#### **Agate Lake**

- The ramp is open and the lake is 90% full.

#### **Agency Lake**

- UPDATE: Henzel and Petric Park's boarding docks are installed.

#### **Alsea Bay**

- Port of Alsea boat launch and marina facilities are open.

#### **Applegate Reservoir**

- NEW: The Rogue Valley Bassmaster's Tournament is scheduled for April 15, from 5:00 am to 3:00 pm. [Tournament Schedule \(roguevalleybass.com\)](https://www.roguevalleybass.com)
- UPDATE: Copper boat ramp has approximately 40 feet over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: French Gulch has more than 100 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Hart-Tish has more than 30 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.

#### **Ben Irving Reservoir**

- The boat ramp and dock are open.

### **Beulah Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The water is approximately 50% full and covers five feet over the bottom of the ramp.

### **Big Lake**

- Big Lake West, Big Lake campground, Big Lake Day Use and boat ramp are closed.

### **Blue River Reservoir**

- Lookout Boat Ramp is closed to trailed boats. Paddlers can carry down to access the reservoir.
- The water is approximately 30 feet above the end of the Saddle Dam boat ramp, which is currently closed.

### **Brownlee Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The Hewitt Park boat ramp is open. The Crappie Shootout, a kayak fishing tournament, is scheduled for May 20th. [Upcoming Events – Travel Baker County](#). A new vault toilet is being installed near the Hewitt low water boat ramp.
- The Holcomb Park boat ramp is closed to all use. The water level is 10 feet below the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: The Farewell Bend State Park water level is approximately one foot above the boat ramp.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open and has approximately 20 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- The Spring Recreation Campground will open in April. This site will begin charging fees at that time. The water is approximately 17 feet below the boat ramp. There is no water, trash service, or onsite host at this time and the bathrooms are not maintained regularly. The fish cleaning station will not be operational until the water is turned on sometime in April. The docks will not be available until late May.

### **Bully Creek Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The boat ramp has approximately 35 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp and the docks are floating.

### **Carmen Smith Reservoir**

- The closure has been extended to the spring of 2025.

### **Clackamas Lake**

- Currently closed. The tentative opening date is May 19, depending on snow conditions. Plan ahead. When the Timothy Lake campgrounds are full, consider going here and enjoy paddling on this small, shallow lake.

### **Clear Lake (Linn County)**

- The hand launch is open at the Clear Lake Resort.

### **Cold Springs Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Cold Springs Reservoir is 45% full.

### **Columbia River**

- From September 15, 2022, through May 14, 2023, boaters can only pass-through Bonneville, The Dalles and John Day locks during the daytime hours.

### **Cooper Creek Reservoir**

- The boat ramps and docks are open.

### **Coos Bay**

- The California Street boat ramp is open and accessible.
- Empire Boat Ramp boarding docks were removed for inspection and repairs. The docks are anticipated to be reinstalled in late May.

### **Cottage Grove Reservoir**

- Boating access sites are anticipated to reopen in mid-May.

### **Cougar Reservoir**

- Slide Creek and Echo Park are closed. The water is approximately 100 feet below the bottom of the boat ramps.

### **Crane Prairie**

- Quinn River, Rock Creek and Crane Prairie boat ramps are open. The campgrounds are closed. Crane Prairie Reservoir is 85% full. The docks are not installed. ### **Crescent Lake**

- Crescent Lake Campground is closed. The reservoir is 10% full.

### **Crump Lake**

- The lake is closed.

### **Depoe Bay**

- Depoe Bay boat ramp is open and new boarding docks are in the process of being installed. The Crab Feed and Chowder Cook-Off is April 15 from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm at the Depoe Bay Community Hall. The event will not affect boating access.

### **Deschutes River**

- Aspen, Big River and Lava Island Day use boating access sites are open. Aspen and Lava Island Day Use are also hiking trailheads for the Deschutes River Trail. To learn more about the trail [Deschutes National Forest - Deschutes River Trail \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov)

### **Detroit Lake**

- Hoover, Cove Creek, Southshore, State Park G Loop, State Park D, and Kane's Marina are closed.
- UPDATE: The Mongold Low Water boat ramp has approximately 50 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.

### **Devils Lake**

- NEW: The park closed on April 12-17 due to high water conditions.

### **Dexter Reservoir**

- UPDATE: State Park boat ramps are open. Water is approximately six feet above the bottom of the ramps. The Covered Bridge Regatta is scheduled for April 15-16. [The Covered Bridge Regatta – Oregon Association of Rowers \(wordpress.com\)](https://www.wordpress.com)
- NEW: The Dexter Lake Invite is scheduled for April 29, from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm. The championship event will be May 14. [Women's Rowing Release 2023 Spring Schedule - Oregon State University Athletics \(osubeavers.com\)](https://www.osubeavers.com)

### **Diamond Lake**

- The North end boat ramp and restrooms are open. The South end and Thielson View are still closed for the season.

### **Dorena Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The Baker Bay boat ramp has more than 60 feet of water above the bottom of the ramp.
- NEW: Harms Park boat ramp has approximately 3 feet of water above the bottom of the ramp.

