bay Community Hall. The event is not anticipated to impact boating access.

### **Dexter Reservoir**

- State Park boat ramps are open. Water is approximately five feet above the bottom of the ramps. The Collegiate Covered Bridge Regatta is April 8, from 6:00 am to 5:00 pm. [The Covered Bridge Regatta – Oregon Association of Rowers \(wordpress.com\)](https://www.oregonrowing.com/).

### **Diamond Lake**

- The North end boat ramp and restrooms are open. The South end and Thielson View are still closed for the season.

### **Dorena Reservoir**

- Baker Bay Marina is opening April 1<sup>st</sup> and the campground is anticipated to open on April 7. Water is 45 feet above the bottom of the ramp.

### **Emigrant Lake**

- North Boat Ramp (Area A) is open for limited use. West Boat Ramp Area (Area B) is closed due to low water. The reservoir is 39% full.

### **Estacada Lake**

- Timber Park nonmotorized boat launch will reopen May 1<sup>st</sup>. A new \$5.00 parking permit is required and can be paid by credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass available by calling 503-464-8515 or emailing: [pgeparks@pgn.com](mailto:pgeparks@pgn.com).

### **Fall Creek Reservoir**

- All boat ramps are out of water and gated. The reservoir is drawdown to streambed or approximately 70 below the boat ramp.

### **Faraday Lake**

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (Southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to reopen in 2023. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](https://www.portlandgeneral.com/).

### **Fern Ridge Reservoir**

- Richardson Park marina is opening April 1st and the campground on April 7th. There is approximately seven feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Orchard Point marina is opening April 1st. There is approximately eight feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Perkins Peninsula Park is anticipated to open on May 15th.

### **Floras Lake**

- Boice Cope ramp is open and accessible.

### **Foster Reservoir**

- Sunnyside boat ramp has approximately three feet of water above bottom of ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- Calkins Park and Gedney boat launches are out of water.

### **Fourmile Lake**

- Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp is closed. USFS anticipates reopening in July. Reservoir is approximately 29% full.

### **Galesville Reservoir**

- Chief Miwaleta ramp and dock are open.

### **Green Peter Reservoir**

- Thistle Creek low water boat ramp is open. There is approximately 40 feet of water above bottom of the ramp.

### **Henry Hagg Lake**

- Ramp A has approximately 70 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Ramp C has approximately 60 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Eagle Point Recreation Area restroom is closed for repairs. Portable toilets are available.

### **Haystack Reservoir**

- The boat ramps are open. Reservoir is 74% full.

### **Hells Canyon Reservoir**

- Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

### **Hemlock Lake**

- Hemlock Lake is open.

### **Hills Creek Reservoir**

- Water at the Packard Creek boat ramp is approximately 10 feet *below* bottom of the boat ramp. Bingham and CT Beach are open; however, water is 80 feet *below* the bottom of the ramp.

### **Howard Prairie Lake**

- Grizzly Park, Klum Landing, Willow Point, and Howard Prairie Resort are currently closed. The water level is approximately 20% full. Small boats can use the unimproved access near the dam.

### **Lake Billy Chinook**

- Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps are open year-round.
- Perry South Day Use is open pending road conditions.

### **Lake Harriet**

- Inaccessible by vehicle due to snow.

### **Lake of the Woods**

- Lake of the Woods Resort is open. For additional information, contact the Resort at 866-201-4194.

### **Lake Owyhee Reservoir**

- The Indian Creek boat ramp has 25 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- The Gordon Gulch boat ramp has 10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the boat ramp's lower portion, causing expensive repairs and permitting.

### **Lake Simtustus**

- Pelton Park Marina closed for season. Boat launches are open.

### **Lookout Point Reservoir**

- Signal Point Launch has approximately 30 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Loon Lake**

- Loon Lake Recreation Site is anticipated reopen in May. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year around. Paddle craft can carry down from the Day Use Area.

