Agate Lake

- The ramp is open, and the lake is full.
- Rogue Eagles annual Danny Stanton Memorial Float Fly. May 19, 2023 - May 21, 2023. [Oregon State Marine Board : Recreational Boating Events : Agency Info : State of Oregon](#)

Agency Lake

- Henzel and Petric Park's boat ramps are open and boarding docks are installed.

Applegate Reservoir

- Hart-Tish has more than 55 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp. The boat ramp is open. The price to launch has increased from \$5 to \$7.
- Copper boat ramp has approximately 60 feet over the bottom of the ramp.
- French Gulch has more than 125 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.

Ben Irving Reservoir

- Boat ramp and dock open. ODFW stocked the reservoir with fish last week.

Beulah Reservoir

- Beulah Reservoir is full.

Big Lake

- Big Lake West and Big Lake campgrounds, Big Lake Day Use and the boat ramp are closed.

Blue River Reservoir

- UPDATE: Reservoir is full.
- Lookout Boat Ramp is open.
- Saddle Dam boat ramp remains closed.

Brownlee Reservoir

- The Hewitt Park boat ramp is open. The new vault toilet has been installed. There is approximately 30 feet of water at the end of the ramp. The Park is at full capacity for The Crappie Shootout, a kayak fishing tournament, on May 20th: <https://www.facebook.com/BrownleeCrappieShootout>. Three new life jacket loaner stations will be in service in May.
- The Spring Recreation Campground is now open. Both ramps are open, and the dock is floating. This site started charging fees this spring. The water is approximately 13 feet over the end of the boat ramp.
- The Holcomb Park boat ramp is open. The water level is 21 feet above the bottom of the boat ramp. The park is at full capacity for the Crappy Shootout event scheduled for the weekend of May 20th.
- Farewell Bend State Park is open and the water level is approximately 31 feet above the boat ramp.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open. There is approximately 42 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.

Bully Creek Reservoir

- The water is approximately 35 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp. The docks are installed and floating.

Carmen Smith Reservoir

- The closure has been extended to the spring of 2025.

Chickahominy Reservoir

- The lake is nearly full, ODFW recently stocked the lake with fish, and the boat ramp is open.

Clackamas Lake

- Currently Closed. Tentative opening date of 5/26/23, depending on snow conditions. Plan ahead. When Timothy Lake campgrounds are full, consider going to Clackamas Lake and enjoy paddling.

Clackamas River

- The Upper Clackamas Whitewater Festival is May 20th-21st. There are multiple events planned at several locations. - Moore Creek, Sandstone, and Hole-in-the-Wall Boat Access sites are open. Areas along the Clackamas River are still heavily impacted by wildfire. Visitors are recommended to exercise caution if taking out at non-designated areas.

Clear Lake (Linn County)

- Boating access is open for paddlecraft.

Coast Fork-Willamette River

- The Highway 58 bridge at Dilley Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. The boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor for an anticipated schedule. Coffenbury Lake

- Fort Stevens State Park Boat Launch is open, and the lake is full.

Cold Springs Reservoir

- Cold Springs Reservoir is approximately 57% full.

Columbia River

- UPDATE: Chinook Landing's pumpout and dump station is turned off while the water line is being repaired.
- City of St. Helens Courthouse Docks are open and the pumpout and dump station are operational. There will be some construction in the park throughout the summer; however, access will remain open. Bull rails on the docks are in poor condition so larger vessel operators need to be careful when tying up.
- City of St. Helens Sand Island North and South are open.

Cooper Creek Reservoir

- Cooper Creek East and West boat ramps are open, and the docks are floating.

Coos Bay

- UPDATE: Empire Boat Ramp boarding docks are being partially installed this week. The docks are anticipated to be reinstalled in June.
- Repairs to North Jetty. Construction to last until December 2025.

- The California Street boat ramp and docks are open.

Coquille River

- The docks at Bullards Beach are installed, and the facilities are open.

Cottage Grove Reservoir

- Lakeside Boat Ramp is open, and the docks are floating. There is approximately 40 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- Wilson Creek Boat Ramp is open. There is approximately 7 feet of water over the end of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Cougar Reservoir

- The Slide Creek Campground is open; however, the water is approximately 55 feet below the bottom of the ramp. Paddlers can carry down, but the terrain is difficult.
- Echo Park remains closed. The water is approximately 55 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

Crane Prairie

- Crane Prairie Resort is open. The Resort is open from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.
- Quinn River, Rock Creek and Crane Prairie boat ramps are open. The campgrounds are closed. Crane Prairie Reservoir is 87% full. The docks are not installed. To monitor when docks will be installed check here: [Deschutes National Forest - Home \(usda.gov\)](#)

Crescent Lake

- Crescent Lake Campground is closed. The reservoir is 13% full.

