### **Agate Lake**

- The ramp is open, and the lake is full.
- Rogue Eagles annual Danny Stanton Memorial Float Fly is scheduled for May 19, 2023 through May 21, 2023. [Oregon State Marine Board : Recreational Boating Events : Agency Info : State of Oregon](#)

### **Agency Lake**

- Henzel and Petric Park's boat ramps are open, and the boarding docks are installed.

### **Applegate Reservoir**

- Hart-Tish has more than 55 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp. The boat ramp is open. The price to launch has increased from \$5 to \$7.
- Copper boat ramp has approximately 60 feet over the bottom of the ramp.
- French Gulch has more than 125 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.

### **Ben Irving Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The boat ramp and dock are open. ODFW stocked the reservoir with fish this week.

### **Beulah Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The water is approximately 20 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Big Lake**

- Big Lake West, Big Lake campgrounds, Big Lake Day Use and the boat ramp are closed.

### **Blue River Reservoir**

- Lookout Boat Ramp water level is approximately 15 feet over the end of the ramp.
- There is approximately 50 feet over the end of Saddle Dam boat ramp, which is currently closed.

### **Brownlee Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The Hewitt Park boat ramp is open. The new vault toilet has been installed. There is approximately 30 feet of water at the end of the ramp. The Park is at full capacity for the Crappie Shootout, a kayak fishing tournament, scheduled for May 20th. Three new life jacket loaner stations will be in service in May.
- UPDATE: The Spring Recreation Campground is now open. Both ramps are open, and the dock is floating. This site started charging fees this spring. The water is approximately 13 feet over the end of the boat ramp. There is currently no water, trash service, or onsite host and the bathrooms are not maintained regularly. Please be considerate of others if you use the fish cleaning station and clean up after yourself.
- The Holcomb Park boat ramp is open. The water level is 21 feet above the bottom of the boat ramp. The park is at full capacity for the Crappy Shootout scheduled for the weekend of May 20<sup>th</sup>.
- Farewell Bend State Park is open and the water level is approximately 31 feet above the boat ramp.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open. There is approximately 42 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Bully Creek Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The water is approximately 35 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp. The docks are installed and floating.

### **Carmen Smith Reservoir**

- The closure has been extended to Spring of 2025.

### **Chickahominy Reservoir**

- NEW: The lake is nearly full, ODFW recently stocked the lake with fish, and the boat ramp is open.

### **Clackamas Lake**

- Currently closed. The tentative opening date is May 26, depending on snow conditions. Plan ahead. When Timothy Lake campgrounds are full, consider going to Clackamas Lake to enjoy paddling.

### **Clackamas River**

- The Upper Clackamas Whitewater Festival is May 20<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>. There are multiple events planned at several locations. - Moore Creek, Sandstone, and Hole-in-the-Wall Boating Access sites are open. Areas along the Clackamas River are still heavily impacted by wildfire. Visitors are recommended to exercise caution if pulling out at non-designated areas.

### **Clear Lake (Linn County)**

- Boating access is open for paddlecraft.

### **Coast Fork-Willamette River**

- The Highway 58 bridge at Dilley Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. The boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor for an anticipated schedule. The work may happen as early as June 2023 or sometime in 2024 or 2025. ### **Coffenbury Lake**

- Fort Stevens State Park Boat Launch is open, and the lake is full

### **Cold Springs Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Cold Springs Reservoir is approximately 55% full.

### **Columbia River**

- Hat Rock State Park has a Paddlecraft Demo Day scheduled on May 13<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm.

- Chinook Landing pumpout and dump station are fully operational and open to the public.
- City of St. Helens Courthouse Docks are open, and the pumpout and dump station are operational. There will be some construction in the park throughout the summer; however, access will remain open. Bull rails on the docks are in poor condition and larger vessels are urged to be cautious when tying up.
- City of St. Helens Sand Island North and South are open.
- From September 15 through May 14, 2023, boaters can only pass-through Bonneville, The Dalles and John Day locks during daytime hours.

### **Cooper Creek Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Cooper Creek East and West boat ramps are open, the docks are floating and ODFW stocked the lake with fish this week.

### **Coos Bay**

- Repairs to North Jetty. Construction to last until December 2025.

- The California Street boat ramp and docks are open.
- Empire Boat Ramp boarding docks were removed for inspection and repairs. The docks are anticipated to be reinstalled in June.

