Many Oregon reservoirs have rising water levels and rivers are full and running fast. This means the water is cold and there is a significant amount of debris in the water. Don't forget to check and report boating obstructions or hazards [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](https://arcgis.com)

#### **Agate Lake**

- The ramp is open, and the lake is full.

#### **Agency Lake**

- Henzel and Petric Park's boat ramps are open and boarding docks are installed.

#### **Applegate Reservoir**

- Hart-Tish has more than 55 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp. The boat ramp is open. The price to launch increased from \$5 to \$7.
- Copper boat ramp has approximately 60 feet over the bottom of the ramp.
- French Gulch has more than 125 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.

#### **Ben Irving Reservoir**

- The boat ramp and dock are open.

#### **Beulah Reservoir**

- The water is approximately 82% full and water is 18 feet over the bottom of the ramp.

### **Big Lake**

- Big Lake West and Big Lake campgrounds, Big Lake Day Use and boat ramp are closed.

### **Blue River Reservoir**

- Water is approximately 15 feet over the end of the ramp at Lookout Boat Ramp.
- The water is approximately 50 feet above the end of Saddle Dam boat ramp, which is currently closed.

### **Brownlee Reservoir**

- The Holcomb Park boat ramp is open. The water level is 15 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp. The park is at full capacity for the Crappy Shootout event scheduled for the weekend of May 20<sup>th</sup>.
- The Hewitt Park boat ramp is open. There is approximately 24 feet of water at the end of the ramp. The Park is at full capacity for The Crappie Shootout event, scheduled for May 20<sup>th</sup>. [Upcoming Events – Travel Baker County](#). A new vault toilet is being installed near the Hewitt low water boat ramp. Three new life jacket loaner stations will be in service in May.
- Farewell Bend State Park is open and the water level is approximately 25 feet above the boat ramp.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open and has approximately 42 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.
- The Spring Recreation Campground is currently closed. The anticipated opening is May 12. This site will begin charging fees. The water is approximately seven feet below the boat ramp. No water or trash service at this time, or onsite host. The bathrooms are not regularly maintained. The fish cleaning station will not be operational until the water is turned on sometime in May. The docks will not be in use until late May.

### **Bully Creek Reservoir**

- The boat ramp has approximately 33 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp and the docks are floating.

### **Carmen Smith Reservoir**

- The closure has been extended to the spring of 2025.

### **Clackamas Lake**

- Currently Closed. The tentative opening date is May 19<sup>th</sup>, depending on snow conditions. Plan ahead. When Timothy Lake campgrounds are full, consider going to Clackamas Lake to enjoy paddling.

### **Clackamas River**

- NEW: The Upper Clackamas Whitewater Festival is May 20<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>. There are multiple events planned at several locations. For additional details: [2023 Upper Clackamas Whitewater Festival Schedule | Upper Clackamas Whitewater Festival \(upperclackamasfestival.org\)](#)
- Moore Creek, Sandstone, and Hole-in-the-Wall boating access sites are open. Areas along the Clackamas River are still heavily impacted by wildfire damage. Visitors need to exercise caution if pulling out at non-designated areas.

### **Clear Lake (Linn County)**

- Boat access is open for paddlecraft.

### **Coast Fork-Willamette River**

- The Highway 58 Bridge construction at Dilley Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. Boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor for an anticipated schedule. ### **Coffenbury Lake**

- Fort Stevens State Park Boat Launch is open, and the lake is full.

### **Cold Springs Reservoir**

- Cold Springs Reservoir is 53% full.

### **Columbia River**

- NEW: Hat Rock State Park has a paddlecraft demo day on May 13 from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm.
- Chinook Landing pumpout and dump station are fully operational and open to the public.
- City of St. Helens Courthouse Docks are open and the pumpout and dump station are operational. There will be some construction in the park throughout the summer; however, access will remain open. For larger vessels, be advised the bull rails on the docks are in poor condition. Be cautious when tying up.

- City of St. Helens Sand Island North and South are open.
- From September 15 through May 14, 2023, boaters may only pass-through Bonneville, The Dalles and John Day locks during daytime hours. Winter recreational lock schedule begins Sept. 15 on Lower Columbia

### **Cooper Creek Reservoir**

- The boat ramps and docks are open.

### **Coos Bay**

- Repairs to North Jetty. Construction is to last until December 2025.

- The California Street boat ramp is open and accessible.
- Empire Boat Ramp boarding docks are removed for inspection and repairs. The docks are anticipated to be reinstalled in late May.

### **Cottage Grove Reservoir**

- Lakeside Boat Ramp is open, and docks are floating. There is approximately 40 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- Wilson Creek Boat Ramp is open. There is approximately six feet of water over the end of the ramp.

### **Cougar Reservoir**

- Slide Creek and Echo Park are closed. The water is approximately 65 feet below the bottom of the boat ramps.