Crystal Creek

- Malone Springs Day Use is located approximately 45 minutes northwest of Klamath Falls. This small paddle access is part of the Upper Klamath Canoe Trail meandering through marshes and is part of the Upper Klamath National Wildlife Refuge. [Upper Klamath Canoe Trail in Oregon | Paddling.com](#)

Davis Lake

- NEW: Lake level is still very low. Limited boat launching is available at North Lava Flow Campground and West Davis day-use sites.

Depoe Bay

- NEW: The Depoe Bay 50th Anniversary Celebration will be held in the adjacent city park on May 20th from Noon to 4 pm. This may impact overflow parking.

Deschutes River

- Heritage Landing is open, and the ramp is in the water. There is no dock at this facility. The sand bar at the mouth of the Deschutes may result in reduced access to the Columbia River during periods of low water.
- Aspen, Big River and Lava Island Day Use boating access sites are open. Aspen and Lava Island Day Use are also hiking trailheads for the Deschutes River Trail. To learn more about the trail: [Deschutes National Forest - Deschutes River Trail \(usda.gov\)](#).

Detroit Lake

- State Park D has approximately five feet of water over the bottom of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- Southshore has 18 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- The Mongold upper boat ramp is open, and docks are floating.
- Kane's Marina has 14 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp. Marina is open.
- Hoover has 17 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp. Anticipated to open in May.
- Cove Creek has 19 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp. Anticipate opening this month.
- State Park G Loop has 30 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp. Anticipate opening this month.

Dexter Reservoir

- Lowell and Dexter State Park boat ramps are open except for event closure as noted below. Water is approximately 10 feet above the bottom of the ramps.
- There will be a Paddlecraft Demo Day, held at Lowell State Park on May 20th. [What is Demo Day? - Oregon Paddle Sports](#)

Diamond Lake

- The North end boat ramp and restrooms are open. The South End and Thielson View are still closed for the season.

Dorena Reservoir

- UPDATE: The Baker Bay boat ramp is open and has more than 65 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Harms Park boat ramp is open. There is approximately 10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Dog Lake

- NEW: Dog Lake Campground and boat launch are open.

Eel Lake

- William M. Tugman State Park boat launch and kayak launch are open.

Emigrant Lake

- UPDATE: The lake is 73% full. The North ramp is open, and the West ramp has one lane open. Use caution – the inflow of water is creating high levels of woody debris throughout the lake.

Estacada Lake

- Timber Park nonmotorized boat launch opened May 1st. A new \$5 parking permit is required and can be paid for by credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass available by calling or emailing – 503-464-8515, pgeparks@pgn.com.

Fall Creek Reservoir

- North Shore low water ramp is open. Water is fluctuating between 0 and 10 feet over the end of the ramp. All other ramps are out of the water and gated for now. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Faraday Lake

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (Southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to be reopened in 2023. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com)

Fern Ridge Reservoir

- UPDATE: Perkins Peninsula Park opened on May 14. There is approximately five feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Fern Ridge Shores has more than six feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Orchard Point Marina is open. There is approximately nine feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Richardson Park marina is open. There is approximately eight feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Foster Reservoir

- NEW: Gedney Creek is closed; however, the water level is anticipated to increase and by Friday. There should be 7 -10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. Linn County is monitoring water levels and will open the ramp as soon as the water is three feet over the end of the boat ramp.
- Sunnyside Boat ramp is open. The water is approximately seven feet over the end of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- Calkins Park Boat Ramp closed. The water is 11 feet *below* the end of the ramp.

Fourmile Lake

- UPDATE: Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp are closed. USFS anticipates reopening in July. The reservoir is approximately 43% full.

Galesville Reservoir

- Chief Miwaleta ramp is open. The County has removed the docks for repair. There is significant woody debris floating due to the high water level. Keep a lookout when boating.

Gold Lake

- UPDATE: Access is closed due to the Cedar Creek Fire. The closure is in effect through June 25, 2023, unless rescinded sooner. [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/forestry/cedar-creek-fire)
As of May 10, U.S. Forest Service is requesting people not to drive on closed

roads. They are monitoring snow and road conditions and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. For updates, call the Gold Lake information line at 541-782-5235.