### **Emigrant Lake**

- UPDATE: Lake at 50%. The North Ramp is open. Use caution - inflow of water is creating high levels of woody debris flow throughout the lake and near the ramp and shorelines.

### **Estacada Lake**

- Timber Park nonmotorized boat launch will reopen May 1. A new \$5.00 parking permit is required and can be paid by credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass is available by calling or emailing: 503-464-8515, [pgeparks@pqn.com](mailto:pgeparks@pqn.com)

### **Fall Creek Reservoir**

- UPDATE: North Shore has approximately 50 feet of water covering the end of the ramp. All other ramps are out of the water and gated until May.

### **Faraday Lake**

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (Southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to reopen in 2023. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://FaradayLake(portlandgeneral.com))

### **Fern Ridge Reservoir**

- NEW: Fern Ridge Shores has more than five feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Orchard Point Marina is open. There is approximately 10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Perkins Peninsula Park is anticipated to open on May 15. There is approximately five feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Richardson Park marina is open. There is approximately 8 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Floras Lake**

- Boice Cope ramp is open and accessible.

### **Foster Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Calkins Park Boat Ramp closed. The water is 15 feet *below* the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Sunnyside Boat ramp is open and has approximately four feet of water covering the end of the ramp.

### **Fourmile Lake**

- Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp are closed. USFS anticipates reopening in July. The reservoir is approximately 30% full.

### **Galesville Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The Chief Miwaleta ramp is open. The County is removing the partially submerged docks on April 14. The high water levels have added substantial woody debris. keep a sharp lookout when boating.

### **Green Peter Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Thistle Creek boat ramp is open. There is approximately 65 feet of water above the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Whitcomb Creek boat ramp water level is approximately 15 feet above the bottom of the ramp. Boarding docks are floating.

### **Haystack Reservoir**

- The boat ramps are open and accessible. The reservoir is 85% full.

### **Hells Canyon Reservoir**

- Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

### **Hemlock Lake**

- Hemlock Lake is open.

### **Henry Hagg Lake**

- Eagle Point Recreation Area restroom is closed for repairs. Portable toilets are available.
- Ramp A and C are open with adequate water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Hills Creek Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Bingham boat ramp is open. However, water is approximately 70 feet below the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: CT Beach is open. However, water is approximately 60 feet below the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Water at Packard Creek is approximately 10 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp

### **Howard Prairie Lake**

- Grizzly Park, Klum Landing, Willow Point, and Howard Prairie Resort are currently closed. The water level is approximately 23% full. Small boats can use the unimproved access near the dam.

### **Hyatt Lake**

- The water level is 22% full at this time.

### **Kinglsey Reservoir**

- Campground is currently closed due to high snowpack levels.

### **Lake Billy Chinook**

- Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps will stay open year-round.
- Perry South Day Use is open, pending road conditions.

### **Lake Harriet**

- Lake Harriet Campground and Day Use area are currently closed.

### **Lake of the Woods**

- Lake of the Woods Resort is open. For additional information contact the Resort at 866-201-4194.

### **Lake Owyhee Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Gordon Gulch has 15 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Indian Creek boat ramp has 30 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Lake Simtustus**

- Pelton Park Marina closed. Boat launch is open.
- NEW: Reservations for Indian Park Campground are now available online through the Warm Springs Fisheries Department. [Indian Park Camping – Check Availability – Department of Fisheries \(warmsprings-nasn.gov\)](http://www.warmsprings-nasn.gov)

### **Lookout Point Reservoir**

- Signal Point Launch has approximately 60 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Black Canyon water level is approximately 10 feet below the boat ramp.

### **Loon Lake**

- Loon Lake Recreation Site closed and is due to reopen in May. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year-round. Paddlecraft can carry down from the Day Use Area.

### **Lost Creek Reservoir**

- There is approximately 25 feet of water at the end of the boat ramp.
- Takelma boat ramp has approximately 85 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. The boarding docks were removed and will not be reinstalled.

### **Luckiamute River**

- Luckiamute Landing is open.

### **McKenzie River**

- Ben and Kay Dorris State Park's single boat ramp open. There are no park facilities due to the Holiday Fire.
- Full-spanning strainer just downstream – portage or lower river put-in recommended; continued tree fall in river expected from Knoll Fire scar across river and downstream. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](#)
- Frisell and Paradise Boat Launches are open.
- McKenzie Bridge Boat Launch open.
- Bruckart Boat Launch is open.

### **Middle Fork of the Middle Fork Willamette River**

- Pengra Access: The ramp is open.

### **North Santiam River**

Fishermen's Bend Recreation Site will remain open, however, there will be no sanitation available. Please plan ahead. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](#)

### **North Santiam River**

- NEW: Lyons-Mehama and Stayton Bridge boat ramps are open.

### **North Twin Lake**

- Boating access is open. The campground is closed.



### **North Umpqua River**

- Boulder Flat raft launch, Horseshoe Bend raft launch and Gravel Bin are open. The Horseshoe Bend campground is closed.