### **Crane Prairie**

- NEW: Crane Prairie Resort is open and “thawed out”. The Resort is open from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.
- Quinn River, Rock Creek and Crane Prairie boat ramps are open. The campgrounds are closed. Crane Prairie Reservoir is 86% full. The docks are not installed. Monitor when docks will be installed: [Deschutes National Forest - Home \(usda.gov\)](#).

### **Crescent Lake**

- Crescent Lake Campground is closed. The reservoir is 10% full. The tentative opening is May 19<sup>th</sup>.

## Depoe Bay

- The Depoe Bay Boat Ramp is open, and the boarding docks have been installed.

## Deschutes River

- NEW: Riverbend Park will be holding the Paddlefest event on May 6<sup>th</sup> from 10 am to 4 pm. [Upcoming Events | Tumalo Creek](#)
- Aspen, Big River and Lava Island Day use boating access sites are open. Aspen and Lava Island Day Use areas are also hiking trailheads for the Deschutes River Trail. Learn more about the trail: [Deschutes National Forest - Deschutes River Trail \(usda.gov\)](#).

## Detroit Lake

- UPDATE: Kane's Marina has four feet of water over the bottom of the ramp. The marina opens on May 5<sup>th</sup>. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- UPDATE: Hoover has seven feet of water over the bottom of the ramp and is scheduled to open on May 6.
- UPDATE: Cove Creek has nine feet of water over the bottom of the ramp and is scheduled to open on May 13.
- UPDATE: State Park G Loop has 20 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp. The anticipated opening is May 18.
- UPDATE: Mongold Low Water boat ramp has approximately 100 feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Southshore, State Park D remain closed for now.

## Dexter Reservoir

- UPDATE: State Park boat ramps are open except for event closure as noted below. Water is approximately 10 feet above the bottom of the ramps.
- The Dexter Lake Invite championship event is scheduled for May 14. ### **Diamond Lake**

- The North end boat ramp and restrooms are open. The South end and Thielson View are still closed for the season.

### **Dorena Reservoir**

- Baker Bay boat ramp is open and has more than 60 feet of water above the bottom of the ramp.
- Harms Park boat ramp is open. There is approximately five feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. Motorized boats are advised to launch at Baker Bay until the water levels increase.

### **Eel Lake**

- William M. Tugman State Park boat launch and kayak launch are open.

### **Emigrant Lake**

- The water level at the lake is 66% and the North Ramp is open. Use caution – the inflow of water is creating high levels of wood and debris throughout the lake and near the ramp and shorelines.

### **Estacada Lake**

- Timber Park's nonmotorized boat launch opened on May 1st. A new \$5.00 parking permit is required and can be paid for by credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass is available by calling or emailing: 503-464-8515, [pgeparks@pqn.com](mailto:pgeparks@pqn.com).

### **Fall Creek Reservoir**

- North Shore low water ramp is open. Water is fluctuating between 0 and 5 feet over the end of the ramp. All other ramps are out of the water and gated for now. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

### **Faraday Lake**

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (Southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to be reopened in 2023. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com)

### **Fern Ridge Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Perkins Peninsula Park is open. There is approximately five feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.

- Fern Ridge Shores has more than six feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Orchard Point Marina is open. There is approximately nine feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Richardson Park Marina is open. There is approximately eight feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Floras Lake**

- The Boice Cope ramp is open and accessible.

### **Foster Reservoir**

- Sunnyside Boat ramp is open. The water level fluctuates between one and three feet of water over the end of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- Gedney Creek is closed. The water is approximately five feet below the end of the ramp.
- Calkins Park Boat Ramp closed. The water is 17 feet *below* the end of the ramp.

### **Fourmile Lake**

- Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp are closed. The US Forest Service anticipates reopening in July. The reservoir is approximately 36% full.

### **Galesville Reservoir**

- Chief Miwaleta ramp is open. The County has removed the docks for repair. There is significant woody debris due to high water, so keep a sharp lookout while boating.

### **Gold Lake**

- UPDATE: Access is closed from the Cedar Creek Fire Emergency. The Forest Order identifies the closure is in effect through June 25, 2023, unless rescinded sooner. [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](#). The U.S. Forest Service is monitoring snow and road conditions and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. ### **Green Peter Reservoir**

- Thistle Creek and Whitcomb Creek boat ramps are open. The boarding docks will be released when the reservoir reaches full pool for the season.

### **Haystack Reservoir**

- UPDATE: The boat ramps are closed. The reservoir is 52% full.

### **Hells Canyon Reservoir**

- Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

### **Hemlock Lake**

- Hemlock Lake is open.

### **Henry Hagg Lake**

- UPDATE: Eagle Point Recreation Area restrooms are now open after being repaired.
- Ramps A and C are open, and the reservoir is 99% full.