### **Coquille River**

- NEW: Bullards Beach docks are installed, and the facilities are open.

### **Cottage Grove Reservoir**

- Lakeside Boat Ramp is open, and docks are floating. There is approximately 40 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- Wilson Creek Boat Ramp is open. There is approximately seven feet of water over the end of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

### **Cougar Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Slide Creek Campground is open; however, the water is approximately 60 feet below the bottom of the ramp. Paddlers can carry down, but the terrain is difficult.

- Echo Park remains closed. The water is approximately 60 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Crane Prairie**

- Crane Prairie Resort is open and “thawed out.” The Resort is open from 7:00 am-6:00 pm.
- Quinn River, Rock Creek and Crane Prairie boat ramps are open. The campgrounds are closed. Crane Prairie Reservoir is 87% full. The docks are not installed. To monitor when docks will be installed: [Deschutes National Forest - Home \(usda.gov\)](#)

### **Crescent Lake**

- Crescent Lake Campground is closed. The reservoir is 12% full.

### **Crystal Creek**

- NEW: Malone Springs Day Use is located approximately 45 minutes northwest of Klamath Falls. This small paddle access is part of the Upper Klamath Canoe Trail that meanders through marshes and is part of the Upper Klamath National Wildlife Refuge. ### **Depoe Bay**

- Depoe Bay Boat Ramp is open. Boarding docks have been installed.

### **Deschutes River**

- NEW: Heritage Landing is open, and the ramp is in the water. There is no dock at this facility. The sand bar at the mouth of the Deschutes may result in reduced access to the Columbia River during periods of low water.
- Aspen, Big River and Lava Island Day use boating access sites are open. Aspen and Lava Island Day Use are also hiking trailheads for the Deschutes River Trail. To learn more about the trail: [Deschutes National Forest - Deschutes River Trail \(usda.gov\)](#)

### **Detroit Lake**

- UPDATE: State Park D has four feet of water over the bottom of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- UPDATE: Southshore has 18 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Mongold upper boat ramp is open, and docks are floating

- Kane's Marina has 14 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp. The marina is open.
- Hoover has 17 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp and is scheduled to open in May.
- Cove Creek has 19 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp and is scheduled to open on May 13.
- State Park G Loop has 30 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp. The anticipated opening is May 18.

### **Dexter Reservoir**

- Lowell and Dexter State Park boat ramps are open except for event closure as noted below. Water is approximately 10 feet above the bottom of the ramps.
- The Dexter Lake Invite championship event is scheduled for May 14. [Women's Rowing Release 2023 Spring Schedule - Oregon State University Athletics \(osubeavers.com\)](https://osubeavers.com). ### **Diamond Lake**

- The North end boat ramp and restrooms are open. The South End and Thielson View are still closed for the season.

### **Dorena Reservoir**

- Baker Bay boat ramp is open and has more than 60 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- Harms Park boat ramp is open. There is approximately five feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

### **Eel Lake**

- William M. Tugman State Park boat launch and kayak launch are open.

### **Emigrant Lake**

- UPDATE: The lake is 71% full. The North ramp is open, and the West ramp has one lane open. Use caution - inflow of water is creating high levels of woody debris throughout the lake.

### **Estacada Lake**

- Timber Park nonmotorized boat launch opened May 1st. A new \$5.00 parking permit is required and can be paid for by credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass available by calling or emailing: 503-464-8515, [pgeparks@pgn.com](mailto:pgeparks@pgn.com).

### **Fall Creek Reservoir**

- North Shore low water ramp is open. Water is fluctuating between 0 and 10 feet over the end of the ramp. All other ramps are out of the water and gated for now. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

### **Faraday Lake**

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (Southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to be reopened in 2023. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com)

### **Fern Ridge Reservoir**

- Perkins Peninsula Park is open. There is approximately five feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Fern Ridge Shores has more than six feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Orchard Point Marina is open. There is approximately nine feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Richardson Park marina is open. There is approximately eight feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Floras Lake**

- The Boice Cope ramp is open and accessible.

### **Foster Reservoir**

- Sunnyside Boat ramp is open. The water level fluctuates between one and three feet of water over the end of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

- Gedney Creek is closed. The water is approximately five feet below the end of the ramp.
- Calkins Park Boat Ramp closed. The water is 17 feet *below* the end of the ramp.

#### **Fourmile Lake**

- UPDATE: Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp are closed. The U.S. Forest Service anticipates reopening in July. The reservoir is approximately 39% full.