Green Peter Reservoir

- UPDATE: Thistle Creek and Whitcomb Creek boat ramps are open. Boarding docks are available. Floating restrooms are installed. Watch for floating debris.

Green Point Reservoir/ Kinglsey Reservoir

- Snow has melted and trees are being cleaned up out of the campground. The anticipated opening is Memorial Day Weekend.

Haystack Reservoir

- The boat ramp is open, and the docks are floating. The reservoir is 88% full.

Heart Lake

- NEW: Heart Lake Landing is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

Hells Canyon Reservoir

- The Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

Hemlock Lake

- Hemlock Lake is open.

Henry Hagg Lake

- Ramp A and C are open, and the reservoir is full.

Hills Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: Packard Creek Boat Ramp is open and there is approximately 60 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Bingham boat ramp is open; however, water is approximately 10 feet below the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: CT Beach is open. The water level is approximately one foot below the bottom of the ramp. This is a nice location for paddlers to carry down their boats.

Holbrook Reservoir

- NEW: Holbrook Reservoir Campground is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

Howard Prairie Reservoir

- NEW: Howard Prairie Resort is open. The new marina docks are being installed. Please be cautious when boating in the area. The water level is approximately 48% full. Small boats can use the unimproved access near the dam.
- NEW: Grizzly Park is closed due to low water. Anticipated opening is May 19. [Grizzly Park at Howard Prairie Lake \(jacksoncountyor.org\)](http://jacksoncountyor.org)
- Klum Landing Campground opens May 19; however, the boat ramp is closed due to low water levels.
- Willow Point Campground opens May 19; however, the boat ramp is closed due to low water levels.

Hyatt Lake

- UPDATE: The lake is 54% full. The water is at the bottom of the C Loop ramp. It remains closed due to snowpack levels. The BLM anticipates opening the C Loop ramp and Wildcat Campground for Memorial Day Weekend. Kinglsey Reservoir/Green Point Reservoir

- Snow has melted and damaged trees are being removed from the campground. Anticipated opening for Memorial Day Weekend.

Lake Billy Chinook

- NEW: Cove Palisades Resort and Marina are open for the summer.
- NEW: The Water Ski course on the Crooked River Arm will be set up this weekend.
- Perry South Day Use will close from May 15th through 21st for maintenance.
- Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps are open.

Lake Harriet

- Lake Harriet Campground and Day Use area are inaccessible due to snow levels.

Lake Marie

- Umpqua Lighthouse State Park is open to paddlecraft. Paddlers must carry down since there is no formal launch or dock.

Lake of the Woods

- Lake of the Woods Resort staff are available to answer inquiries by calling 866-201-4194. The resort is open 7 days per week. Cabin and RV sites can be reserved at: <https://lakeofthewoodsresort.com/>.

Lake Owyhee Reservoir

- The reservoir is 99% full. Gordon Gulch and Indian Creek boat ramps are open and the docks are floating.
- Leslie Gulch boat ramp is open.

Lake Simtustus

- Pelton Park Marina closed. The boat launch is open.
- Reservations for Indian Park Campground are now available online through the Warm Springs Fisheries Department. [Indian Park Camping – Check Availability – Department of Fisheries \(warmsprings-nsn.gov\)](#)

Lofton Reservoir

- NEW: Lofton Reservoir is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Rd (Forest Road 3790).

Lookout Point Reservoir

- The Signal Point Ramp has approximately 70 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Black Canyon's water level is approximately five feet below the boat ramp.

Loon Lake

- Loon Lake Recreation Site is closed, but due to reopen during Memorial Day Weekend. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year-round. Paddlecraft can carry down from the Day Use Area.

Lost Creek Reservoir

- Takelma boat ramp has approximately 118 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. The boarding docks were removed and will not be reinstalled.

Luckiamute River

- Luckiamute Landing is open.

McKenzie River

- NEW: Silver Creek Boat Launch is open. Please be careful as the viewing platform has not yet been rebuilt since the Holiday Farm Fire.
- Deerhorn, Forest Glen, Goodpasture, Greenwood, Hayden Bridge, Helfrich, Leaburg Landings, Bellinger, Armitage, Hamlin, Hendricks Bridge Parks are all open.

- Ben and Kay Dorris State Park: the single boat ramp is open. There are no park facilities due to the Holiday Fire.