### **Lost Creek Reservoir**

- Joseph Stewart boat ramp reopened on January 6th. There is approximately 18 feet of water at the end of the boat ramp. Takelma boat ramp has approximately 78 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. The boarding docks were removed and will not be reinstalled.

### **McKenzie River**

- Ben and Kay Dorris State Park: single boat ramp open. No Park facilities due to the Holiday Fire.
- Olallie Boat Launch is still under snow, full-spanning strainer just downstream – portage or lower river put-in recommended; continued tree fall in river expected from Knoll Fire scar across river and downstream. [Check the Boating Obstruction Map for other waterway hazards.](#)
- Frisell and Paradise Boat Launches snow has recently melted. The boat launches are open.
- McKenzie Bridge Boat Launch is open.
- Bruckart Boat Launch is open.

### **Middle Fork of the Middle Fork Willamette River**

- Pengra Access: ramp open.

### **North Santiam River**

- **UPDATE: Fishermen's Bend Recreation Site will remain open, however, there will be no sanitation available. Please plan ahead.**
- For information about boating hazards and obstructions visit the Obstructions Dashboard.

### **North Twin Lake**

- Boating access is open. The campground is closed.

### **North Umpqua River**

- Boulder Flat raft launch, Horseshoe Bend raft launch, and Gravel Bin are open.
- Horsehoe Bend campground is closed.

### **Ochoco Lake**

- The reservoir is 15% full. The boat ramp is closed.

### **Pilcher Creek Reservoir**

- Boat ramps and docks are out of the water, but, paddle craft could be carried down. Water is very low and partially frozen over. Use caution when putting in. Docks are anticipated to be reinstalled in mid to late April.

### **Rogue River**

- Argo Recreation Site is closed until further notice due to the Rum Creek Fire. The road is closed just past Almeda Campground to the Grave Creek Bridge.
- Access to Grave Creek Boat Launch is accessible via Lowe Grave Creek Road.
- Almeda Boat Launch and Rand River access is open.
- Baker Park is open, but the river level is low. Construction of a new restroom is anticipated to begin in late spring to early summer. Security cameras have been upgraded at this location.

### **Thief Valley Reservoir**

- Boat ramp is open and docks are anticipated to be installed mid-late April. The water is partially frozen.

### **Tillamook Bay**

- The Memaloose Boat Launch dredging project has been completed and the launch is now open for the public to use.

### **Toketee Lake**

- This lake is located approximately 60 miles east of Roseburg. The boat ramp is open year-round and launches into a narrow channel to the main body of the lake. Angling and paddling are popular activities.

### **Trojan Pond**

- Trojan Park is open year-round for paddling and day use.

### **Tualatin River**

- ODOT is soliciting comments on the I-205 Toll Project-De Minimis Impact Determination for the Tualatin River Water Trail until **April 7, 2023**. This is your opportunity to comment on the impact of river closures during construction and your ability to use the Tualatin River. - Rood Bridge boat ramp is closed, and docks are anticipated to be reinstalled at the end of May.



**Turner Lake**

- North Turner Lake boat ramp and docks are open.

**Unity Reservoir**

- There is approximately 16 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp at Unity Lake State Park. The campground will open on April 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Wickiup Reservoir**

- Wickiup Reservoir is 66% full.

**Lower (Columbia River to Willamette Falls)**

- Sportcraft Landing, the boat ramp, boarding docks and lower parking area are open. The ODOT bridge contractor is working, watch for barges and work boats in the area.
- Jon Storm Park dock, restrooms and pumpout and dump station are open, however, the parking lot will be closed until completion of the I-205 bridge widening project.

**Warm Springs Reservoir**

- Water is 25 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

**Wolf Creek Reservoir**

Boat ramps and docks are out of the water but, paddlecraft could be carried down. Water is low and partially frozen over. Docks are anticipated to be reinstalled in mid to late April.