#### **Galesville Reservoir**

- Chief Miwaleta ramp is open. The County has removed the docks for repair. There is significant woody debris floating due to high water. Keep a sharp lookout when boating.

#### **Gold Lake**

- UPDATE: Access is closed from the Cedar Creek Fire Emergency. The Forest Order identifies the closure is in effect through June 25, 2023 unless rescinded sooner: [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/forestry/land-management/forest-restoration/cedar-creek-fire-emergency). The U.S. Forest Service is monitoring snow and road conditions and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. #### **Green Peter Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Thistle Creek and Whitcomb Creek boat ramps are open. Boarding docks are available. Watch for debris.

#### **Green Point Reservoir / Kinglsey Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The snow has melted, and trees are being cleaned up out of the campground. The anticipated opening is Memorial Day Weekend.

#### **Haystack Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The boat ramp is back open, and the fishing is great. The reservoir is 90% full.

#### **Hells Canyon Reservoir**

- Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

#### **Hemlock Lake**

- Hemlock Lake is open.



### **Henry Hagg Lake**

- Eagle Point Recreation Area restrooms have been reopened after repairs.
- Ramp A and C are open, and the reservoir is 99% full.

### **Hills Creek Reservoir**

- Packard Creek Boat Ramp is open and there is approximately 54 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- Bingham boat ramp is open; however, water is approximately 25 feet below the bottom of the ramp.
- CT Beach is open; however, water is approximately 12 feet below the bottom of the ramp.

### **Howard Prairie Lake**

- UPDATE: Howard Prairie Resort is opening May 12. The water level is approximately 44% full. Small boats can use the unimproved access near the dam.
- NEW Grizzly Park is closed due to low water.
- NEW: Klum Landing Campground opens May 19; however, the boat ramp is closed due to low water levels.
- NEW: Willow Point Campground opens May 19; however, the boat ramp is closed due to low water levels.

### **Hyatt Lake**

- UPDATE: The lake is 50% full. Water is at the bottom of the ramp. However, it remains closed due to snowpack. All camping facilities at the Hyatt Lake Recreation Area will be closed in 2023 for utility upgrades: [Hyatt Lake Recreation Area, Hyatt Reservoir - Recreation.gov](#).

### **Kinglsey Reservoir/Green Point Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Snow has melted, and trees are being cleaned up out of the campground. The anticipated opening is Memorial Day Weekend.

### **Lake Billy Chinook**

- NEW: Perry South Day Use will close from May 15 through May 21 for maintenance.
- Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps will stay open year-round.

### **Lake Harriet**

- Lake Harriet Campground and Day Use area are inaccessible due to snow.

### **Lake Marie**

- Umpqua Lighthouse State Park is open to paddlecraft. Paddlers must carry down. There is no formal launch ramp or dock.

### **Lake of the Woods**

- Lake of the Woods Resort staff are available to answer inquiries at: 866-201-4194. The resort is open 7 days per week. Cabin and RV sites can be reserved at <https://lakeofthewoodsresort.com/>.

### **Lake Owyhee Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Reservoir is 99% full.
- Gordon Gulch boat ramp is open, and docks are floating.
- Indian Creek boat ramp is open, and docks are floating.
- Leslie Gulch boat ramp is open.

### **Lake Simtustus**

- Pelton Park Marina closed. Boat launch is open.
- Reservations for Indian Park Campground are now available online through the Warm Springs Fisheries Department. [Indian Park Camping – Check Availability – Department of Fisheries \(warnsprings-nsn.gov\)](http://www.warmsprings-nsn.gov/indian-park-camping)

### **Lookout Point Reservoir**

- Signal Point Ramp has approximately 70 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Black Canyon water level is approximately five feet below the boat ramp.

### **Loon Lake**

- Loon Lake Recreation Site closed, but is due to re-open during Memorial Day Weekend. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year around. Paddlecraft can carry down from the Day Use Area.

### **Lost Creek Reservoir**

- Takelma boat ramp has approximately 118 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. The boarding docks were removed and will not be reinstalled.

### **Luckiamute River**

- Luckiamute Landing is open.

### **McKenzie River**

- Deerhorn, Forest Glen, Goodpasture, Greenwood, Hayden Bridge, Helfrich, Leaburg Landings, Bellinger, Armitage, Hamlin, Hendricks Bridge Parks are open.