Mercer Lake

- Mercer Lake Landing is open.

Middle Fork Willamette River

- The Middle Fork boat ramp near Dexter Dam will be closed this year for the Dexter Fish Facility Upgrade. Additional information has been requested.
- The Pengra Access ramp is open.

Morgan Lake

- Morgan Lake is open.

Munsel Lake

- Munsel Lake is open.

North Santiam River

- Buell Miller Boat Ramp is open.
- Fishermen's Bend Recreation Site will remain open; however, there will be no sanitation available. Please plan ahead. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](https://arcgis.com)
- Lyons-Mehama and Stayton Bridge boat ramps are open.

North Twin Lake

- Boating access is open. The campground is closed until Memorial Day Weekend.

North Umpqua River

- The Boulder Flat raft launch, Horseshoe Bend raft launch and Gravel Bin are open. The Horseshoe Bend campground is closed.

Ochoco Lake

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 66% full. The boat launch is open, and three docks are floating.

Odell Lake

- Sunset Cove is open.

Olalla Reservoir

- Boat launch is open, and the reservoir is full.

Paulina Lake

- Hazard tree inspectors identified more than 300 hazard trees within Paulina Lake Campground. Crews removed a majority of these trees last fall; however, some hazard tree removal work remains. The remaining hazard tree work will resume as soon as snow levels decrease this spring. In anticipation of this work, the opening date for Paulina Lake Campground will be delayed by two weeks to June 30. Pilcher Creek Reservoir

- Pilcher Creek site is open, and the reservoir is 75% full. The docks have not been installed yet.

Plat I Reservoir

- The reservoir is full and open for recreation.

Port of Garibaldi

- NEW: Both floating restrooms are installed.

- UPDATE: Public Restroom Remodel is scheduled to be completed by mid-June.

Port of Newport

- All boating sites are open, and the docks are floating. Check with Coast Guard Station Yaquina Bay for bar conditions prior to launching. [District Thirteen \(uscg.mil\)](https://www.uscg.mil)

Port of Siuslaw

- The boat ramp is open and boom logs have been removed for the season.

Prineville Reservoir

- NEW: The floating restroom is anticipated to be installed at Bear Creek by this weekend.
- UPDATE: Prineville State Park Day Use is open. The boarding docks are damaged and are being repaired. The Moorage Dock is not installed and is anticipated to be installed after the surcharge. Surcharge storage is the storage between the full reservoir level (FRL) and the maximum water level (MWL) of a reservoir which may be attained with capacity exceeding the reservoir at FRL to start with.
- Powderhouse Cove ramp is open, and dock is installed.
- Prineville reservoir is full. The Bureau of Reclamation is expecting to surcharge the reservoir, resulting in levels in excess of six feet above full pool. Be cautious when using the swim area because it is collecting debris.

Rogue River

- NEW: Chinook County Park, Ferry Hole, Galice, Griffin Park, Hog Creek, Lathrop, Matson, Pierce Riffle, Robertson Bridge, Schroeder Park, and Ennis Riffle are all open. The water is high, and the current is strong.
- NEW: Boatnik 2023 Sprint and Drag Boat Racing event is scheduled for May 26 through the 29th. <https://www.boatnik.com/>
- Dees Landing (Coyote Evans Wayside) is open. New signage will be installed for reserved trailer parking.
- TouVelle and Valley of the Rogue State Park boat launches are open.
- Access at Argo Recreation Site is closed until further notice due to the Rum Creek Fire. The road is closed just past Alameda Campground to the Grave Creek Bridge.

- Access to Grave Creek boat launch is accessible via Lower Grave Creek Rd.
- Alameda boat launch and Rand River access are open.
- Baker Park boat ramp is open. Security cameras have been upgraded at this location.
- Casey, Rogue Elk, Shady Cove, and Dodge Bridge access sites are all open.

Siletz River

- Moonshine Boat Ramp in Lodgsen is closed. There is a tree approximately one mile downstream of Moonshine Park that spans the river. Due to high water levels, the obstruction cannot be removed at this time. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](#)

Snake River

- NEW: The Ontario State Park boarding docks have some broken decking. Please use caution when using the dock.
- Dug Bar and Pittsburg Landing Campground are open.
- Hells Canyon Creek boat launch is closed.

South Santiam River

- Waterloo County Boat Ramp is open.

Spring Creek

- Collier Memorial Park is closed through the month of May.