### **Hills Creek Reservoir**

- Packard Creek Boat Ramp is open and there is approximately 44 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- Bingham boat ramp is open; however, the water is approximately 35 feet below the bottom of the ramp.
- CT Beach is open; however, the water is approximately 22 feet below the bottom of the ramp.

### **Howard Prairie Lake**

- UPDATE: Grizzly Park, Klum Landing, Willow Point, and Howard Prairie Resort are scheduled to reopen on May 12. The water level is approximately 49% full. Small boats can use the unimproved access near the dam.

### **Hyatt Lake**

- The water level is 41% full at this time.

### **Kinglsey Reservoir**

- Campground is currently closed due to high snowpack. Anticipated opening is in mid-May.

### **Lake Billy Chinook**

- UPDATE: Perry South Day Use is open, pending road conditions. The site will be closed May 15-21 for maintenance.



- Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps will stay open year-round.

### **Lake Harriet**

- UPDATE: Lake Harriet Campground and Day Use area are inaccessible due to snow levels.

### **Lake Marie**

- Umpqua Lighthouse State Park is open to paddlecraft. Paddlers must carry down since there is no formal launch or dock.

### **Lake of the Woods**

- Lake of the Woods Resort staff are available to answer inquiries. Call 866-201-4194. The resort is open 7 days per week. Cabin and RV sites can be reserved at <https://lakeofthewoodsresort.com/>.

### **Lake Owyhee Reservoir**

- Gordon Gulch boat ramp is open and has 39 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp and the docks are floating.
- Indian Creek boat ramp is open and has 55 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp and the docks are floating.
- Water is 10 feet over the bottom of the ramp at Leslie Gulch.

### **Lake Simtustus**

- Pelton Park Marina closed. The boat launch is open.
- Reservations for Indian Park Campground are now available online through the Warm Springs Fisheries Department. [Indian Park Camping – Check Availability – Department of Fisheries \(warnsprings-nasn.gov\)](https://www.warmsprings-nasn.gov/indian-park-camping)

### **Lookout Point Reservoir**

- The ramp has approximately 70 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Black Canyon water level is approximately five feet below the boat ramp.

### **Loon Lake**

- Loon Lake Recreation Site closed, due to reopen on Memorial Day Weekend. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year around. Paddlecraft can carry down from the Day Use Area.

### **Lost Creek Reservoir**

- Luckiamute Landing is open.

### **McKenzie River**

- NEW: Deerhorn, Forest Glen, Goodpasture, Greenwood, Hayden Bridge, Helfrich, Leaburg Landings, Bellinger, Armitage, Hamlin, Hendricks Bridge Parks are open.
- Approximately ¼ mile below Ollalie Campground there is a full-spanning strainer. To find or report boating obstructions or hazards, visit [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](http://arcgis.com).
- Ben and Kay Dorris State Park: The single boat ramp is open. No Park facilities are available at this time due to the Holiday Fire.
- Frisell and Paradise Boat Launches are open.

### **Mercer Lake**

- NEW: Mercer Lake Landing is open.

### **Middle Fork Willamette River**

- The Middle Fork boat ramp near the Dexter Dam will be closed this year for the Dexter Fish Facility Upgrade. Additional information has been requested.
- Pengra Access ramp is open.

**Morgan Lake**

- Morgan Lake is open.

**Munsel Lake**

- Munsel Lake is open.

**North Santiam River**

- Buell Miller Boat Ramp is open.
- Fishermen's Bend Recreation Site will remain open; however, there will be no sanitation available. Please plan ahead. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](http://arcgis.com)

**North Santiam River**

- Lyons-Mehama and Stayton Bridge boat ramps are open.

**North Twin Lake**

- Boating access is open. The campground is closed until Memorial Day Weekend.

**North Umpqua River**

- Boulder Flat raft launch, Horseshoe Bend raft launch and Gravel Bin are open. Horseshoe Bend campground is closed.

**Ochoco Lake**

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 46% full. The boat ramp and docks are out of the water. Paddlers can carry down to launch.

**Odell Lake**

- UPDATE: Sunset Cove is open.

**Olalla Reservoir**

- Boat launch is open, and the reservoir is full.

**Paulina Lake**

- Hazard tree inspectors identified more than 300 hazard trees within Paulina Lake Campground. Crews removed a majority of these trees last fall; however, some hazard tree removal work remains. The remaining hazard tree work will resume as soon as snow levels permit this spring. In anticipation of this work, the opening date for Paulina Lake Campground will be delayed by two weeks to June 30. ### **Pilcher Creek Reservoir**

- Pilcher Creek site is open, but water is too low to launch. Docks have not been installed yet.

### **Plat I Reservoir**

- The reservoir is full and open for recreation.