- Ben and Kay Dorris State Park: single boat ramp open. No Park facilities due to the Holiday Fire.

### **Mercer Lake**

- Mercer Lake Landing is open.

### **Middle Fork Willamette River**

- NEW: The Westfir take out also known as Turtle Island Park is on the North Fork of the Middle Fork is open for the season.
- The Middle Fork boat ramp near the Dexter Dam will be closed this year for the Dexter Fish Facility Upgrade. Additional information has been requested.
- Pengra Access ramp is open.

### **Morgan Lake**

- Morgan Lake is open.

### **Munsel Lake**

- Munsel Lake is open.

### **North Santiam River**

- Buell Miller Boat Ramp is open.
- Fishermen's Bend Recreation Site will remain open, however, there will be no sanitation available. Please plan ahead. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](http://arcgis.com)
- Lyons-Mehama and Stayton Bridge boat ramps are open.

### **North Twin Lake**

- Boating access is open. The campground is closed until Memorial Day Weekend.

### **North Umpqua River**

- Boulder Flat raft launch, Horseshoe Bend raft launch and Gravel Bin are open. Horseshoe Bend campground is closed.

### **Ochoco Lake**

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 56% full. The boat ramp and docks are out of the water. Paddlers can carry down to launch.

### **Odell Lake**

- Sunset Cove is open.

### **Olalla Reservoir**

- Boat launch is open, and the reservoir is full.

### **Paulina Lake**

- Hazard tree inspectors identified more than 300 hazard trees within Paulina Lake Campground. Crews removed a majority of these trees last fall; however, some hazard tree removal work remains. The remaining hazard tree work will resume as soon as snow levels permit this spring. In anticipation of this work, the opening date for Paulina Lake Campground will be delayed by two weeks to June 30. ### **Pilcher Creek Reservoir**

- Pilcher Creek site is open, but water is too low to launch. Docks have not been installed yet.

### **Plat I Reservoir**

- The reservoir is full and open for recreation.

### **Port of Garibaldi**

- NEW: Public Restroom Remodel scheduled to be completed May 15<sup>th</sup>.

### **Port of Newport**

- All boating sites are open, and docks are floating. Check with Coast Guard Station Yaquina Bay for bar conditions prior to launching. [District Thirteen \(uscg.mil\)](http://www.uscg.mil)

### **Port of Siuslaw**

- Boat ramp is open and boom logs have been removed for the season.

### **Prineville Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Prineville reservoir is full. The Bureau of Reclamation is expecting to surcharge the reservoir, resulting in levels in excess of 6 feet above full pool. Be cautious when using the swim area which is collecting debris.
- UPDATE: Powderhouse Cove ramp is open, and the dock has been installed.
- Prineville State Park Day Use is open. The boarding docks are damaged and not installed. These are sitting in the left ramp. There is a large amount of debris on the water, so be cautious.
- Floating restrooms might not be installed this season.

### **Rogue River**

- Dees Landing (Coyote Evans Wayside) is open. New signage will be installed for reserved trailer parking.
- TouVelle and Valley of the Rogue State Park boat launches are open.
- Access at Argo Recreation Site is closed until further notice due to the Rum Creek Fire. The road is closed just past Alameda Campground to the Grave Creek Bridge.
- Access to Grave Creek boat launch is accessible via Lower Grave Creek Rd.
- Alameda boat launch and Rand River access are open.
- Baker Park boat ramp is open. Security cameras have been upgraded at this location.

- Casey, Rogue Elk, Shady Cove, and Dodge Bridge access sites are all open.

### **Siletz River**

- Moonshine Boat Ramp in Lodgsen is closed. There is a tree approximately 1-mile downstream of Moonshine Park that spans the river. Due to high water levels, obstruction cannot be removed at this time. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](#)
- Old Mill Park is open, and the ramp is in the water.

### **Siltcoos Lake**

- Westlake County Park is open.

### **Siuslaw River**

- Bender Landing, Deadwood, Farnham, Mapleton, Schindler, Tiernan, Konnie Memorial, Tide County Parks and Linslaw are open.

### **Snake River**

- Dug Bar and Pittsburg Landing Campground are all open.
- Hells Canyon Creek boat launch is closed.

### **South Santiam River**

- Waterloo County Boat Ramp is open.

### **Spring Creek**

- Collier Memorial Park is closed through May.

### **Summit Lake**

- Summit Lake is closed due to snowpack.