### **Ochoco Lake**

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 26% full and not accessible by motorized boat. Non-motorized launching is difficult.

### **Olalla Reservoir**

- Boat launch is open and the reservoir is full.

### **Paulina Lake**

- NEW: Hazard tree inspectors identified more than 300 hazard trees within Paulina Lake Campground. Crews removed a majority of these trees last fall; however, some hazard tree removal work remains. The remaining hazard tree work will resume as soon as snow levels permit this spring. In anticipation of this work, the opening date for Paulina Lake Campground will be delayed by two weeks to June 30. ### **Pilcher Creek Reservoir**

- The water level is improving. The anticipated reopening is for the end of April.

### **Plat I Reservoir**

- Reservoir is full and open for recreation.

### **Port of Alsea**

- Port of Alsea boat launch and marina are open.

### **Prineville Reservoir**

- Roberts Bay, Powderhouse Cove, Jasper Point Park and the Resort boat ramps are currently closed because of low water. Most of the ramps are gated when closed.
- NEW: Prineville State Park Day Use water level is near the end of the boat ramp. The waterflow indicates the boat ramp should be open by the end of the month, if not sooner.
- The County boat ramp is open, but use caution.
- Floating restrooms might not be installed this season due to low water.
- In A Landscape event is scheduled for April 22 at the Prineville day use area. [Oregon State Parks](https://www.oregonstateparks.com/)

## **Rogue River**

- Access at the Argo Recreation Site is closed until further notice due to the Rum Creek Fire. The road is closed just past Alameda Campground to the Grave Creek Bridge.
- Access to Grave Creek Boat Launch is accessible via Lower Grave Creek Rd.
- Alameda Boat Launch and Rand River access are open.
- Baker Park is open. Boat Ramp is out of the water. The river levels are adequate for paddlecraft launching. Security cameras have been upgraded at this location.
- Casey, Rogue Elk, Shady Cove, and Dodge Bridge access sites are all open.

## **Siletz River**

- NEW: There is a large fallen tree approximately one mile downstream of Moonshine Park that spans the river and could lead to capsizing. Put in at Twin Bridge boat launch downstream of the obstruction. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](#)
- Old Mill Park is open, and the ramp is in the water. Old Mill Park will be closed April on 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> to assess the road stability.
- Hee Hee Ilahee is open and the ramp is in the water.

## **Snake River**

- Dug Bar, Pittsburg Landing Campground are all open.
- Hells Canyon Creek boat launch is closed.

## **South Santiam River**

- UPDATE: Waterloo County Boat Ramp is open

## **Spring Creek**

- UPDATE: Collier Memorial Park is closed through May.

## **Summit Lake**

- Summit Lake is closed.

### **Tenmile Lake**

- Tenmile County Ramp will have intermittent sidewalk construction depending on weather over the next few weeks. All of the work is anticipated to be completed before Memorial Day weekend.

### **Thief Valley Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Thief Valley Reservoir is full and the boat ramp is open.

### **Tillamook Bay**

- The Memaloose Boat Launch dredging project is complete and the launch is now open for the public to use.

### **Timothy Lake**

- UPDATE: North Arm, Oak Fork, Pine Point, and West Shore Day Use areas are closed until May 26.

### **Trojan Pond**

- Trojan Park is open year-round for paddling and day use.

### **Tualatin River**

- NEW: The Farmington Boat Launch restroom building is closed. Portable restrooms are available.
- ODOT is soliciting comments on the I-205 Toll Project-De Minimis Impact Determination for the Tualatin River Water Trail until **April 17**. This is your opportunity to comment on the impact of river closures during construction and your ability to use the Tualatin River. - Rood Bridge boat ramp is closed, and docks are anticipated to be reinstalled at the end of May.

### **Turner Lake**

- North Turner Lake is open.

### **Upper Klamath Lake**

- Wocus Bay ramp and docks are open. The floating restroom is temporarily moored there while the County is purchasing parts to reanchor the restroom.

### **Unity Reservoir**

- There is approximately 20 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp at Unity Lake State Park. The boarding docks are floating and the campground is open.

**Wallowa Lake**

- NEW: Wallowa Lake State Park is open. Be cautious of recent snow and ice on boat ramp.

**Warm Springs Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Reservoir is 55% full and water is 15 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

**Wickiup Reservoir**

- Wickiup Reservoir is 66% full.

**Lower Willamette (Columbia River to Willamette Falls)**

- Sportcraft Landing, the boat ramp, boarding docks and lower parking area are open. The ODOT bridge contractor is working, so watch for barges and work boats in the area.
- Jon Storm Park dock, restrooms and pumpout and dump station are open, but the parking lot will be closed until the completion of the I-205 bridge widening project.

**Upper Willamette (Salem to Eugene)**

- NEW: McCartney Boat Ramp is open.
- NEW: Peoria Park Boat Ramp is open.

**Willow Lake**

- Ramp and dock are open. The reservoir is 96% full.

**Wolf Creek Reservoir**

- Water level is improving. Anticipated reopening mid-April.
