Agate Lake

- UPDATE: The ramp is open, and the lake is 90% full.

Agency Lake

- Henzel and Petric Park's boarding docks have been seasonally removed. The boat ramps are open.

Alsea Bay

- Port of Alsea boat launch and marina facilities are open.

Applegate Reservoir

- UPDATE: French Gulch has more than 90 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Copper boat ramp has approximately 28 feet over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Hart-Tish has more than 20 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.

Ben Irving Reservoir

- Boat ramp and dock open.

Beulah Reservoir

- Water approximately 37% full.

Big Lake

- Big Lake West and Big Lake campgrounds, Big Lake Day Use and boat ramp are closed.

Blue River Reservoir

- Lookout Boat Ramp is closed to trailed boaters. Paddlers can carry down to access the reservoir. The water is approximately 10 feet above the end of Saddle Dam boat ramp, which is currently closed.

Brownlee Reservoir

- The Hewitt Park boat ramp is closed to all use. The park opened April 1st for camping. The annual Easter Egg Hunt will happen April 8th. The Crappie Shootout, a kayak fishing tournament is scheduled for May 20th. A new vault toilet is being installed near the Hewitt low water boat ramp. Three new life vest kiosks will be in service early in the season.
- The Holcomb Park boat ramp is closed to all use. The water level is 15 feet below the boat ramp. The campground opened April 1st.
- Farewell Bend State Park water level is approximately five feet below the boat ramp. Paddlers can carry down.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open and has approximately 50 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- The Spring Recreation Campground will open on or around April 1st. This site will begin charging fees at that time. The water is approximately 23 feet below the boat ramp. There is currently no water, trash service, or onsite host and the bathrooms are not maintained regularly. The fish cleaning station will not be operational until the water is turned on sometime in April. The docks are not anticipated to be in use until late May.

Bully Creek Reservoir

- The boat ramp has approximately 30 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp. The docks are anticipated to be floating in early to mid-April.

Carmen Smith Reservoir

- The closure has been extended to Spring of 2025.

Clackamas Lake

- Currently Closed. Tentative open date 5/19/23, depending on snow conditions. Plan ahead, when Timothy Lake campgrounds are full consider going here and enjoy paddling on this small, shallow lake.

Clear Lake (Linn County)

- The hand launch is open at the Clear Lake Resort.

Cold Springs Reservoir

- Cold Springs Reservoir is 42% full.

Columbia River

- From September 15 through May 14, 2023, boaters can only pass-through Bonneville, The Dalles and John Day locks during daytime hours.

Coos Bay

- The California Street boat ramp is open and accessible.
- Empire Boat Ramp boarding docks are removed for inspection and repairs. Docks are anticipated to be reinstalled in late May.

Cooper Creek Reservoir

- The boat ramps and docks are open.

Cottage Grove Reservoir

- Boating access sites are anticipated to reopen in mid-May.

Cougar Reservoir

- Slide Creek and Echo Park are closed. The water is approximately 120 feet below the bottom of the boat ramps.

Crane Prairie

- Quinn River, Rock Creek and Crane Prairie boat ramps are open. The campgrounds are closed. Crane Prairie Reservoir is 85% full. The docks are not installed. To monitor when docks will be installed: [Deschutes National Forest - Home \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/land-management/land-use/land-use-planning/land-use-planning-home).

Crescent Lake

- Crescent Lake Campground is closed. The reservoir is 10% full.

Crump Lake

- The lake is closed.

Deschutes River

- Aspen, Big River and Lava Island Day use boating access sites are open. Aspen and Lava Island Day Use are also hiking trailheads for the Deschutes River Trail. Depoe Bay

- UPDATE: Depoe Bay boat ramp is open and new boarding docks are anticipated to be installed on April 5 and 6. The Crab Feed and Chowder Cook Off is April 15 from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm at the Depoe Bay Community Hall. Boating access shouldn't be impacted.

Detroit Lake

- Hoover, Cove Creek, Southshore, State Park G Loop, State Park D, and Kane's Marina are closed.
- UPDATE: Mongold Low Water boat ramp has approximately 30 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.

Dexter Reservoir

- State Park boat ramps are open. Water is approximately six feet above the bottom of the ramps. The Collegiate Covered Bridge Regatta is April 8 from 6:00 am to 5:00 pm. [The Covered Bridge Regatta – Oregon Association of Rowers \(wordpress.com\)](http://www.wordpress.com)

Diamond Lake

- The North end boat ramp and restrooms are open. The South end and Thielson View are still closed for the season.