### **Port of Newport**

- All boating sites are open, and docks are floating. Check with Coast Guard Station Yaquina Bay for bar conditions prior to launching. [District Thirteen \(uscg.mil\)](https://www.uscg.mil).

### **Port of Siuslaw**

- The boat ramp is open and boom logs have been removed for the season.

### **Prineville Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Powderhouse Cove has 16 feet of water over the end of the ramp and is open. The dock is not installed yet.
- Prineville State Park Day Use is open with 35 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp. The boarding docks are damaged and not installed but are located in the left ramp area. There is a large amount of debris on the water. Keep a sharp lookout.
- Jasper Point Park is open with 23 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- Roberts Bay and the Resort boat ramps are currently closed because of low water. Most of the ramps are gated when closed.
- The County boat ramp is open.
- Floating restrooms might not be installed this season.

### **Rogue River**

- NEW: Dees Landing (Coyote Evans Wayside) is open. New signage will be installed for reserved trailer parking.
- NEW: Danny Stanton Memorial Float Fly May 19-21. [Danny Stanton Memorial Float Fly | Academy of Model Aeronautics \(modelaircraft.org\)](https://www.modelaircraft.org).
- TouVelle and Valley of the Rogue State Park boat launches are open.

- Access at Argo Recreation Site is closed until further notice due to the Rum Creek Fire. The road is closed just past Alameda Campground to the Grave Creek Bridge.
- Access to Grave Creek boat launch is accessible via Lower Grave Creek Rd.
- Alameda boat launch and Rand River access are open.
- Baker Park boat ramp is open. Security cameras have been upgraded at this location.
- Casey, Rogue Elk, Shady Cove, and Dodge Bridge access sites are all open.

### **Siletz River**

### **Snake River**

- Dug Bar, Pittsburg Landing and Campground are all open.
- Hells Canyon Creek boat launch is closed.

### **South Santiam River**

- Waterloo County Boat Ramp is open

### **Spring Creek**

- Collier Memorial Park is closed through May.

### **Summit Lake**

- Summit Lake is closed due to snowpack.

### **Suttle Lake**

- NEW: Suttle Lake Boat Ramp is open, but the docks have not been installed yet.

### **Tenmile Lake**

- Tenmile County Ramp will have intermittent sidewalk construction, weather dependent over the next few weeks. All work is anticipated to be completed before Memorial Day weekend.

### **Thief Valley Reservoir**

- Thief Valley Reservoir is full, and the boat ramp is open. The dock has been installed.

### **Tillamook Bay**

- The Memaloose Boat Launch dredging project has been completed and the launch is now open for the public to use.

### **Timothy Lake**

- North Arm, Oak Fork, Pine Point, and West Shore Day Use areas are closed until May 27.

### **Triangle Lake**

- NEW: Triangle Lake Park is open.

### **Trojan Pond**

- Trojan Park is open year-round for paddling and day use.

### **Tualatin River**

- NEW: The Stark (Rivergrove) Boat Launch is open, but in need of repairs. Recommend paddlecraft launch. Limited parking is available on the park side of the street.
- The Farmington Boat Launch restroom building is closed. Portable restrooms are available.
- The Rood Bridge boat ramp is closed, and docks are anticipated to be reinstalled at the end of May.

### **Turner Lake**

- North Turner Lake is open.

### **Umpqua River**

- Scottsburg Park ramp is open. Docks have not been installed yet. Anticipated installation next week.

### **Upper Klamath Lake**

- Rocky Point Boat Launch is open and accessible.
- Wocus Bay ramp and docks are open.

### **Unity Reservoir**

- UPDATE: There is approximately 27 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp at Unity Lake State Park. Docks were installed on May 3<sup>rd</sup>.

### **Waldo Lake**

- UPDATE: Access is closed from the Cedar Creek Fire Emergency. The Forest Order identifies the closure is in effect through June 25, 2023 unless rescinded sooner [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](#). The U.S. Forest Service is monitoring snow and road conditions and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. ### **Wallowa Lake**

- NEW: Wallowa County Park is open, and the docks are floating.

- The reservoir is 74% full and water is 14 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Wickiup Reservoir**

- Wickiup Reservoir is 63% full.

### **Lower Willamette (Columbia River to Willamette Falls)**

- UPDATE: The Cedaroak Park parking lot paving and renovation project is ahead of schedule and the ramp reopened May 3<sup>rd</sup>. Striping and sign installation is pending. - Swan Island boat ramp property is owned by the City of Portland Bureau of Environmental Services (BES). BES has determined the property is no longer needed for ongoing operations. ### **Willow Lake**

- The ramp and dock are open. The reservoir is 96% full.

### **Wolf Creek Reservoir**

- Wolf Creek site is open, but the water is too low to launch. Docks have not been placed yet.