### **Suttle Lake**

- Suttle Lake Boat Ramp is open, but the docks have not been installed yet.

### **Tahkenitch Lake**

- NEW: Tahkenitch boat ramp is damaged and is temporarily closed. The U.S. Forest Service is converting several campsites in the campground to day-use only to help accommodate boating access.

### **Tenmile Lake**

- The Tenmile County Ramp will have intermittent sidewalk construction (weather dependent) over the next few weeks. All of the work is anticipated to be completed before Memorial Day weekend.

### **Thief Valley Reservoir**

- Thief Valley Reservoir is full, and the boat ramp is open. The dock has been installed.

### **Timothy Lake**

- North Arm, Oak Fork, Pine Point, and West Shore Day Use areas are closed until May 27.

### **Triangle Lake**

- Triangle Lake Park is open.

### **Trojan Pond**

- Trojan Park is open year-round for paddling and day use.

### **Tualatin River**

- The Stark (Rivergrove) Boat Launch is open but in need of repairs. Recommend paddlecraft launch. Limited parking is available on the park side of the street.
- The Farmington Boat Launch restroom building is closed. Portable restrooms are available.
- The Rood Bridge boat ramp is closed, and docks are anticipated to be re-installed at the end of May.

### **Turner Lake**

- North Turner Lake is open.

### **Umpqua River**

- UPDATE: Scottsburg Park ramp is open, and docks are installed.

### **Upper Klamath Lake**

- NEW: The floating restroom is installed near Bare Island.
- NEW: Odessa campground and ramp are open.
- Rocky Point Boat Launch is open and accessible.
- Wocus Bay ramp and docks are open.

## Unity Reservoir

- UPDATE: Reservoir is full, and docks have been installed.

## Waldo Lake

- Access is closed from the Cedar Creek Fire Emergency. The Forest Order identifies the closure is in effect through June 25, 2023, unless rescinded sooner: [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/forestland/plant-soil/management/forest-order/fseprd1049655.pdf). - Wallowa County Park is open, and docks are floating.
- Wallowa Lake State Park is open.

## Warm Springs Reservoir

- UPDATE: Boating access is open, and the reservoir is 92% full.

## Wickiup Reservoir

- NEW: The Gull Point boating access is closed for 2023, so the U.S. Forest Service can address 679 hazardous trees. [Deschutes National Forest - News & Events \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/forestland/plant-soil/management/forest-order/deschutes-national-forest-news-events)
- NEW: North Wickiup Boating access is open. The fish cleaning station is not open yet.
- The reservoir is 61% full.

## Lower Willamette (Columbia River to Willamette Falls)

- Swan Island boat ramp property is owned by the City of Portland Bureau of Environmental Services (BES). BES has determined the property is no longer needed for on-going operations. If no Portland bureau or office indicates interest in purchasing the project, it will be sold as surplus property. - Sportcraft Landing, the boat ramp, boarding docks and lower parking area are open. The ODOT bridge contractor is working. Watch for barges and work boats in the area.



- Jon Storm Park dock, restrooms and pumpout and dump station are open, but the parking lot will be closed until completion of the I-205 bridge widening project.

### **Middle Willamette (Willamette Falls to Salem)**

- NEW: Boones Ferry will be closed May 22 and 23 to replace the boarding docks at the boat ramp.
- Hebb Park Ramp is open, and docks are installed for the season.

### **Upper Willamette (Salem to Eugene)**

- Willamette Ramp in Corvallis is open. Floating docks are scheduled to be installed by Memorial Day.
- Whitley Landing is open.
- McCartney Boat Ramp is open.
- Peoria Park Boat Ramp is open.

### **Willamette River - Coast Fork**

- The Highway 58 bridge at Dilley Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. The boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor for an anticipated schedule. The work may happen as early as June 2023 or sometime in 2024 or 2025. ### **Willamette River – Middle Fork**

- The Middle Fork boat ramp near the Dexter Dam will be closed this year for the Dexter Fish Facility Upgrade. Additional information has been requested.

### **Willamette River – North Fork of the Middle Fork**

- NEW: The Westfir take-out, also known as Turtle Island Park, is open for the season.

### **Willow Lake**

- Ramp and dock are open. The reservoir is full.

### **Wolf Creek Reservoir**

- Wolf Creek site is open, but water is too low to launch. Docks have not been placed yet.

**Wood River**

- NEW: Wood River Day Use area is open. There is carry down paddle access.