Dorena Reservoir

- UPDATE: Baker Bay boat ramp has more than 50 feet of water above the bottom of the ramp.

Emigrant Lake

- UPDATE: Lake at 40%. North Ramp open. Use caution. The in-flow of water is creating high levels of woody debris throughout the lake and near the ramp and shorelines.

Estacada Lake

- Timber Park nonmotorized boat launch will reopen May 1. A new \$5.00 parking permit is required and can be paid with a credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass is available by calling or emailing: (503) 464-8515, pgeparks@pqn.com

Fall Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: North Shore low water ramp is open as of April 1. All other ramps are out of the water and gated.

Faraday Lake

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (Southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to be reopened in 2023. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com)

Fern Ridge Reservoir

- Richardson Park marina is opening April 1 and the campground April 7. There is approximately seven feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Orchard Point marina is opening April 1. There is approximately eight feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Perkins Peninsula Park is anticipated to open on May 15. There is approximately four feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.

Floras Lake

- The Boice Cope boat ramp is open and accessible.

Foster Reservoir

- Sunnyside boat ramp has approximately two feet of water above bottom of ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Fourmile Lake

- UPDATE: Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp are closed. The US Forest Service anticipates reopening in July. The reservoir is approximately 30% full.

Galesville Reservoir

- The Chief Miwaleta ramp and dock are open.

Green Peter Reservoir

- UPDATE: Thistle Creek boat ramp is open. Approximately 50 feet of water above bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Whitcomb Creek water level is approximately two feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

Haystack Reservoir

- The boat ramps are open and accessible. The reservoir is 74% full.

Hells Canyon Reservoir

- Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

Hemlock Lake

- Hemlock Lake is open.

Henry Hagg Lake

- Ramp A has approximately 70 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Ramp C has approximately 60 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Eagle Point Recreation Area restroom is closed for repairs. Portable toilets are available.

Hills Creek Reservoir

- Water at the Packard Creek boat ramp is approximately five feet *below* bottom of the boat ramp. Bingham and CT Beach are open; however, the water is 71 feet *below* the bottom of the ramp.

Howard Prairie Lake

- Grizzly Park, Klum Landing, Willow Point, and Howard Prairie Resort are currently closed. The water level is approximately 20% full. Small boats can use the unimproved access near the dam.

Hyatt Lake

- The water level is 19% full.

Kinglsey Reservoir

- UPDATE: Campground is currently closed due to snowpack.

Lake Billy Chinook

- Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps will stay open year-round.
- Perry South Day Use is open pending road conditions.

Lake Harriet

- The ramp is inaccessible by vehicle, due to snow.

Lake of the Woods

- Lake of the Woods Resort is open. For additional information contact the Resort at 866-201-4194.

Lake Owyhee Reservoir

- The Indian Creek boat ramp has 28 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- The Gordon Gulch boat ramp has 12 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the boat ramp's lower portion, causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Lake Simtustus

- Pelton Park Marina closed for the season. Boat launches are open.

Lookout Point Reservoir

- UPDATE: Signal Point Launch has approximately 40 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Loon Lake

- Loon Lake Recreation Site closed, due to reopen in May. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year around. Paddlecraft can carry down from the Day Use Area.

Lost Creek Reservoir

- There is approximately 18 feet of water at the end of the boat ramp.
- Takelma boat ramp has approximately 80 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. The boarding docks were removed and will not be reinstalled.

Luckiamute River

- Luckiamute Landing is open.

McKenzie River

- Ben and Kay Dorris State Park: single boat ramp open. No Park facilities due to the Holiday Fire.
- Olallie Boat Launch is still under snow, full-spanning strainer just downstream – portage or lower river put-in recommended; continued tree fall in river expected from Knoll Fire scar across river and downstream. Check the [Boating Obstruction Map](#) for other waterway hazards.
- Frisell and Paradise Boat Launches are open.
- McKenzie Bridge Boat Launch is open.
- Bruckart Boat Launch is open.

Middle Fork of the Middle Fork Willamette River

- The Pengra Access ramp is open.

North Santiam River

Fishermen's Bend Recreation Site will remain open, however, there will be no sanitation available. Please plan ahead. For information about boating hazards and obstructions visit the [Obstructions Dashboard](#).