Summit Lake

- Summit Lake is closed due to the snowpack.

Suttle Lake

- Suttle Lake Boat Ramp is open, but the docks have not been installed yet.

Tahkenitch Lake

- Tahkenitch boat ramp is damaged and is temporarily closed. The U.S. Forest Service is converting several campsites in the campground to day-use only to help accommodate boating access.

Tenmile Lake

- Tenmile County Ramp will have intermittent sidewalk construction, weather dependent over the next few weeks. All of the work is anticipated to be completed before Memorial Day weekend.

Thief Valley Reservoir

- Thief Valley Reservoir is full, and the boat ramp is open. The dock has been installed.

Timothy Lake

- North Arm, Oak Fork, Pine Point, and West Shore Day Use areas are all closed until May 27.

Triangle Lake

- Triangle Lake Park is open.

Trojan Pond

- Trojan Park is open year-round for paddling and day use.

Tualatin River

- NEW: The Stark (Rivergrove) Boat Launch may not be usable due to recent work. Check with the City of Tualatin for updates: <https://www.tualatinoregon.gov/>.
- The Farmington Boat Launch restroom is closed. Portable restrooms are available.
- The Rood Bridge boat ramp is closed, and docks are anticipated to be reinstalled at the end of May.

Turner Lake

- North Turner Lake is open.

Umpqua River

- Scottsburg Park ramp is open, and the docks are installed.

Upper Klamath Lake

- The floating restroom is installed near Bare Island.
- Odessa campground and ramp are open.
- Rocky Point Boat Launch is open and accessible.
- Wocus Bay ramp and docks are open.

Unity Reservoir

- The reservoir is full, and docks have been installed.

Waldo Lake

- Access is closed from the Cedar Creek Fire Emergency. The Forest Order identifies the closure is in effect through June 25, 2023 unless rescinded sooner. [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](#). The U.S. Forest Service is monitoring snow and road conditions and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. Wallowa Lake

- Wallowa County Park and Wallowa Lake State Park are open, and docks are floating.

Warm Springs Reservoir

- UPDATE: Boating access is open, and the reservoir is 98% full.

Wickiup Reservoir

- Gull Point Boating access is closed for 2023 for U.S. Forest Service to address 679 hazardous trees. [Deschutes National Forest - News & Events \(usda.gov\)](#)
- North Wickiup Boating access is open. The fish cleaning station is not open yet. The reservoir is 61% full.

Lower Willamette (Columbia River to Willamette Falls)

- Memorial Weekend Boat Races are scheduled for May 27th from 10 am to 7 pm. An assortment of outboard hydroplane and runabout racing craft will compete for points on approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile oval course to be run between the St. Paul Bridge and the north end of Ash Island on the Willamette River in Newberg. - Swan Island boat ramp property, owned by City of Portland Bureau of Environmental Services (BES), has determined the property is no longer needed for on-going operations. If no Portland bureau or office indicates interest in purchasing the project, it will be sold as surplus property. - Sportcraft Landing, the boat ramp, boarding docks and lower parking area are open. The ODOT bridge contractor is working, so watch for barges and work boats in the area.
- Jon Storm Park dock, restrooms and pumpout and dump station are open, but the parking lot will be closed until completion of the I-205 bridge widening project.

Middle Willamette (Willamette Falls to Salem)

- UPDATE: Boones Ferry will be closed May 22 through 24 to replace the boarding docks at the boat ramp.
- Hebb Park Ramp is open, and docks are installed for the season.

Upper Willamette (Salem to Eugene)

- NEW: The Buena Vista boat ramp will be closed May 30 through September 30 for continued construction. There is no launching or retrieval at the site for motorized or nonmotorized boats. Plan ahead. The next downstream take out or launch is in Independence, or upstream at Bowman Park. Both locations are approximately 11 miles away from the Buena Vista boat ramp. Paddlers could take out at Luckiamute Access, roughly 5 miles upstream on the Luckiamute River. For everyone's safety, DO NOT launch or load from the Marion or Polk County Ferry Landings. - The Willamette Ramp in Corvallis is open. The floating docks are scheduled to be installed by Memorial Day Weekend.
- Whitley Landing is open.
- McCartney Boat Ramp is open.
- Peoria Park Boat Ramp is open.

Willamette River - Coast Fork

- The Highway 58 bridge at Dilley Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. The boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor for an anticipated schedule. The work may happen as early as June 2023 or sometime in 2024 or 2025.