North Twin Lake

- Boating access is open. The campground is closed.

North Umpqua River

- Boulder Flat raft launch, Horseshoe Bend raft launch and Gravel Bin launch are open. The Horseshoe Bend campground is closed.

Ochoco Lake

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 17% full and not accessible by motorized boat. Non-motorized launch is difficult.

Olalla Reservoir

- NEW: Boat launch is open and in the water. The water level is full, at 68 feet.

Pilcher Creek Reservoir

- Boat ramps and docks are out of the water but paddle craft can be carried down. The water is very low and partially frozen. Use caution when putting in. Reopening is expected by mid-April.

Prineville Reservoir

- NEW: Roberts Bay West, Powder House Cove, Prineville Day Use, Jasper Point Day Use Parks and the Resort boat ramps are currently closed because of low water. Most ramps are gated when closed. Carrying paddlecraft is discouraged currently because of the long distance and sensitive soil conditions.
- NEW: The County boat ramp is open but use caution.
- NEW: The floating restrooms might not be installed this season due to low water.
- NEW: The "In A Landscape" event is scheduled for April 22, at Prineville day use area. Learn more: [Oregon State Parks](#)

Plat I Reservoir

- NEW: Reservoir is full and open for recreation.

Rogue River

- Access at Argo Recreation Site is closed until further notice due to the Rum Creek Fire. The road is closed just past Alameda Campground to the Grave Creek Bridge.
- Access to Grave Creek Boat Launch is accessible via Lowe Grave Creek Road.
- Alameda Boat Launch and Rand River access are open.
- Baker Park is open. The boat ramp is out of the water. River levels are adequate for paddlecraft launching. Security cameras have been upgraded at this location.
- NEW: Casey, Rogue Elk, Shady Cove, and Dodge Bridge access sites are all open.

Siletz River

- NEW: Old Mill Park is open, and the ramp is in the water. Old Mill Park will be closed on April 18th and 19th for assessment of the road's stability.
- NEW: Hee Hee Ilahee is open, and the ramp is in the water.

Snake River

- NEW: Dug Bar and Pittsburg Landing Campground are open.
- NEW: Hells Canyon Creek boat launch is closed.

Spring Creek

- NEW: Collier Memorial Park is open.

Summit Lake

- Summit Lake is closed.

Tenmile Lake

- NEW: Tenmile County Ramp will have intermittent sidewalk construction, weather dependent over the next few weeks. All of the work is anticipated to be completed before Memorial Day weekend.

Thief Valley Reservoir

- Thief Valley Reservoir is partially frozen. Use caution when putting in. Reopening is expected by mid-April.

Tillamook Bay

- The Memaloose Boat Launch dredging project is complete and the launch is now open for the public to use.

Timothy Lake

- Pine Point Day Use inaccessible by vehicle due to snow.
- West Shore Day Use inaccessible by vehicle due to snow.
- North Arm Day Use is closed for the season.
- Oak Fork Day Use closed for the season.

Trojan Pond

- Trojan Park is open year-round for paddling and day use.

Tualatin River

- ODOT is soliciting comments on the I-205 Toll Project-De Minimis Impact Determination for the Tualatin River Water Trail until **April 7**. This is your opportunity to comment on the impact of river closures during construction and your ability to use the Tualatin River. - The Rood Bridge boat ramp is closed, and docks are anticipated to be reinstalled at the end of May.

Turner Lake

- North Turner Lake is open.

Unity Reservoir

- UPDATE: There is approximately 17 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp at Unity Lake State Park. The boarding docks are floating, and the campground is open.

Wickiup Reservoir

- Wickiup Reservoir is 66% full.

Lower (Columbia River to Willamette Falls)

- Sportcraft Landing, the boat ramp, boarding docks and lower parking area are open. The ODOT bridge contractor is working. Watch for barges and work boats in the area.
- Jon Storm Park dock, restrooms and pumpout and dump station are open, but the parking lot will be closed until the completion of the I-205 bridge widening project.

Warm Springs Reservoir

- Reservoir is 15% full and water is 23 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

Willow Lake

- NEW: Ramp and dock are open. The reservoir is 96% full.

Wolf Creek Reservoir

- Boat ramps and docks are out of the water but paddlecraft can be carried down. The water is very low and partially frozen. Use caution when putting in. The reservoir is expected to reopen in mid-April.
